



## Texas Rangers (55-35) at Oakland A's (46-44)

**WINS AND LOSSES:** The Rangers and A's conclude this brief series on Wednesday afternoon...Texas is 3-1 on this 8-game, 10-day road trip to Seattle (2-1), Oakland (1-0), and Anaheim (3 games)...club has won 2 straight and 5 of the last 6 games after losing 5 in a row...Rangers have won 21 of 30 and 22 of 32, the longer span beginning June 8...club is 40-31 since a 15-4 start...Entering this series, Texas has won 9 of its last 10 series, including 7 straight from June 8-July 1...club is 19-9-1 overall in series in 2012...rank 2nd in majors with both 55 wins and a .611 (54-35) winning pct. (see note below)...**own team's best record ever after 90 games**, and will also hold best 91-game mark regardless of Tuesday's outcome...club is at least 20 games above .500 for the 4th time in 2012, 1st since July 1 (50-30) with a season-high 21 games above .500 on June 30 (50-29)...own majors' best winning pct. since 2011 All-Star break at .625 (100-60).

**AMONG THE BEST:** Texas enters Wednesday's games with the 2nd-best record in the major leagues, trailing only the Yankees (see above)...Rangers have had majors' best record for 12 days overall since June 1 (5 straight, June 20-24; 7 straight, June 28-July 4)...marks first time for the club to ever have sole possession of best mark in ML after June 1...Rangers became 1st ML team to 50 wins on June 30 in game no. 79, joining the 2009 Dodgers as only teams to reach 50 wins in as few as 79 games over the last 6 seasons.

**IN THE LEAD:** The Rangers' lead in the A.L. West has been 5.5 games for the last 2 days, the largest since July 1 (5.5 GA)...it is the 2nd largest advantage of any division leader to the Yankees' 9.5 lead in the A.L. East...Texas has led by at least 4.0 games for the last 33 days beginning June 15 with an advantage of 3.5 or more games for 88 of last 92 days beginning April 17...have had outright possession of A.L. West lead for last 100 days and have held at least a share of the West lead for 101 of 103 days in 2012 and 237 of last 239 days beginning May 16, 2011...beg. June 8, 2010, Texas has held 1st place for 387 of 403 days...club's 4.0-game lead at the All-Star break marked just 4th time to have a lead that large at the break...the others: 1999 (+5.0 GA), 2010 (+4.5), and 1996 (+4.0).

**ON THE ROAD:** Texas has won consecutive road games for the 1st time since a 4-game win streak, June 10-20...club has captured 7 of 11 away from home beginning June 10...at 26-19 (.578), the Rangers have the 4th best away winning percentage in the majors. behind the Yankees at .614 (27-17), Braves at .605 (26-17), and White Sox at .591 (26-18)...club has matched 1977 and 1999 for its **best road mark ever after 45 road games**...best record after 46 road games is 27-19 in 1977...team was 22-23 after 45 road games in 2011.

**VERSUS OAKLAND:** The Rangers have won 4 of the last 5 meetings to take a 6-5 edge in the 2012 season's series...Texas has won 18 of 25 vs. the A's beginning May 10, 2011 and have captured 5 of the last 6 season's series beginning 2006...Texas is 2-3 here in Oakland this season and has lost 4 of last 6 here...Texas is 11-7 in last 18 games at the Coliseum since Sept. 24, 2010...in the all-time series, the Rangers lead, 313-297 with A's holding a 159-146 edge in Oakland...this is the last series between the teams until they meet in 7 of the year's last 10 games (9/24-27 at TEX; 10/1-3 at OAK).

**VS. A.L. WEST:** The Rangers are 16-14 in their own division in 2012, 6-8 on the road...club has lost 10 of 17, 11 of 19, and 13 of last 22 to A.L. West opponents overall...the Rangers had dropped their 1st 3 road series to A.L. West clubs in 2012 before going 2-1 in Seattle over the weekend...the Rangers and Yankees are the only clubs with winning records against all 3 A.L. divisions.

