## **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The Oakland Athletics had their four-game winning streak snapped, which was one short of the season high of five (twice, last: July 1-6)...are 0-1 on this six-game homestand against Texas (0-1) and New York (four games).
- Bartolo Colon is 2-3 with a 2.89 ERA (14 er in 43.2 ip) over his last seven starts...has walked one batter or fewer in 13 of his 18 starts and has issued just 18 free passes for the season...allowed a solo home run to Beltre in the fourth inning...has now allowed 14 home runs for the season, all of which have been solo shots.
- Yoenis Cespedes (2 for 4) has four straight multiple hit games for the first time in his career (10 for 18, .556)... has hit safely in all nine of his career games against Texas (16 for 32, .500).
- Brandon Moss (1 for 3) is 10 for 30 (.333) over his last nine games after going 1 for 17 over his previous five contests.
- Josh Reddick (1 for 3) is 16 for 49 (.327) with four home runs and six RBI over his last 14 games.
- Kurt Suzuki (0 for 4) is batting .167 (19 for 114) at home compared to .254 (32 for 126) on the road.

## **TEXAS NOTES**

The Texas Rangers have won five of the last six games and are now 21-9 over the last 30 games... are 26-19 on the road this season... are 3-1 on this eight-game road trip to Seattle (2-1), Oakland (1-0) and Los Angeles (three games).

The Rangers scored six runs, snapping their streak of scoring four runs or fewer at 10 games...that was their longest such streak since they also went 10 consecutive games with four runs or less June 13-22, 1999.

Roy Oswalt is 3-1 with a 5.22 ERA (17 er in 29.1 ip) in five starts since his contracted was purchased from Triple-A Round Rock June 22...is 1-1 with a 4.00 ERA (8 er in 18.0 ip) in three career games, both starts, against the A's.

- Elvis Andrus (1 for 5) is on a six-game hitting streak (6 for 25, 240)...has struck out in a career-high 10 consecutive games.
- Adrian Beltre (1 for 5) has hit safely in nine of his last 10 games (14 for 41, .341).
- Craig Gentry (2 for 3) is batting .390 (30 for 77) over his last 30 games...is batting .435 (20 for 46) against American League West teams.
- Michael Young (1 for 4) has hit safely in 13 of his last 15 games against the A's (20 for 57, .351).
