**THE LATEST:** Today, the Angels play the sixth contest (2-3) of a 10-game road trip to San Diego (1-2), Oakland (May 21-23; 1-1) and Seattle (May 24-27)...**Club is 4-7 vs. A.L. West foes in 2012**...Angels are 1-4 in 'rubber games' this season...LAA is 11-10 this month after an 8-15 showing in April...Last night's win snapped a three-game skid and **marked the club's MLB-leading sixth shutout of season.**

**COMBINED ONE-HITTER:** Last night, **C.J. Wilson** (8 IP) and **Ernesto Frieri** (1 IP) tossed the seventh combined one-hitter in club history...The lone hit surrendered was a Pennington single to center in the 5<sup>th</sup>...**Second consecutive season the Halos posted a no-hitter and one-hitter in same campaign (Santana & Haren in 2011)**...Marked the club's first one-hit shutout on the road since July, 2006 when J. Lackey turned the trick at Oakland as well.

**ALL OR NOTHING:** Angels' pitchers lead the Majors with six shutouts...Halos batters have been blanked eight times, which also leads MLB.

**MOVIN' ON UP:** With his 449<sup>th</sup> career HR last night, **Albert Pujols** moved into a tie for 35th with **Vlad Guerrero** and **Jeff Bagwell** on the all-time HR list.

**WELLS UPDATE:** **Vernon Wells** underwent successful right thumb surgery to repair the torn medial (ulnar) collateral ligament yesterday. Surgery was performed in Los Angeles with Hand and Wrist Surgeon Dr. Steve Shin. The procedure lasted approximately 30 minutes. Estimated time of recovery is 8-10 weeks. No rehab schedule at this time. He suffered the injury stealing second base in the second inning of Sunday's contest at SD.

**OFFENSIVE STRUGGLES:** Club is 1-21 when scoring three runs or less and has been held to two runs or less in 17 of 44 games...LAA ranks 13<sup>th</sup> in A.L. with 109 extra-base hits and 159 runs scored.

**@ OAKLAND:** **A's have won five of last seven vs. Angels and lead 2012 season series 5-3**... Halos have been limited to 15 runs in last seven games vs. Oakland...**Angels are 13-9 in last 22 meetings at Angel Stadium vs. A's but are 4-7 in last 11 games at Oakland**...Club was 8-11 vs. Oakland in 2011, just second season series loss to A's since 2003 (9-10 in 2007).

**HOT HALOS:** **Erick Aybar** has 10 hits in last 21 at-bats after totaling 10 in previous 22 games combined (72 at-bats)... **Mark Trumbo** is batting .408 (20-for-49) with seven doubles, two home runs and seven RBI over last 13 games...**Ernesto Frieri**, acquired from Padres May 3<sup>rd</sup>, has not allowed a hit in eight relief appearances (7.2 IP) as an Angel while posting 16 strikeouts...20 year-old rookie **Mike Trout** has hits in 12 of his last 16 games batting .387 (24/62) with 15 runs, four doubles, a triple, four home runs and 11 RBI...**He is batting .370 (27/73) in May to rank second in the A.L.**

**UP NEXT @ SEATTLE:** **Halos are 19-4 in last 23 home games vs. Seattle but have dropped five of last nine games at SAFECO Field**...Angels were 12-7 vs. M's in 2011, the club's sixth consecutive season series win over M's...**Halos' 64 wins (64-31) vs. M's since 2007 are most by any team in MLB vs. one club**...LAA is 96-55 vs. M's since '04.