**TWO-GAME SETS:** Today concludes Texas' last scheduled 2-game series of the season...club won 2 in Boston, April 17-18, lost 2 to Kansas City, May 14-15, and split with Oakland, May 16-17...Rangers have also won every game of a 3-game series 4 times in 2012, last June 18-20 at San Diego.

**ON THE MOUND:** The Rangers have allowed 10 hits and one run in 18.0 innings the last 2 games while posting a 2.38 ERA (19 ER/72.0 IP) over the past 8 games, allowing 3 or fewer ER 7 times, to lower ERA from season-high 3.82 to 3.67, 2nd in A.L. behind the A's (3.43)...starters have allowed 8 earned runs in 29.1 innings over the last 4 games, issuing one of fewer runs 3 times, with a 2.62 ERA (16 ER/55.0 IP) in last 8 G to drop from 4.15 to 4.00...the bullpen has issued just 2 runs in 17.0 innings in its last 5 games and has a 1.97 ERA (7 ER/32.0 IP) in its last 10 games to drop from 3.14 to 2.98, 2nd in A.L. to Oakland (2.76).

**A STREAK ENDS AT THE PLATE:** With 6 runs on Tuesday, Texas snapped a string of scoring 4-runs-or-less in the previous 10 games, the team's longest such streak since 10 in a row from June 13-22, 1999 and matching the longest streak in the A.L. this season...it was the Rangers' most runs scored since a 7-2 win versus Oakland on June 30...it marked just the 2nd time in the last 15 road games that Texas has tallied more than 5 runs, the other a 7-3 victory on June 19 in San Diego...the Rangers have scored multiple runs in 2 of the last 16 innings after doing so just twice in the previous 68 frames.

**HALF DOZEN WITH DOUBLE DIGITS:** Josh Hamilton connected for his 28th homer on Tuesday, tying the White Sox' Adam Dunn for the major league lead...it is the 2nd most homers ever by a Ranger in the team's 1st 90 games in a season behind 31 for Alex Rodriguez in 2002...Hamilton had a pair of RBO on Tuesday to increase his ML lead to 78, 4 more than the Tigers' Miguel Cabrera...Josh is just 3-for-27 in his last 8 games, 2 of the hits being homers...Hamilton is batting .316 (25-79) with 6 HR and 19 RBI in 21 day games in 2012 after having a .220 average with 1 HR and 12 RBI in 33 day games in 2011.

**LEFTIES HAVE BEEN LARGE:** Entering this afternoon's outing versus A's southpaw Travis Blackley, opposing left-handers have won their last 4 starts against the Rangers, issuing just 4 runs in 29.0 innings...last lefty starter to lose to Texas was the A's Tommy Milone on June 30...overall, the Rangers are 16-13 in games started by opposing LH in 2012.  
--Texas has 4 players among the A.L.'s top 14 in batting average vs. left-handers: Craig Gentry, 3rd at .360; Michael Younf, 12th at .330; Ian Kinsler, 13th at .327; and Nelson Cruz, 14th at .326.

**ROSS' STREAK:** Robbie Ross failed to retire a batter for the 1st time in his major league career on Tuesday, but continues to rank 2nd among qualifying A.L. relievers with a 0.95 ERA behind Fernando Rodney (0.86)...Ross' current 23.0-inning scoreless streak tied 2nd-longest in ML and is tied for the 3rd longest overall in the A.L. in 2012...it is the longest scoreless innings streak for a Ranger since a 26.1 innings span for Darren O'Day, June 3-August 13, 2010.

**COLBY LEWIS** will be activated from the 15-day disabled list to start this afternoon's game...the right-hander will be making his 1st outing since a loss to Colorado on June 23...went on the DL on June 26 (retroactive to June 24) with right forearm tendinitis after making all 79 of his scheduled starts since returning to Texas in 2010...Texas still has 4 players on the DL...RHP Neftali Feliz is scheduled to make his 2nd rehab start at Friday at Round Rock (AAA)...RHP Koji Uehara has been shut down for a few days after experiencing tightness in area of right lat muscle...RHP Mark Lowe and 1B Mitch Moreland continue to rehab with the club.

