#### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The Oakland Athletics had their season-high five-game winning streak snapped...are now 12-19 since May 15 after going 19-17 over the first 36 games...are 2-1 on this nine-game homestand against San Diego (2-1), Los Angeles (three games) and San Francisco (three games).
- Bartolo Colon left the game with a right oblique strain...tossed 2.0 innings, his shortest start since he went 0.2 innings July 14, 2011 at Toronto...it is the shortest start by an Athletic this season (previous: 2.1, Colon, May 10 vs. Detroit).
- Pedro Figueroa tossed a season-high 3.0 innings (previous: 1.2, May 4 at Tampa Bay).
- Collin Cowgill (1 for 4) is batting .396 (21 for 53) over his last 14 games after hitting .128 over his first 16 contests.
- Coco Crisp (2 for 5) is 12 for 37 (.324) over his last 10 games after going 5 for 47 (.106) over his first 14 games after being reinstated from the disabled list May 21.
- Jonny Gomes (3 for 4) had a season-high tying three hits (also May 17 at Texas)...is batting .438 (7 for 16) in nine games in June after hitting .222 in 22 games in May...is a .340 (17 for 50) career hitter against San Diego.
- Jemile Weeks (0 for 5) is batting .196 (10 for 51) over his last 13 games after hitting safely in each of his previous nine contests (13 for 36, .361).

#### **SAN DIEGO NOTES**

- The San Diego Padres are 6-3 in interleague play and have won 12 of their last 17 games against the American League...went 5-4 on this nine-game road trip to Milwaukee (1-2), Seattle (3-0) and Oakland (1-2), their first winning road trip of the season...begin a six-game homestand against Texas (three games) and Seattle (three games) tomorrow.
- Clayton Richard tossed a season-high 7.2 innings (previous: 7.1, May 21 at St. Louis)...is 3-2 with a 2.66 ERA (14 er in 47.1 ip) over his last seven starts...is 6-3 with a 3.12 ERA (26 er in 75.0 ip) in 13 career interleague games, all starts.
- Everth Cabrera (1 for 3) is batting .304 (24 for 79) over his last 23 games.
- Chris Denorfia (1 for 3) is on a season-high nine-game hitting streak (13 for 33, .394)...is batting .338 (26 for 77) on the road compared to .222 (16 for 72) at home.
- Carlos Quentin (1 for 4) is 21 for 52 (.404) in 16 games since being reinstated from the disabled list May 28.
- Will Venable (1 for 4) is batting .324 (34 for 105) on the road compared to .202 (18 for 89) at home.