**FAST FACTS:** In his last two starts in Oakland, **Jered Weaver** has registered a 2-0 record with a 1.98 ERA (13.2 IP – 3 ER)...**Albert Pujols** has driven in 15 runs his last 16 games (2 RBI his previous 18 games)...**He has four home runs and 16 RBI this month (19 G) after logging 0 homers and four RBI in April**...Halos are 18-4 when scoring 4+ runs and 1-21 when scoring three or fewer runs...**Bullpen has fashioned an 0.99 ERA over last nine games (27.1 IP – 3 ER).**

**ANGELS ADD EPPARD:** **Jim Eppard** has assumed the Angels' Hitting Coach duties with the dismissal of **Mickey Hatcher**. The 2012 campaign represents Eppard's 10<sup>th</sup> season in both the Angels organization and with the Salt Lake Bees. Previously, he spent eight seasons with the Colorado Rockies' minor league system, including five as a manager and three seasons as the hitting coach for the Colorado Springs Sky Sox.

**FROM THE START:** **Halos' starting staff has posted quality starts in 21 of last 26 games** and in 24 of last 30 affairs, compiling a combined 3.01 ERA (203.1 IP – 68 ER) in those 30 starts...**Angel starters lead the A.L. with a 3.48 ERA.**

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER – RHP JERED WEAVER**

6-1, 2.80

Has won two straight at the Coliseum, posting a 1.98 ERA in those starts

- Earned the victory in last start, May 18<sup>th</sup> at San Diego, his sixth straight interleague win...Marked seventh quality start in nine outings this season.
- Among league leaders, ranks T1st in wins, T6th in ERA, 8th in innings pitched, T10th in strikeouts and fourth in average against (.199).
- Making fourth straight road start...Owns a 2-1 road record with a 5.08 ERA (28.1 IP – 16 ER) compared to 4-0 with a 0.83 mark at home.
- **VS. OAKLAND:** Making 22<sup>nd</sup> career start vs. Oakland, second start of 2012...Tossed 6.2 scoreless innings vs. A's, April 16<sup>th</sup>...Owns a 7-7 career record with one shutout and a 2.71 ERA (136 IP – 41 ER)...In last two starts at the Coliseum, has registered a 2-0 record with a 1.98 ERA (13.2 IP – 3 ER)...Is 4-4 with a 3.77 ERA (74 IP – 31 ER) in 12 starts at Oakland.
- Tossed first career no-hitter, May 2<sup>nd</sup> vs. Minnesota (see box right) and earned first career American League Player of the Week Award.
- Became just the third Angels' pitcher in franchise history who hasn't allowed a single earned run in four of his first six starts of a season, joining Nolan Ryan ('78) and Rudy May ('73) - Stats.
- On April 16, defeated Oakland 6-0, striking out Josh Reddick in sixth inning for 1,000<sup>th</sup> career strikeout, becoming just the eighth Angel to record 1,000+ strikeouts with the club...Joined brother Jeff as just sixth brother tandem in MLB history to record 1,000 strikeouts each.
- Since start of career in 2006, leads league with a 2.96 first-half ERA (675 IP – 222 ER) and a 2.59 home ERA (589.2 IP – 170 ER).
- **2011 RECAP:** Finished 2011 season 18-8 with a 2.41 ERA in 33 starts...His 18 wins and 235.2 IP are new career-bests...Among A.L. leaders, finished 2nd in ERA, 3rd in wins, tied for 4th in CG and 8th in strikeouts...Earned second selection to All-Star team and became just fifth Halo to start midsummer classic...Signed five-year contract extension, August 23<sup>rd</sup>.
- **CAREER NOTES:** His 1,030 strikeouts are 8<sup>th</sup> on the Angels' all-time list behind teammate Ervin Santana (1,079)...Is 88-48 with nine complete games, five shutouts and a 3.28 ERA in 184 starts...Married this offseason to Kristin Travis, November 12, 2011.

**-WEAVER SPINS A NO-NO-**

On May 2, 2012, Jered Weaver tossed his first career no-hitter vs. the Minnesota Twins at Angel Stadium.

