OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics recorded their sixth shutout of the season...have won three of their last five games after a season-high nine-game losing streak...are 2-1 on this four-game homestand against Texas.
- Bartolo Colon 1-1 with a 1.20 ERA (2 er in 15.0 ip) in two starts in June after going 1-3 with a 7.92 ERA in five starts in the month of May...has walked one batter or fewer in nine of his 13 starts...is 18-6 with a 3.61 ERA (74 er in 184.2 ip) in 28 career appearances, all starts, against Texas.
- Yoenis Cespedes (3 for 3) recorded a season-high tying three hits (fourth time, last: June 2 at Kansas City)...is batting .364 (20 for 55) at home compared to .200 (15 for 75) on the road.
- Brandon Inge (1 for 3) is 4 for 10 (.400) on this homestand...is now batting .268 (11 for 41) in his home ballparks compared to .137 (7 for 51) on the road
- Josh Reddick (1 for 3) is on a six-game hitting streak (7 for 23, .304).
- Cliff Pennington (1 for 3) is batting .417 (5 for 12) in three games against Texas this year.
- Kurt Suzuki (0 for 3) is batting .182 (14 for 77) over his last 23 games.

- The Texas Rangers were shut out for the first time this season...have lost nine of the last 13 games against AL West opponents...are 2-4 on this 10-game road trip to Los Angeles (1-2), Oakland (1-2) and San Francisco (three games).
- Colby Lewis tossed his first complete game of the season and fourth of his career...is 5-2 with a 2.56 ERA (18 er in 63.1 ip) in 10 career starts in Oakland.
- Elvis Andrus (0 for 4) did not reach base...had reached safely in 32 consecutive games, which was the longest streak of his career.
- Nelson Cruz (0 for 3) is a career .188 (26 for 138) hitter in Oakland.
- Ian Kinsler (1 for 4) has hit safely in 22 of his last 24 games against Oakland (36 for 104, .346).
- Mitch Moreland (0 for 3) is batting .043 (1 for 23) in his last nine games.
- Mike Napoli (2 for 3) is hitting .429 (12 for 28) in his last 10 games.
- Michael Young (1 for 3) has hit safely in 11 of his last 12 games (18 for 49, .367)...has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 in Oakland since the start of 2011 (19 for 50, .380).
