OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics recorded their seventh shutout of the season...are 10-6 over the last 16 games after losing a season-high nine consecutive contests...are 3-1 on this nine-game homestand against San Diego (2-1), Los Angeles (1-0) and San Francisco (three games).
- The A's had a season-high 10 walks (previous: 9, May 29 at Minnesota)...it is their first game of 10 or more walks since they also had 10 walks Sept. 14, 2008 vs. Texas.
- Brandon McCarthy is 3-0 with a 1.35 ERA (3 er in 20.0 ip) in three starts since being reinstated from the disabled list June 2...extended his winning streak to six games, an ongoing career-high...is 6-0 with a 1.96 ERA (10 er in 46.0 ip) over his last seven starts.
- Coco Crisp (2 for 3) had a season-high three stolen bases and has now been successful in each of his last 36 stolen base attempts, which is the longest streak of consecutive stolen bases without a caught stealing in Athletics history...is 14 for 40 (.350) over his last 11 games after going 5 for 47 (.106) over his first 14 games after being reinstated from the disabled list May 21.
- Brandon Inge (0 for 4) is on a 0 for 14 streak...is now 1 for 20 over his last five games after going 13 for 32 (.406) with two home runs and 12 RBI over his previous nine contests.
- Josh Reddick (0 for 4) struck out a career-high tying four times (also Aug. 4, 2009 at Tampa Bay)...is on a 0 for 15 streak.
- Seth Smith (1 for 3) is batting .424 (14 for 33) over his last 11 games...is batting .340 (34 for 100) with 17 of his 23 RBI in 33 games in the outfield compared to .178 (13 for 73) in 23 games at designated hitter.
- Jemile Weeks (0 for 2) had a career-high three walks (previous: 2, nine times; last: June 15, 2012 vs. San Diego).

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Dodgers were shut out for the third time this season...are 5-5 in interleague play...are 9-14 all-time against the A's during the regular season, including 2-10 in Oakland...are 0-1 on this nine-game road trip to Oakland (0-1), Los Angeles (three games) and San Francisco (three games).
- Aaron Harang allowed a career-high eight walks (previous: 7, July 8, 2008 at Chicago-NL)...the walks are the most by a Dodgers starting pitcher since
 Edwin Jackson also allowed eight walks Sept. 27, 2003 at San Francisco...is 4-3 with a 4.59 ERA (25 er in 49.0 ip) in nine starts on the road compared to
 1-1 with a 2.51 ERA (9 er in 32.1 ip) in five starts at home.
- Andre Eithier (1 for 4) is batting .190 (12 for 63) in the month of June after hitting .366 in May.
- A.J. Ellis (0 for 3) is batting .231 (9 for 39) in June after hitting .333 in May.
- Tony Gwynn Jr. (1 for 3) is batting .284 (23 for 81) on the road compared to .239 (22 for 92) at home...is 8 for 14 (.571) in his career against the A's.
- Juan Uribe (0 for 3) is batting .071 (2 for 28) on the road compared to .301 (22 for 73) at home...is batting .203 (29 for 143) in his career against the A's.