**ON TO ANAHEIM:** The Rangers conclude the trip with a 3-game series in Anaheim beginning Friday...Texas is 3-3 vs. Los Angeles this season, losing 2 of 3 in Anaheim in clubs' last meeting, June 1-3...Rangers have won 11 of 16 vs. the Angels starting August 15, 2011, including 7 of 10 in Anaheim in that span...Saturday's game will be televised nationally to 65% of the U.S. on FOX...Sunday's game is now a 7:05 p.m. CT start for ESPN's national telecast.

**SHORTS:** Tuesday marked the 5th time this season that Josh Hamilton and Adrian Beltre have homered in the same game with Texas going 5-0 in those contests...the Rangers are 14-9 (.609) in day games this season, the A.L.'s 3rd best winning percentage behind the Yankees at .667 (18-9) and Tigers at .610 (25-16)...On Tuesday, Roy Oswalt worked 6.0+ innings (6.1 IP), issued 3 or fewer hits (3) and no walks for 1st time in a start since August 21, 2009 vs. Arizona (7.0 IP/3 H)...Texas has just 2 steals in the last 12 games.

2012: Has 90 strikeouts and just 12 walks in 96.0 innings, leading all major league pitchers in SO/BB ratio (7.50) and BB/9 (1.08)...T17th in the A.L. with 15 HR allowed...

VS. OAKLAND: Has gone 7-4 with a 3.16 ERA (39 ER/111.0 IP) over 19 games/17 starts against the Athletics in his career...

ON THE ROAD: Will be making his 8th road start, and first since a complete game loss here in Oakland on June 6...has gone 2-4, 3.75 (21 ER/50.1 IP) in his first 7 away outings...

10K: In last start on 6/17 vs. HOU, recorded his 2nd double-digit strikeout game of the season and 10th of his career, 5th-most in club history...

**TEAM PITCHING:** The Rangers have allowed 10 hits and one run in 18.0 innings the last 2 games...club has posted a 2.38 ERA (19 ER/72.0 IP) over the past 8 games, allowing 3 or fewer ER 7 times, to lower ERA from season-high 3.82 to 3.67, 2nd in A.L. behind the A's (3.43) and lowest since June 26 (3.63)...club has a 4.37 ERA (84 ER/173.0 IP) over the last 18 games to increase from 3.48...have allowed 3 ER-or-fewer in 27 of last 39 games...staff ranks among A.L. leaders in opp. OBP (1st, .303), CG (T1st, 6), WHIP (1st, 1.23), SO/BB ratio (2nd, 2.88), strikeouts (4th, 692), and opp. avg. (6th, .245)...staff's pre-break 3.72 ERA was 8th-lowest ever, lowest since club-best 3.10 in 1983...45 unearned runs are 2nd-highest in A.L. **STARTERS:** The rotation has allowed 8 earned runs in 29.1 innings over the last 4 games, issuing one of fewer runs 3 times, have a 2.62 ERA (16 ER/55.0 IP) in last 8 G to drop from 4.15 to 4.00, 5th in A.L...have a 4.88 ERA (62 ER/114.1 IP) in last 19 games to increase from 3.76...club is 39-10 when a starter posts a QS...rotation ranks among A.L. team leaders in wins (1st, 44), win pct. (2nd, .603), strikeouts (5th, 465), and quality starts (5th, 49)...starters have a decision in 43 of last 49, and 54 of 62, the longer span since May 6...have 2 ER-or-fewer in 52 of 90 starts overall...starters have gone at least 5.0 IP in 9 straight, 15 of 16, 26 of last 29 and 77 of 90, at least 6.0 in 59 of 90...have used 10 starters this season, T2nd in A.L...Tuesday was 15th time a starter has not allowed a walk in 2012.

**RELIEVERS:** The bullpen has issued just 2 runs in 17.0 innings in its last 5 games and has a 1.97 ERA (7 ER/32.0 IP) in its last 10 games to drop from 3.14 to 2.98, 2nd in A.L...have a 3.98 ERA (55 ER/124.1 IP) last 38 G to rise from 2.03...has fewest losses in ML (5)...leads majors with 1.09 WHIP, .277 OBP, and 3.55 SO/BB ratio...4th-lowest opp. avg. in A.L.
