#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have four walk-off wins, which is one more than their total from last year...have won eight of the last nine games, including a season-high five-game winning streak that was snapped Sunday...are 12-6 over the last 18 games after losing a season-high nine consecutive contests...are 5-1 on this nine-game homestand against San Diego (2-1), Los Angeles (3-0) and San Francisco (three games).
- Travis Blackley** tossed a career-high 8.0 innings (previous: 6.0 ip, June 15, 2012 vs. San Diego)...is 1-1 with a 2.57 ERA (6 er in 21.0 ip) in five career interleague appearances, including three starts.
- The A's have allowed 22 hits over the past six games, which is fewest allowed by an A's team over a six-game span since at least 1918 (previous: 25, May 10-17, 1963)...allowed eight hits this series, which is the fewest hits allowed by an A's team in a three-game series since 1918 (previous: 10, May 7-9, 2010 vs. Tampa Bay).
- Yoenis Cespedes** (1 for 4) hit his first career walk-off home run...is batting .375 (24 for 64) with six of his seven home runs at home compared to .197 (15 for 76) on the road.
- Coco Crisp** (1 for 3) was caught stealing in the first inning, snapping his streak of 36 consecutive stolen bases without a caught stealing...it was the longest such streak in Athletics history...has batted leadoff in each of his last seven games and is 10 for 25 (.400) over that span.
- Jonny Gomes** (1 for 3) is batting .409 (9 for 22) in 11 games in June after hitting .222 with one home run and seven RBI in 22 games in May...is 9 for 25 (.360) in 11 interleague games.
- Brandon Inge** (0 for 1) is on a 0 for 15 streak...is 1 for 21 over his last six games after going 13 for 32 (.406) over his previous nine contests.
- Derek Norris** (0 for 3) was recalled from Triple-A Sacramento today and made his Major League debut.

- The Los Angeles Dodgers are 5-7 in interleague play...are 9-16 all-time against the A's during the regular season, including 2-12 in Oakland...are 0-3 on this nine-game road trip to Oakland (0-2), Los Angeles (three games) and San Francisco (three games).
- Clayton Kershaw** is 5-3 with a 3.02 ERA (32 er in 95.1 ip) in 15 career interleague starts...that includes 0-0 with a 0.66 ERA (1 er in 13.2 ip) in two starts against the A's.
- Ivan De Jesus** (0 for 3) is batting .200 (3 for 15) in June after hitting .353 in May...is 4 for 19 (.211) on the road and 5 for 13 (.381) at home.
- Andre Ethier** (0 for 3) is batting .171 (12 for 70) in June after hitting .366 in May.
- Dee Gordon** (0 for 4) is on a 0 for 12 streak.
- Tony Gwynn Jr.** (0 for 3) is batting .196 (11 for 56) in June after hitting .291 in May.
- Juan Uribe** (0 for 3) is batting .088 (3 for 34) on the road compared to .301 (22 for 73) at home.