- 10<sup>th</sup> overall and ninth individual no-no in Angels history.
- First Angels no-hitter since Ervin Santana, July 27, 2011 in Cleveland.
- Sixth Angels no-hitter thrown at Angel Stadium, first since a combined no-hitter by Mark Langston and Mike Witt, April 11, 1990 vs. Seattle.
- First individual no-no at Big A since Nolan Ryan, June 5, 1975 vs. Baltimore.
- Second no-hitter in MLB this season (Humber perfect game) and 250<sup>th</sup> in MLB regular season history.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER @ SEATTLE**

**RHP DAN HAREN (1-5, 3.47):** Recorded fourth straight loss in last start despite quality start...Has received just two runs of support over his last four starts; club is averaging just 2.3 runs per game in his starts...Making 20<sup>th</sup> career start and appearance vs. Mariners...Has won four of last five decisions vs. Seattle, posting a 1.97 ERA (50.1 IP – 11 ER) over the span...Owns a 10-5 lifetime record with a 2.60 ERA...His 19 starts and 10 wins are most vs. any opponent.

**IN THE PEN**

**#52 DAVID CARPENTER (RHP)** .360 vs. LH, .346 vs. RH **AGE: 24**

- 2.1 IP Sunday marked longest outing of young career...Held A's scoreless in only career outing (1.2 IP, April 17<sup>th</sup>).
- Has not allowed a single run in four appearances (4.1 IP) at Angel Stadium...Owns a 7.00 ERA (9 IP – 7 ER) away from the Big A.
- Made Major League debut, April 13 vs. Yankees, tossing a scoreless ninth inning allowing one hit...Recorded first big league strikeout April 15 vs. Mark Teixeira.
- Posted a combined 1-1 record with 16 saves and a 0.56 ERA between Inland Empire and Arkansas...Held opponents scoreless in all 19 outings at Arkansas.

**#38 BOBBY CASSEVAH (RHP)** --- vs. LH, --- vs. RH **AGE: 26**

- Recalled Sunday from Salt Lake where he posted a 1-0 record with three saves and a 6.75 ERA (12 IP – 9 ER) in 13 appearances...Started season on 15-day disabled list after missing all of spring training with right shoulder inflammation...Missed 20 games before being reinstated, April 27<sup>th</sup> and optioned to Salt Lake.
- Made 30 appearances for Halos in 2011, going 1-1 with a 2.72 ERA (39.2 IP – 12 ER)...Had stellar September, posting a 1.54 ERA (11.2 IP – 2 ER) with a .150 BAA.
- In 46 career games with Angels, owns a 2.87 ERA (59.2 IP – 19 ER).

**#37 SCOTT DOWNS (LHP)** .300 vs. LH, .087 vs. RH **AGE: 36**

- **Is one of two ML pitchers who has not given up a run this season in 10+ games**...Has converted all three save opportunities since being named closer, April 27<sup>th</sup>.
- Has appeared in just three of 14 games since suffering left knee contusion, May 6<sup>th</sup> vs. Toronto.
- **24 of last 26 outings are scoreless since August 31<sup>st</sup>, leading all MLB with a 0.39 ERA (23.1 IP -1 ER) – min. 10 IP.**
- **Since becoming an Angel in 2011, 35 of 36 outings at home have been scoreless (32.2 IP; 0.27 ERA)...12 K's from 500 for his career.**
- In 2011, finished 6-3 with 25 holds, one save and a 1.34 ERA (53.2 IP – 8 ER)...Registered a 0.35 ERA at the Big A, the lowest home ERA in club history (min. 25 G).

**#49 ERNESTO FRIERI (RHP)** .000 vs. LH, .000 vs. RH **AGE: 26**

- **Has not allowed a hit in eight outings (7.2 IP) with Halos while striking out 16 batters (28 BF)...17 of 19 outings this season have been scoreless.**
- Acquired from San Diego, May 3<sup>rd</sup> in exchange for minor leaguers Alexi Amarista and Donn Roach...Made Angels debut May 5<sup>th</sup> vs. Blue Jays.
- All eight road outings have been scoreless (8 IP), limiting opposing batters to a .080 average (2/25) with 15 strikeouts.
- Third Colombian native to appear with the Halos, joining Orlando Cabrera (2005-07) and Orlando Ramirez (1974-77, '79).
- In parts of four big league seasons with San Diego, the Colombia native registered a 3-3 record with a 2.33 ERA (108.1 IP – 28 ER) and 137 strikeouts.

