Road Game #38 (19-18) San Francisco Giants (40-32) at Oakland Athletics (34-38) Oakland-Alameda County Coliseum

<u>'S GAME</u>...The San Francisco Giants visit the Oakland Athletics in the final game of this 3-game series...Giants' right-hander Matt Cain (9-2, 2.34) will face A's right-hander A.J. Griffin (Major League Debut).

THE GIANTS...came from behind for the 2nd-straight day to defeat the A's 9-8 yesterday.

• Are now 4-4 on this 10-day, 9-game road trip to SEA (1-2), LAA (1-2) and OAK (2-0).

- Have won 3 of their last 5 games.
- Enter today's game in 2nd place in the NL West, 3.0 games behind 1st-place LA.

A FIRST FOR EVERYTHING...A victory for the Giants today and they can sweep the A's here in Oakland, which would be the club's 1st sweep of 3-or-more games here at Oakland-Alameda Coliseum...the Giants have broomed just one opponent this season, sweeping the Cubs in a 4-game series at AT&T Park to kick off this month (June 1-4).

KEEP IT GOING...RHP Matt Cain enters today's game having won his last 8 starts, a new career-high and the longest such win streak in Giants history since Rick Reuschel won 8 consecutive starts in 1989...no pitcher in SF-era history has ever won 9-straight starts in a single season...the last pitcher in Giants franchise history with 9 consecutive winning starts in a single campaign was Sal Maglie in 1952.

CAIN VS. THE A'S...In his 1st 5 career starts against the A's, Matt Cain went 1-4 with a 3.38 ERA (13er, 34.2ip) and 1 complete game...in his last 4 starts against them, he's 2-1 with a 0.87 ERA (3er, 31.0ip) and 2 complete games.

BRANDON BELTING...IF Brandon Belt enters today's game with a career-best 11 game hitting streak, the 3rd-longest active streak in the National League...during this stretch, he's raised his batting avg. 49 points from .224 to his current .273 figure, while batting .441 (15-for-34) with 3 2Bs, 4 HRs and 12 RBI.

40 WINS...The Giants reached the 40-win plateau yesterday and are now 1 of only 3 NL teams with 40-or-more wins this season, joining the Dodgers (43) and Nationals (41).

CAN YOU MAKE IT THREE?... The Giants haven't won 3 consecutive games since the start of this month when they swept the Cubs at home in a 4-game series, June 1-4.

TOO CLOSE...San Francisco has 16 one-run wins this season, the 3rd-most in the Majors... only the Dodgers (18) and Pirates (17) have more such victories.

TIGHT ONES...Of the Giants' 72 games this season, 53 of have been decided by 3 runsor-fewer, including 15 of 21 contests this month...only the Nationals have played more games overall this season that have been decided by that many runs (55 games).

LEADING THE WAY...The Giants lead the Majors with 28 saves this season and rank 3rd overall with a 84.8 save percentage (28-for-33 in saves chances)...6 different Giants pitchers have earned at least 1 save this year (Casilla with 20, Romo with 3, Hensley with 2, Affeldt, Lopez and Wilson all with 1).

CATCH US IF YOU CAN...SF has been successful in 19 of their last 21 stolen base attempts...their 58 stolen bases overall are the 3rd-most in the NL...the Giants are just 27 stolen bases away from matching their season total from last year (85).

DID YOU KNOW?...LHP Madison Bumgarner earned his 9th win yesterday despite allowing 11 hits in 6.0 innings pitched...the last Giants pitcher to win a game despite allowing at least 11 hits in no more than 6.0 innings was Noah Lowry on Aug. 24, 2007 (he gave up 12 hits in 5.0 innings in an 11-6 Giants win over the Brewers) (Elias).

ON TAP...Following today's game with the A's, the Giants will return home for the start of a 7-game homestand against a pair of 1st-place teams, the Dodgers (Monday-Wednesday) and Reds (Thursday-Sunday).

CAIN AT A GLANCE

- 2-time NL All-Star (2009 and 2011) will be making his 15th start of the 2012 season...will mark his 219th career appearance and his 218th start.
- SF has won his last 9 starts and are 11-3 overall in his outings this year.
- Signed a 5-year extension with a club/vesting player option for the 2018 season on April 2.

CAIN CRUISING

- Has won his last 8 starts, a new career-high and the longest such win streak in Giants history since Rick Reuschel won 8 consecutive starts in 1989.
- No pitcher in SF-era history has ever won 9-straight starts in a single season...the last pitcher in Giants franchise history with 9 consecutive winning starts in a single campaign was Sal Maglie in 1952
- The record since 1919 is 11 consecutive wins by starter Hal Schumacher from May 19-July 10, 1935.
- Cain hasn't had a losing decision since May 1 vs. Miami.

