



## San Diego Padres (23-42) at Oakland A's (28-37)

RHP Ross Ohlendorf (1-0, 3.38) vs. RHP Tyson Ross (2-6, 6.51)

**LONG ROAD HOME:** The Padres continue a 10-day, nine-game road trip today with the second of three in Oakland...following the three-game set, the Friars will return to San Diego to host the Texas Rangers (6/18-20) and Seattle Mariners (6/22-24) for an Interleague homestand...the club is in the middle of a 45-day stretch during which the team embarks on three 10-day road trips...over that 45-day period, the Padres are playing 29 of 41 games away from home.

**INTERLEAGUE INTRIGUE:** For this year's Interleague schedule, the Padres will play 15 games against the American League West...the Padres are 108-138 in 15-seasons of Interleague Play, including an 8-15 mark against the A's...the club is 5-2 against the American League this year and has won 11 of the last 15 Interleague games and four of the last five Interleague series dating back to last year....if the Padres can win three of their remaining eight games against the American League, they will clinch their third ever winning season of Interleague play...the only other times the Padres finished with a record above .500 against the AL were 1999 (11-4) and 2010 (9-6).

**ON THE HILL:** Ross Ohlendorf will make his first start of for the Padres this afternoon...prior to today, he made two relief outing, including 4.1 innings of one-run ball in relief of Andrew Cashner 6/9 at MIL...prior to being acquired by the Padres, he made 10 starts for Triple-A Pawtucket in the Red Sox organization, going 4-3 with a 4.61 ERA (27 ER/52.2 IP)...today's start will be his third career appearance (second start) against OAK...he has posted a 1.23 ERA (1 ER/7.1 IP) in his two outings against the A's.

**FAMILIAR FACE:** Mark Kotsay, who played for the A's from 2004-07, is a career .370 hitter (17-for-46) in 15 games against OAK...he has hit safely in 13 of the 14 games against the A's in which he has had at least one at-bat, including each of the last 12.

**WAKING THE BATS:** Over the last 16 games, the Padres offense has picked up to the tune of a .258 batting average (141-for-547) with 31 doubles, 11 triples and 17 home runs...the Friars are averaging 4.3 runs per game and 1.1 home runs per game over that stretch, with a team OPS of .776.

**OUT OF THE GATE:** Will Venable connected for his seventh career leadoff home run on Sunday vs. the Brewers...it was the second of the year for Venable and the seventh of his career...he is now tied with Quilvio Veras for first on the Padres all-time list...prior to his two leadoff homers this year, each of his previous five came during the 2011 season.

**BACK FOR THE FIRST TIME:** The Padres activated outfielder Carlos Quentin from the disabled list after he missed 49 games to start the season...he has gone 19-for-46 with 10 extra-base hits (five doubles, five homers) since joining the Friars, including three three-hit games...in 57 plate appearances since being activated, he has reached base 30 times (.526 OBP), including at least once in each game he has played.

**CABBY:** After going hitless in his first five games of the season, Everth Cabrera has hit .315 (23-for-73) with eight doubles, one triple, two home runs, eight RBI and 10 runs scored in his last 21 games dating back to 5/23...over that stretch, he is posting a .398 on-base percentage along with a .534 slugging percentage...he has also stolen nine bases in nine attempts, making him a perfect 24-for-24 between Triple-A Tucson (15-for-15) and the Padres this year.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** Yonder Alonso has hit a career-high tying two doubles six times this season, tying Tony Gwynn (1993) and Adrian Gonzalez (2007) for the most multi-double games in a season by a Padre...with his 16 doubles on the season, Alonso leads the club and all Major League rookies.

## STARTING PITCHER

### RHP - Ross Ohlendorf #59 (1-0, 3.38)

**FOR STARTERS:** The 29-year-old is set to make his first start of the season and first as a Padre in his third outing of the year today at OAK.

- Was signed by the Padres to a Major League contract on 6/4.
- In 10 starts for Triple-A Pawtucket (BOS) this season, went 4-3 with a 4.61 ERA (27 ER/52.2 IP) and 37 strikeouts against 15 walks.
- Today is the 98th outing and 65th start of his Big League career.
- Making his 14th career Interleague appearance and eighth start.
- Will be the 12th different pitcher to start a game for the Padres in 2012, the most starting pitchers used in a season for the Padres since the 2009 club had a franchise-record tying 15 different pitchers start a game (2x, also, 2002)... 11 different pitchers to start a game currently the most for any Major League club this season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned the win on 6/9 at MIL after working 4.1 innings and allowing just one run on five hits and two walks while striking out four...threw 67 pitches in the effort, 43 for strikes...came in relief of Andrew Cashner who made his first start as a Padre in that game and worked 2.1 innings...Padres scored four runs between the fifth and seventh inning to win by a score of 5-2.

**VS. THE ATHLETICS:** Making his third career appearance and second start against the A's.

- Last faced the A's during Interleague play in 2010 for PIT in a game started on 6/27/10 at the Coliseum...worked 6.0 innings and allowed two unearned runs on two hits and four walks while striking out three...Pirates fell by a score of 3-2 to the A's.
- Only other appearance against the A's also came at the Coliseum in 2008 while with the New York Yankees...worked 1.1 innings in relief on 6/11/08 for NYY, allowing one run on two hits and three walks.

### LHP - Clayton Richard #33 (3-7, 4.30)

**FOR STARTERS:** The 28-year-old is set to make his 14th start of the season... will be his 116th Big League outing and 99th career start.

- Has gone 2-2 with a 3.18 ERA (14 ER/39.2 IP) over his last six starts.
- Posted seven quality starts this season, including five of his last eight starts

**VS. THE ATHLETICS:** Making his third career appearance and second start against the Athletics.

- Tossed 1.0 inning of scoreless relief 8/17/08 at OAK and was tagged for five runs over 5.1 innings in his start 6/3/09 vs. OAK.
- Has yet to face the A's as a member of the Padres (both previous outings came with the White Sox).

**INTERLEAGUE:** Making his 13th career Interleague start and second of the season.

- Last season, went 2-2 with a 4.50 ERA (11 ER/22.0 IP) over four Interleague starts.
- 5-3 lifetime in Interleague games, posting a 3.48 ERA (26 ER/67.1 IP) 12 games (all starts).

**HOME AND AWAY:** Making his eighth road start of the season tonight...is 1-4 with a 5.73 ERA (28 ER/44.0 IP) and a .294 (52-for-177) opponents average in seven starts on the road this season, compared to 2-3 with a 2.72 ERA (12 ER/39.2 IP) and a .238 (36-for-151) opponents batting average over six starts at home.

**KEEP IT IN THE PARK:** Allowed 10 home runs total on the year...in his start on 6/6 vs. SF, allowed a solo home run to Gregor Blanco, his first home run allowed to a left-handed hitter since 9/26/10 vs. CIN (Joey Votto).
