#### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The Oakland Athletics have won seven of the last eight games...are 11-6 over the last 17 games after losing a season-high nine consecutive contests...are 15-9 all-time against the Dodgers during the regular season, including 11-2 in Oakland...are 4-1 on this nine-game homestand against San Diego (2-1), Los Angeles (2-0) and San Francisco (three games).
- Tommy Milone tossed his first career complete game, the first by an Athletic this season...is 5-1 with a 0.99 ERA (5 er in 45.2 ip) in six starts at home compared to 2-4 with a 7.42 ERA (36 er in 43.2 ip) in eight starts on the road.
- Yoenis Cespedes (2 for 4) made his first career start at designated hitter, his first game since leaving the game after the first inning a week ago tonight at Colorado...is 12 for 30 (.400) with six RBI in nine starts since being reinstated from the 15-day disabled list June 1.
- Brandon Moss (1 for 4) hit a home run in the eighth inning and now has seven home runs in his first 13 games with the A's...10 of his 12 hits this year are for extra bases (three doubles, seven home runs).
- Cliff Pennington (2 for 4) is 17 for 51 (.333) over his last 14 games after going 3 for 41 (.073) over his previous 13 contests...is batting .315 (17 for 54) in 14 interleague games.
- Josh Reddick (0 for 4) is on a 0 for 19 streak...the longest hitless streak of his career is 20 at bats from Sept. 19, 2009 to April 20, 2010.
- Seth Smith (1 for 3) is batting .417 (15 for 36) with 11 RBI over his last 12 games...is batting .340 (35 for 103) with 18 of his 24 RBI in 34 games in the outfield compared to .178 (13 for 73) in 23 games at designated hitter.
- The A's raised over \$24,000 at today's 13<sup>th</sup> Annual MUG Root Beer Float Day with all proceeds benefiting the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation...since 2003, the A's have raised over \$353,000 for the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation through Root Beer Float Day.

- The Los Angeles Dodgers are 5-6 in interleague play...are 9-15 all-time against the A's during the regular season, including 2-11 in Oakland...are 0-2 on this nine-game road trip to Oakland (0-2), Los Angeles (three games) and San Francisco (three games).
- Nathan Eovaldi is 0-1 with a 2.00 ERA (4 er in 18.0 ip) in three interleague starts...1-3 with a 2.93 ERA (13 er in 40.0 ip) in eight career games, seven starts, on the road.
- Andre Ethier (0 for 4) is batting .179 (12 for 67) in the month of June after hitting .366 in May.
- A.J. Ellis (0 for 3) is batting .214 (9 for 42) in June after hitting .333 in May.
- Jerry Hairston Jr. (1 for 4) is batting .309 (21 for 68) in 23 games since returning from the disabled list on May 25.
