<u>THE LATEST:</u> Tonight, the Angels play the fourth contest (1-2) of a 10-game road trip to **San Diego** (1-2), **Oakland** (May 21-23) and **Seattle** (May 24-27)...Club is 3-6 vs. A.L. West foes in 2012...LAA is 10-9 this month after an 8-15 showing in April...Yesterday marked Halos' seventh one run loss in 2012 and marked the fourth time this season the Angels have lost in the opponents' last at-bat.

LAST TIME OUT: Yesterday's 3-2 loss in 13 innings at San Diego was the club's second consecutive one-run loss...The series loss to the Padres was the Angels' first in interleague play since losing two of three to Milwaukee, June 14-16, 2010...Angels used 21 players in the effort (club record is 25)...Dan Haren (K) was the first Angel pitcher to pinch hit since June 10, 1998 at Arizona – Omar Olivares (K)... Club was 1 for 14 with RISP and left 12 runners on base.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: Jerome Williams seeks a career-high tying fifth straight win, last done as a member of the SF Giants June 21 – July 12, 2003...Williams is 3-1 with a 3.30 ERA in five career starts against Oakland and gave up one run over 6 1/3 innings in a 4-2 win Sept. 24 (AP).

@ OAKLAND: A's have won four of last five vs. Angels and lead 2012 season series 4-2... Halos have been limited to nine runs in last five games vs. Oakland...Angels are 13-9 in last 22 meetings at Angel Stadium vs. A's but are 3-6 in last nine games at Oakland...Club was 8-11 vs. Oakland in 2011, just second season series loss to A's since 2003 (9-10 in 2007).

MAKING A MARK: Mark Trumbo is batting .450 (18-for-40) with seven doubles, two home runs and six RBI over last 11 games...He has hits in 10 of 11 and has reached base in 13 of last 14 games and 25 of 33 contests in 2012.

<u>HOT HALOS:</u> Ernesto Frieri, acquired from Padres May 3rd, has not allowed a hit in seven relief appearances (6.2 IP) as an Angel while posting 14 strikeouts...Mike Trout has hits in 11 of his last 14 games batting .426 (23/54) with 14 runs, four doubles, a triple, four home runs and 10 RBI.

<u>FAST FACTS:</u> Albert Pujols has driven in 13 runs his last 14 games (2 RBI his previous 18 games)...Halos are 17-4 when scoring 4+ runs and 1-20 when scoring three or fewer runs...Bullpen has fashioned a 1.09 ERA over last eight games (24.2 IP - 3 ER).

ANGELS ADD EPPARD: Jim Eppard has assumed the Angels' Hitting Coach duties with the dismissal

of **Mickey Hatcher**. The 2012 campaign represents Eppard's 10th season in both the Angels organization and with the Salt Lake Bees. Previously, he spent eight seasons with the Colorado Rockies' minor league system, including five as a manager and three seasons as the hitting coach for the Colorado Springs Sky Sox.

FROM THE START: Halos' starting staff has posted quality starts in 19 of last 24 games and in 22 of last 28 affairs, compiling a combined 3.14 ERA (189 IP – 66 ER) in those 28 starts.

Owns a 3-1 career record vs. Oakland, including a 2-0 mark at the Coliseum

- Earned fourth straight win in last start, May 16th vs. White Sox, tossing his fifth quality start...Looking for first road win of season and first since August 30, 2011.
- Has posted a 4-0 record with a 2.08 ERA at home compared to an 0-1 mark with a 7.16 ERA (16.1 IP 13 ER).
- Tossed second career shutout, May 1st vs. Minnesota...Marked first shutout since June 27, 2003 vs. Oakland (w/SF), a span of 8 years, 9 months and 4 days...The span between complete games is longest since Lindy McDaniel who had a CG on May 15, 1960 with his next CG coming on July 10, 1973.
- Owns a 7-0 record with a 1.74 ERA (51.2 IP 10 ER) in seven starts at the Big A.
- VS. OAKLAND: Making sixth career start and appearance vs. Oakland...Owns a 3-1 record with one shutout and a 3.30 ERA (30 IP 11 ER)...Is 1-0 with a 5.06 ERA (10.2 IP - 6 ER) in two starts at Oakland.
- Finished 2011 season 4-0 with a 3.68 ERA (44 IP 18 ER) in 10 Major League appearances (six starts)...Registered a 2.55 ERA (24.2 IP 7 ER) at the Big A compared to a 5.12 mark on the road.

- Former first round pick (39th overall) of the San Francisco Giants in 1999 owns a 31-30 career record with two complete games, one shutout and a 4.18 ERA (515 IP – 239 ER) in 93 Major League appearances (83 starts).
