THE LATEST: Tonight, the Angels play the fifth contest (1-3) of a 10-game road trip to San Diego (1-2), Oakland (May 21-23; 0-1) and Seattle (May 24-27)...Club is 3-7 vs. A.L. West foes in 2012...LAA is 10-10 this month after an 8-15 showing in April...Last night marked Angels' third consecutive one-run loss and ninth one-run defeat in 2012...Angels have dropped four of last five games to fall seven games under .500, most games under mark after 43 contests since 2006 (17-26).

<u>SURGERY FOR WELLS:</u> Vernon Wells underwent surgery on the ulnar collateral ligament in his right thumb today. He suffered the injury stealing second base in the second inning of Sunday's contest at SD. The veteran is expected to be ready to resume baseball activities in 8-10 weeks.

OFFENSIVE STRUGGLES: Halos have been limited to five runs during current three-game skid...Club is 1-21 when scoring three runs or less and has been held to two runs or less in 17 of 43 games... **Halos are 5 for last 48 with RISP**...LAA ranks 13th in A.L. with 108 extra-base hits and 154 runs scored.

HOT HALOS: Mark Trumbo is batting .409 (18-for-44) with seven doubles, two home runs and six RBI over last 12 games...Ernesto Frieri, acquired from Padres May 3rd, has not allowed a hit in seven relief appearances (6.2 IP) as an Angel while posting 14 strikeouts...20 year-old rookie Mike Trout has hits in 12 of his last 15 games batting .414 (24/58) with 14 runs, four doubles, a triple, four home runs and 11 RBI...He is batting .391 (27/69) in May to rank second in the A.L.

UP NEXT @ SEATTLE: Halos are 19-4 in last 23 home games vs. Seattle but have dropped five of last nine games at SAFECO Field...Angels were 12-7 vs. M's in 2011, the club's sixth consecutive season series win over M's...Halos' 64 wins (64-31) vs. M's since 2007 are most by any team in MLB vs. one club...LAA is 96-55 vs. M's since '04.

ANGELS ADD EPPARD: Jim Eppard has assumed the Angels' Hitting Coach duties with the dismissal of **Mickey Hatcher**. The 2012 campaign represents Eppard's 10th season in both the Angels organization and with the Salt Lake Bees. Previously, he spent eight seasons with the Colorado Rockies' minor league system, including five as a manager and three seasons as the hitting coach for the Colorado Springs Sky Sox.

In search of first road win since April 14th; Leads A.L. with a 2.66 road ERA since 2010

- Winless in last three starts, posting a 6.52 ERA (9.2 IP 7 ER) over the span...Winless in last three road starts with last victory away from home coming April 14th at New York.
- Threw just 3.2 innings in last start, May 17th vs. White Sox, marking shortest true outing since throwing 3.2 IP, July 31, 2011 at Toronto...Six walks allowed matched career-high.
- Has allowed two earned runs-or-less in four of five road starts, posting a 2.10 ERA (25.2 IP 6 ER) in those starts.
 Made back-to-back starts, May 11-12 at Texas, becoming first Major League pitcher to make starts in consecutive games since Aaron Myette (TEX), Sept. 3-4, 2002 (ejected from first game after two pitches).
- Ranks sixth in A.L. with a .211 average against (40/190)