ON THE LEADERBOARD

- Cain's 9 wins are tied for the 4th-most in the NL...only NYM's R.A. Dickey (11 wins), PHI's Cole Hamels (10) and STL's Lance Lynn (10) have more.
- Is 2nd in the NL with an opponents avg. against with RISP of .148...also ranks 4th in the league with 100 strikeouts, 4th in innings pitched, 5th in opponents avg. against (.199) and 7th with a 2.34 ERA.

LAST TIME OUT

- Pitching for the 1st time since his perfect game last Monday night against the Angels in Anaheim, Cain had his shortest start of the season, working 5.0 innings while allowing 3 runs on 6 hits with 4 walks and 4 strikeouts... however, earned his 9th-straight win in SF's 5-3 victory.
- His 1st hit allowed came to his 1st batter faced, Mike Trout, snapping his consecutive batters faced streak at 32.

PERFECT START

- Tossed the 22nd perfect game in Major League Baseball history on June 13 vs. Houston...it was the 1st perfect game in the 130th-season history of the Giants franchise.
- It was the 2nd perfect game of 2012, joining Chicago White Sox starter Philip Humber's perfecto on April 21 at Seattle, marking just the 3rd time in ML history that two perfect games have been recorded in the same season (1880 - Monte Ward, Lee Richmond; and 2010 - Roy Halladay, Dallas Braden).

INNINGS EATER

Snapped his streak of working at least 6.0 innings in each of his 1st 13 starts this season after tossing 5.0 frames in his last outing at Anaheim...it was the longest such streak to start a campaign by a Giants pitcher since Atlee Hammaker started the 1983 season with 21-straight starts of at least 6.0 innings in each start.

VS. OAKLAND

- Will make his 10th career start against the A's...has gone 3-5 with a 2.19
- ERA (16er, 65.2ip) and 3 complete games vs. Oakland.

 In his last 4 starts against the A's, Cain has gone 2-1 with a 0.87 ERA (3er,
- 31.0ip) and .183 avg. against (20-for-109).

 Has allowed 1 earned run or fewer in 6 of his 9 starts.

THIS AND THAT

- Has crested the 30-start barrier in each of his 1st 6 full seasons.
- Has never missed a start due to injury and has been skipped in rotation just once (May, 2006).
- Has received the 2nd-lowest run support avg. in Majors since his 1st full season in 2006, averaging 4.00 runs per game (John Lannan, 3.98).
- Has gone 66-9 (.880) when the Giants score at least 3 runs of support for him (106 starts).

TOMORROW'S STARTER: Barry Zito

- 2002 AL Cy Young Award winner and 3-time AL All-Star (2002-03, 2006) will be making his 15th start of the season...has posted a 5-5 record with a 4.35 ERA (39er, 80.2ip) and 1 complete game in 14 starts this season.. earned his 3rd-consecutive loss on Tuesday night against the Angels in Anaheim in SF's 12-5 defeat...was tagged for 8 runs on 9 hits in just 3.1 innings, his 2nd-shortest outing of 2012...gave up 4 runs in the 1st including a 3-run HR to Albert Pujols, and allowed 3 runs in the 4th.
- vs. Los Angeles: Will make his 23rd career appearance vs. Los Angeles his 22nd start...has posted a 6-9 record with a 3.99 ERA (59er, 133.0ip in his 22 outings...faced the Dodgers once already this season on May in LA and suffered the loss after giving up 3 runs on 8 hits in 6.0 innings

ADDITIONAL INFO ON CAIN'S PERFECT GAME

- Cain fanned 14 batters and threw 125 pitches (86 strikes) in the game.. the 14 strikeouts were a career-high for Cain and tied the record for most strikeouts in a perfect game, set by Sandy Koufax (Sept. 9, 1965). It was also the highest strikeout total in a no-hitter since Nolan Ryan fanned 16 Blue Jays on May 1, 1991.

- His 125 pitches were the most ever in a perfect game.

 Cain threw a one-baserunner game earlier this year against Pittsburgh where the only baserunner was the opposing pitcher...Cain's the 2nd pitcher ever to have a perfect game and a 'nearly perfect' game in the same year (Roy Halladay did it in 2010, if you count his postseason
- no-hitter as the 1-baserunner game). Cain's performance marked the 5th no-hitter of the 2012 season, joining Humber, Jered Weaver (May 2), Johan Santana (June 1) and
- the combined Mariners no-hitter (June 8). Cain's perfect game marked the 14th no-hitter in Giants' franchis history, the 6th in SF-era history (since 1958).
