OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics had their three-game winning streak snapped...are now 8-7 in games decided in the last at bat...are 5-2 on this nine-game homestand against San Diego (2-1), Los Angeles (3-0) and San Francisco (0-1).
- The A's allowed eight hits and have now allowed 36 hits in the last eight games, which is the fewest by an A's team over an eight-game span since at least 1916 (previous: 38, twice; last: May 31-June 7, 1968).
- Jarrod Parker** allowed one run in six innings and has now allowed one run or fewer in eight of his 12 career starts...is 2-1 with a 1.97 ERA (7 er in 32.0 ip) over his past five starts...started today on seven days rest and is 2-0 with a 1.07 ERA (4 er in 33.2 ip) in five starts this year on five days rest or more.
- Coco Crisp** (1 for 5) stole two bases, his third game with multiple stolen bases of the season and 27th of his career...has batted leadoff in each of his last eight games and is 11 for 30 (.367) with six stolen bases over that span.
- Brandon Inge** (0 for 2) is on a 0 for 17 streak...is 1 for 23 over his last seven games after going 13 for 32 (.406) in his previous nine contests.
- Josh Reddick** (2 for 3) snapped his 0 for 19 streak with a single in the first inning...the streak was one short of the longest hitless streak of his career (20, Sept. 19, 2009-April 20, 2010).
- Kurt Suzuki** (1 for 4) snapped his 0 for 17 streak with a single in the eighth inning.

SAN FRANCISCO NOTES

- The San Francisco Giants are 9-2 in the first game of a series over their past 11 series...snapped their seven-game losing streak in Oakland...have won nine of the last 13 games against the A's...are 3-4 on this nine-game road trip against Seattle (1-2), Los Angeles (1-2) and Oakland (1-0).
- Tim Lincecum** did not factor in the decision and is now winless in his past 10 starts, which is the longest winless streak of his career...is 0-6 with a 6.23 ERA (39 er in 56.1 ip) over that span.
- Brandon Belt** (1 for 2) hit a two-run double in the ninth inning...is on a career-high 10-game hitting streak (13 for 31, .419).
- Gregor Blanco** (2 for 4) snapped his 0 for 13 streak with a single in the third inning...had a career-high tying three stolen bases (also Aug. 13, 2010 at New York-AL).
- Buster Posey** (0 for 3) had his eight-game hitting streak snapped...batted .313 (10 for 32) during the streak.
- Ryan Theriot** (0 for 5) struck out a career-high four times.
