OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics recorded their sixth walk-off win of the year, which is twice as many as they had last year...are 18-12 over the last 30 games (since June 2) after losing a season-high nine consecutive contests...have won 10 of the last 13 home games and are now 21-19 at home compared to 19-23 on the road...are 2-0 on this six-game homestand against Boston (2-0) and Seattle (three games) that leads into the All-Star Break.
- The A's have homered in each of the past 14 games (19 home runs total)...that is the longest such streak by an A's team since April 27-May 12, 2004 when they also did it in 14 straight games.
- Bartolo Colon** allowed one walk and has now walked one batter or fewer in 11 of his 16 starts...has issued just 17 free passes for the season...is 8-11 with a 3.98 ERA (72 er in 162.2 ip) in 26 career appearances, 25 starts, against Boston.
- Chris Carter** (2 for 4) was recalled from Triple-A Sacramento Friday and is 5 for 11 (.455) with two home runs and two RBI in three games since then.
- Coco Crisp** (2 for 4) recorded his third career game-ending RBI...it is the first walk-off sacrifice fly by an Athletic since Dan Johnson did so May 15, 2007 vs. Kansas City...hit his second leadoff home run of the season (also June 27 at Seattle) and the sixth of his career...has batted leadoff in each of his last 18 games and is 22 for 68 (.324) over that span.
- Brandon Moss** (1 for 1) hit a game-tying pinch-hit RBI single in the ninth inning.
- The A's and Brandon McCarthy raised \$10,066 tonight for Colorado Springs, which is currently fighting massive fires that have destroyed hundreds of homes and displaced thousands of residents...McCarthy, who attended Cheyenne Mountain High School in Colorado Springs, signed autographs with Jarrod Parker for donations...there was also a silent auction, with proceeds benefiting local charities and fire victims.

BOSTON NOTES

- The Boston Red Sox are 7-19 in their last 26 games in Oakland...are 2-4 on this seven-game road trip to Seattle (2-2) and Oakland (0-2).
- Jon Lester** had a season-high tying nine strikeouts (also June 10 vs. Washington)...the strikeouts match the most by a Boston pitcher this year (seventh time)...is 5-3 with a 3.86 ERA (36 er in 84.0 ip) over his last 13 starts...is 3-2 with a 3.04 ERA (18 er in 53.1 ip) in eight starts on the road and a 2-3 with a 5.60 ERA (34 er in 54.2 ip) in nine starts at home this season...is 3-3 with a 4.15 ERA (26 er in 56.1 ip) in 10 starts in his career against Oakland.
- Adrian Gonzalez** (2 for 4) is on a season-high 14-game hitting streak (21 for 59, .356)...that matches the longest hitting streak by a Red Sox this year (Pedroia, April 29-May 13).
- Ryan Kalish** (1 for 4) is on a career-high tying five-game hitting streak (5 for 17, .294).
- David Ortiz** (1 for 3) is batting .306 (22 for 72) over his past 21 games.
- Jarrod Saltalamacchia** (1 for 4) hit his career-high tying 16th home run of the year (also 2011)...that is the most among Major League players who primarily play catcher.
