OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have a season-high five-game losing streak to fall to a season-low four games under .500 at 22-26...have lost nine straight against New York in Oakland, which is tied for the A's second longest Coliseum losing streak against any team (Minnesota, April 27, 78-July 30, 1979)...the record is 13 straight against Baltimore July 8, 1976-April 27, 1979...went 1-5 on this six-game homestand against Los Angeles (1-2) and New York (0-3), their worst homestand since July 25-30, 2008 when they also went 1-5 against Texas and Kansas City...begin a six-game road trip against Minnesota (three games) and Kansas City (three games) tomorrow.
- The A's have been shut out four times in the last 12 games and eight times for the season, which is tied with the Angels for the most in the majors.
- Tommy Milone had his four-game winning streak in Oakland snapped...he was the first pitcher in Oakland history to win each of his first four starts at the Coliseum...is now 4-1 with a 0.96 ERA (4 er in 37.1 ip) in five starts at home compared to 2-3 with a 7.16 ERA (22 er in 27.2 ip) in five starts on the road.
- Ryan Cook has not allowed a run in 21 games and his 23.0 innings pitched are the most consecutive scoreless innings to start a season by an Athletics pitcher on the Opening Day roster since at least 1918.
- Daric Barton (0 for 3) is 8 for 46 (.174) over his last 16 games...is batting .151 (8 for 53) at home compared to .260 (13 for 50) on the road.
- Coco Crisp (1 for 4) snapped his 0 for 19 streak with a single in the seventh inning...he then stole second and third base and has now been successful in an Oakland record 29 consecutive stolen base attempts dating back to last year (previous: 28, Stan Javier in 1995).
- Jemile Weeks (1 for 4) is batting .333 (14 for 42) in his career against New York...is hitting .250 (24 for 96) at home this season compared to .154 (12 for 78) on the road.

NEW YORK NOTES

- The New York Yankees are on a season-high five-game winning streak...have now won six of the last nine games and are 12-8 in the last 20 games...are 26-11 when hitting one or more home runs compared to 0-10 when they do not hit a home run...are on a nine-game winning streak in Oakland and have won 13 of the last 14 contests at the Coliseum...are 3-0 on this nine-game road trip to Oakland (3-0), Los Angeles (three games) and Detroit (three games).
- The Yankees recorded their third shutout of the season (also May 18 vs. Cincinnati, April 13 vs. Los Angeles-AL).
- Hiroki Kuroda tossed a season-high tying eight innings (also April 13 vs. Los Angeles-AL)... has not allowed a run in two starts and 16.0 innings during the day (2-0) and is 2-6 with a 5.36 ERA (27 er in 45.1 ip) in eight starts at night.
- Curtis Granderson (1 for 3) has reached base safely in 43 of 47 games this season.
- Derek Jeter (1 for 5) had a single in the first inning, the 3,155th hit of his career...that moves him past George Brett for 14th in Major League history.
- Nick Swisher (1 for 4) went 5 for 13 (.385) in three games this series against the A's.
- Mark Teixeira (2 for 4) doubled twice and is now 10 for 23 (.435) with four doubles and nine RBI in his past six games.