**#55 JASON ISRINGHAUSEN (RHP)** *.231 vs. LH, .200 vs. RH* **AGE: 39**

- Leads pen with 16 appearances and 15.2 IP...12 of 16 outings are scoreless...Angels are just 2-14 when he pitches.
- Eight of nine career outings vs. Oakland are scoreless, limiting Athletics batters to a .167 average against.
- Entering 18<sup>th</sup> season in big leagues and first with Halos...Signed minor league free agent contract, Feb. 22<sup>nd</sup> and was placed on the Angels' 40-man roster, March 30<sup>th</sup>...In 2011, returned to the Mets (where he began career) and compiled a 3-3 record with seven saves and a 4.05 ERA (46.2 IP – 21 ER) in 53 appearances.
- 22.1 innings shy of 1,000 for career...Ranks third among active pitchers with 300 career saves.

**#35 DAVID PAULEY (RHP)** *.286 vs. LH, .407 vs. RH* **AGE: 28**

- Took the loss Sunday, allowing an unearned run in the 13<sup>th</sup> inning...Has thrown 9.1 IP in first four outings.
- Had contract purchased from Salt Lake, May 7<sup>th</sup>...In seven games (3 starts) with Bees, posted 2-0 record with a 2.29 ERA (19.2 IP – 5 ER) and 16 strikeouts.
- Started spring with Detroit before being release...Signed minor league contract with Halos, March 23
- Split 2011 season between Seattle and Detroit, going 5-6 with a 3.16 ERA.

**#21 HISANORI TAKAHASHI (LHP)** *.321 vs. LH, .188 vs. RH* **AGE: 37**

- Nine of last 10 outings have been scoreless...Has allowed just two hits in last seven appearances (2/15).
- **All 10 career outings (11 IP) vs. Oakland are scoreless...Has limited A's batters to a .059 average (2/34).**
- Third Japanese-born player in Angels history entering second season with Halos...Finished 2011 at 4-3 with one save and a 3.44 ERA in a career-high 61 app.
- In MLB career, owns a 4.12 first-half ERA (126.2 IP – 58 ER) compared to a 2.89 mark (74.2 IP – 24 ER) after the All-Star break.
- 9.2 innings shy of 1,500 in his professional career (Japan and MLB)...Translator's name is Yoichi Terada (travels with team).

**#51 JORDAN WALDEN (RHP)** *.250 vs. LH, .100 vs. RH* **AGE: 24**

- Has thrown eight consecutive scoreless outings (7.2 IP) since relinquishing closer role, limiting opposing batters to a .120 average (3/25).
- One for two in save opportunities this season...32 saves in 2011 set Angels' rookie saves record, surpassing Ken Tatum (22, 1969).
- Earned All-Star selection in first full season in Majors, going 5-5 with 32 saves (42 chances) and a 2.98 ERA (60.1 IP – 20 ER) in 62 appearances in 2011

**#2 ERICK AYBAR (INF)** *.239 vs. LH, .225 vs. RH* **AGE: 28**

- Left yesterday's game after being hit by a pitch in the 7<sup>th</sup> inning in his right knee...Diagnosed after the game with a right knee contusion and is listed as day to day.
- **Has 10 hits in last 21 at-bats after totaling 10 in previous 22 games combined (72 at-bats)...**Hits in five consecutive games for the first time since a six-game hit streak April 18-24...Matched a career high with four hits Saturday (last, Sept. 18, 2011).
- **Batting .440 (11/25) over last seven games to raise average from .187 to .230.**
- Stole a base in consecutive games on Saturday and Sunday for the first time since July 10 and 15, 2011 (All-Star break).
- A career .321 (44/137) hitter at the Oakland Coliseum...Since 2009, the .359 clip (38/106) is second-best by a Major Leaguer (min. 100 PA).
