OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics recorded their eighth "walk-off" win of the season, which is five more than last year...are now 16-10 in games decided in the seventh inning or later, including 12-9 in the last at bat...the 12 last at bat wins are second most in the American League (Baltimore, 14)...are 6-2 in extra inning games...have a 43-43 record at the All-Star Break, the first time they have been .500 or better at the break since 2008 when they were 51-44...went 5-1 on this six-game homestand against Boston (3-0) and Seattle (2-1) that leads into the All-Star Break.
- Today's 13-inning game was the A's second longest of the season (14 innings, April 25 vs. Chicago-AL).
- The A's did not hit a home run, snapping their streak of 17 consecutive games with one or more home runs (22 home runs total over that span)...that was tied for the fourth longest streak in Oakland history.
- Bartolo Colon** tossed a season-high 8.2 innings (previous: 8.1 ip, April 29 at Baltimore)...is 2-2 with a 2.45 ERA (10 er in 36.2 ip) over his last six starts...did not walk a batter and has now walked one batter or fewer in 12 of his 17 starts (17 walks total).
- A's starting pitchers have allowed two earned runs or fewer in 20 of the last 23 games and are 8-5 with a 2.06 ERA (33 er in 144.1 ip) over that span...have a 3.67 ERA (211 er in 517.1 ip) for the season, which is the **lowest in the American League**.
- Yoenis Cespedes** (1 for 2) left the game in the fourth inning with a left thumb sprain.
- Josh Reddick** (2 for 5) hit a "walk-off" RBI double, his second career "walk-off" hit (also Aug. 7, 2011 vs. New York-AL)...now has three consecutive multiple hit games (6 for 13, .462).

SEATTLE NOTES

- The Seattle Mariners are 6-4 in extra inning games...have lost nine of the last 14 games...are 20-26 on the road for the season...went 1-2 on this three-game road trip to Oakland that leads into the All-Star Break.
- Today's 13-inning game was the Mariners longest of the season (previous: 12 innings, June 2 at Chicago-AL).
- Felix Hernandez** is 2-0 with a 1.75 ERA (7 er in 36.0 ip) over his past five starts...is 13-5 with a 2.63 ERA (51 er in 174.1 ip) in 25 career starts against the A's, including 1-1 with a 3.10 ERA (10 er in 29.0 ip) in four starts this year.
- Ichiro Suzuki** (2 for 6) is a .357 (158 for 442) career hitter in Oakland, which ranks first all-time at the Coliseum (minimum 120 PA)...is a .327 (297 for 909) career hitter in 214 games against the A's overall.
