OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have five "walk-off" wins in their last nine home games, seven in the last 14 and a **Major League leading** 10 for the season...have won seven of the last eight games to improve to five games over .500 for the first time since April 17, 2010 (9-4)...are 12-2 in the month of July, which is the **best record in the majors**...are 3-1 on this six-game homestand against Texas (1-1) and New York (2-0).
- The A's recorded their 21st assist by an outfielder this season (Reddick)...last year, A's outfielders had 21 assists all season...the 21 assists rank second most in the American League (Kansas City, 25).
- Tommy Milone** recorded a career-high 10 strikeouts (previous: 9, July 6, 2012 vs. Seattle)...the 10 strikeouts match the **most by an Oakland pitcher** against the Yankees (fourth time, last: Bobby Witt in 1993)...is 3-1 with a 1.10 ERA (5 er in 41.0 ip) over his last six starts.
- Yoenis Cespedes** (4 for 5) recorded a career-high tying four hits (also July 15 vs. Minnesota) to extend his hitting streak to eight games, an ongoing career-high...is batting .581 (18 for 31) with six multiple hit games during the streak.
- Brandon Moss** (2 for 5) recorded his third career "walk-off" hit (last: July 22, 2009 vs. Milwaukee).
- Josh Reddick** (3 for 5) hit a career-high tying two doubles (fifth time, last: July 8, 2012 vs. Seattle)...is batting .338 (27 for 80) over his last 23 games after hitting .211 over his previous 20 contests...recorded his ninth outfield assist of the season, which is an ongoing career-high.

NEW YORK NOTES

- The New York Yankees have lost the first two games of this series after winning nine consecutive games in Oakland, their longest ever such streak at the Coliseum...are 0-2 on this seven-game road trip to Oakland (0-2) and Seattle (three games).
- The Yankees had their streak of scoring three or more runs snapped at 43 consecutive games...it was the longest such streak in franchise history during a single season...have hit one or more home runs in a season-high tying 11 games in a row.
- Ivan Nova** is 7-1 with a 3.30 ERA (26 er in 71.0 ip) in 11 starts on the road compared to 3-3 with a 5.19 ERA (30 er in 52.0 ip) in eight starts at home...is 1-0 with a 3.29 ERA (5 er in 13.2 ip) in two career starts against the A's.
- Robinson Cano** (2 for 4) is on a career-high 23-game hitting streak (36 for 90, .400)...it is the longest active hitting streak in the majors and the longest by a Yankee since Derek Jeter had a 25-game streak Aug. 20-Sept. 16, 2006.
- Andrew Jones** (0 for 4) struck out a season-high four times...it is his 14th career game of four or more strikeouts, his first since Oct. 1, 2009 at Los Angeles-AL.
- Nick Swisher** (0 for 3) left the game in the seventh inning with a mild left hip flexor strain.
- Mark Teixeira** (2 for 3) is batting .340 (16 for 47) over his last 14 games.
