SAN FRANCISCO GIANTS MEDIA NOTES

June 23, 2012

Road Game #37 (18-18) San Francisco Giants (39-32) at Oakland Athletics (34-37) Oakland-Alameda County Coliseum

'S GAME...The San Francisco Giants visit the Oakland Athletics in the middle game of this 3-game series...Giants' left-hander Madison Bumgarner (8-4, 2.92) will face A's right-hander Tyson Ross (2-6, 6.11).

- THE GIANTS...came from behind to defeat the A's 5-4 last night...it marked SF's 15th come-from-behind win this season and just the 2nd time that they won a game when trailing after 8.0 innings (also: April 26 at Cincinnati).
 - Are now 3-4 on this 10-day, 9-game road trip to SEA (1-2), LAA (1-2) and OAK (1-0).
 - Despite last night's win, have still lost 5 of their last 8 games.
 - Enter today's game in 2nd place in the NL West, 3.0 games behind 1st-place LA.

INSIDE THE SERIES... Since Interleague Play began in 1997, the A's and Giants have faced one another every year twice...Oakland owns the upper hand, having gone 46-44 (.511) against San Francisco in the all-time series...however, the Giants have won 9 of their last 13 games against the A's.

ON THE MOUND...LHP Madison Bumgarner enters today's game having won his last 3 decisions...in his last 4 starts, the southpaw has gone 3-0 with a 2.43 ERA (8er, 29.2ip).

LET'S PUT TOGETHER A STREAK...The Giants haven't won 2 consecutive games since defeating Houston in the 1st 2 games of that series from June 12-13.

A GIANT HAPPY BIRTHDAY... Happy Birthday to Giants hitting coach Hensley (Bam Bam) Meulens, who turns 45 years old today.

BRANDON BELTING...IF Brandon Belt enters today's game having hit safely in a careerbest 10 games, batting .419 (13-for-31) with 3 2Bs, 3 HRs and 9 RBI during this stretch.

CASILLA CLOSING...RHP Santiago Casilla sealed his 20th save of the season last night... he's now just 1 save shy of the NL lead, currently held by Atlanta's Craig Kimbrel (21)... Casilla has gone 20-for-21 in save chances this season and has converted each of his last 15 opportunities.

CATCH US IF YOU CAN...San Francisco stole a season-high 4 bases last night (2nd time this year with 4 stolen bases in a game)...SF has been successful in 19 of their last 21 stolen base attempts...their 58 stolen bases overall are the 3rd-most in the NL...the Giants are just 27 stolen bases away from matching their season total from last year (85).

DID YOU KNOW?...Giants pitchers have allowed the 2nd-fewest amount of home runs in the Majors this season, surrendering 54 clouts in 71 games (Nationals have allowed the fewest with 50).

WITH RISP...The Giants are hitting just .222 (143-for-645) with runners in scoring position this year, the 3rd-lowest figure in the NL...however, they've been much better as of late, batting .271 (39-for-144) in their last 15 games.

WITH THE GLOVES...The Giants' 60 errors this season are the most in the National League and tied with the Rays for the 2nd-most in the Majors behind Baltimore (62).

CLOSE ONES...San Francisco has 15 one-run wins this season, tied with the Twins for the 3rd-most in the Majors...only the Dodgers (18) and Pirates (17) have more such victories.

ON TAP...Following this 3-game series with the A's, the Giants will return home for the start of a 7-game homestand against a pair of 1st-place teams, the Dodgers (Monday-Wednesday) and Reds (Thursday-Sunday).

THIS DATE IN GIANTS HISTORY

June 23, 2007 - In a 4 hour and 34 minute game, Nate Schierholtz provided the game-winning run against the Yankees in the 13th inning with a bloop single to have the Giants pull ahead 6-5.

BUMGARNER AT A GLANCE

- 22-year-old will be making his 15th start of the 2012 season...will mark his 67th start and 70th career appearance.
- His 8 wins are tied for the 7th-most in the National League.
- Has won his last 3 decisions.

MOST RECENT OUTING

- Received a no-decision in his last outing at Seattle last Sunday, as he tossed 8.0 innings, allowing 1 ER on 3 hits and 1 BB with 4 Ks.
- Threw 21 1st-pitch strikes to the 29 hitters he faced and retired 18-consecutive batters from the 2nd to the 8th inning.

CATCHING HIS BREATH

• Has gone 5-1 with a 2.08 ERA (10er, 43.1ip) in 6 outings this season when starting on 5 days of rest.

MAY VS. JUNE

• Is 3-0 with a 2.43 ERA (8er, 29.2ip) in 4 starts this month after going 1-3 with a 3.71 ERA (14er, 34.0ip) in 5 May assignments.

IN INTERLEAGUE

• In his last 3 Interleague starts he's 1-0 while fashioning a 1.21 ERA (3er, 22.1ip)...overall, he's gone 1-2 with a 4.55 figure (15er, 29.2ip) in 5 starts.

INNING EATER

- Has tossed at least 6.0 innings in all but 1 start this season (his very 1st start of 2012 he logged 4.0 innings).
- His 95.2 innings pitched are tied for the 5th-most the NL this season.
- Owns 9 quality starts.

TOUGH ON SOUTHPAWS

- Ranks 3rd among NL starters holding by left-handed batters to a .157 clip (13-for-83) with just 3 extra base hits (2 2Bs and 1 3B) this season.
- Lefties are slugging only .205 off him this year, which is 2nd-best among NL starters.
- Over his last 5 games, left-handed hitters are just 3-for-41 (.073) off him.

WITH RISP

• Is tied for 7th in the NL by holding opponents to a .167 clip (13-for-78) Last Home Run: w/RISP...opponents are just 5-for-33 (.152) off him with RISP in his last 7 games.

VS. OAKLAND

• Has never faced the Athletics during the regular season.

AT THE PLATE

- Is 3-for-32 (.125) in 2012...hit his 1st career home run on June 12 vs. Houston.
- Batted in the 8th spot in the order on May 16 vs. St. Louis, just the 2nd time in Giants franchise history that the starting pitcher had batted in the 8th spot in the order (also: May 20, 2010 at AZ; Lincecum).
- Owns a lifetime .136 avg. (18-for-132) with 6 2Bs, HR, 8 RBI and 18 sacrifices.

CAREER NOTES

- Has gone 25-2 (.926) with a 2.18 ERA (54er, 222.2ip) when the Giants score at least 3 runs of support for him (32 starts)...SF is 27-5 (.844) in those contests.
- Has recorded 7 double-digit strikeout games in his career including careerhigh 13 Sept. 5, 2011 at San Diego.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: Matt Cain

- 2-time NL All-Star (2009 and 2011) will be making his 15th start of the 2012 season...has won his last 8 starts, a new career-high and the longest such win streak in Giants history since Rick Reuschel won 8 consecutive starts in 1989...hasn't had a losing decision since May 1 vs. Miami... pitching for the 1st time since his perfect game last Monday night against the Angels in Anaheim, Cain had his shortest start of the season, working 5.0 innings while allowing 3 runs on 6 hits with 4 walks and 4 strikeouts... however, earned his 9th-straight win in SF's 5-3 victory
- <u>vs. Oakland</u>: Will make his 10th career start against the A's...has gone 3-5 with a 2.19 ERA (16er, 65.2ip) and 3 complete games vs. Oakland... in his last 4 starts against the A's, Cain has gone 2-1 with a 0.87 ERA (3er, 31.0ip) and .183 avg. against (20-for-109).
