OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics committed four errors, their most in a game since they also committed four errors Aug. 13, 2011 vs. Texas...have lost the past two games after winning three in a row...are 5-3 on this nine-game homestand against San Diego (2-1), Los Angeles (3-0) and San Francisco (0-2).
- Tonight's time of game was 4:15, which is tied for the second longest nine inning game in Oakland history (also May 31, 2002 at Tampa Bay)...the longest nine inning game in Oakland history is 4:31, Aug. 25, 2011 at New York.
- Coco Crisp** (2 for 4) was ejected by home plate umpire Tony Randazzo in the sixth inning...has batted leadoff in each of his last nine games and is 13 for 34 (.382) with five multiple hit games over that span.
- Brandon Moss** (0 for 4) committed a career-high three errors, all in the sixth inning...that ties the Major League record for errors by a first baseman in an inning (seventh time, last: Jack Clark, May 25, 1987).
- Derek Norris** (2 for 5) recorded his first Major League hit, a single in the fifth inning...had a RBI single in the ninth inning, his first career RBI.
- Josh Reddick** (3 for 4) hit a two-run home run in the first inning and has now homered in back-to-back games...added a two-out RBI single in the second inning for his fourth career game of three or more RBI, his third this season.

SAN FRANCISCO NOTES

- The San Francisco Giants have won the past two games after losing four of the previous five...have won 10 of their last 14 games against the A's...are 4-4 on this nine-game road trip against Seattle (1-2), Los Angeles (1-2) and Oakland (2-0).
- Madison Bumgarner** allowed a career-high tying 11 hits (also Aug. 20, 2011 at Houston)...is 4-0 with a 3.03 ERA (12 er in 35.2 ip) in five starts in June after going 1-3 with a 3.71 ERA in five starts in May...is 2-2 with a 4.79 ERA (19 er in 35.2 ip) in six career interleague starts.
- Brandon Belt** (2 for 3) is on a career-high 11-game hitting streak and is batting .455 (15 for 33) with four home runs and 12 RBI over that span...had a season-high tying three RBI (third time, last: June 13 vs. Houston).
- Buster Posey** (2 for 3) hit a two-run home run in the seventh inning, his team-leading ninth of the season...had a season-high three runs scored.
