OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have a season-high five-game winning streak...are 2-0 on this nine-game homestand against San Diego (2-0), Los Angeles (three games) and San Francisco (three games).
- Tyson Ross** did not allow a hit until Quentin homered with two outs in the sixth inning...is 1-3 with a 3.68 ERA (12 er in 29.1 ip) in five starts during the day compared to 1-3 with a 9.13 ERA (24 er in 23.2 ip) in five starts at night.
- Sean Doolittle** recorded his first Major League win.
- Collin Cowgill** (2 for 4) is batting .408 (20 for 49) over his last 14 games after hitting .128 over his first 15 contests.
- Jonny Gomes** (1 for 1) hit a pinch-hit two-run home run in the seventh inning...the home run snapped his 0 for 34 steak as a pinch hitter, his first pinch hit since Aug. 29, 2010 at Chicago-NL...it was his third career pinch-hit home run (last: June 28, 2008 at Pittsburgh).
- Brandon Moss** (1 for 4) doubled in the fourth inning...nine of his 10 hits this year are for extra bases (three doubles, six home runs).
- Cliff Pennington** (1 for 2) is 15 for 40 (.375) over his last 11 games after going 3 for 41 (.073) over his previous 13 contests...is batting .349 (15 for 43) in 11 interleague games.
- Seth Smith** (1 for 2) hit a home run in the fourth inning...is now 17 for 37 (.459) with three home runs and 10 RBI over his last 11 games...is batting .340 (33 for 97) with all seven of his home runs and 16 of his 22 RBI in 32 games as an outfielder and .178 (13 for 73) in 23 games at designated hitter.

SAN DIEGO NOTES

- The San Diego Padres have lost the past two games to snap their season-high three-game winning streak...are 8-16 all-time against the A's, including 2-8 in Oakland...are 4-4 on this nine-game road trip to Milwaukee (1-2), Seattle (3-0) and Oakland (0-2).
- Ross Ohlendorf** tossed a season-high 4.2 innings (previous: 4.1, June 9 at Milwaukee)...is 0-0 and has a 3.00 ERA (4 er in 12 ip) in three career appearances, two starts, against the A's.
- Mark Kotsay** (1 for 3) has hit safely in each of his past eight games against Oakland (10 for 26, .385)... is a .367 (18 for 49) career hitter against the A's.
- Carlos Quentin** (1 for 2) is 20 for 48 (.417) with six home runs and 13 RBI in 15 games since being reinstated from the disabled list May 28.
- Will Venable** (1 for 4) is batting .327 (33 for 101) on the road compared to .202 (18 for 89) at home.
