OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won four straight and eight of the last nine games to improve to six games over .500 for the first time since July 18, 2008 (51-45)...are now **tied for the second Wild Card spot** with Baltimore and Chicago and are just a ½ game behind Los Angeles for the first slot...are 7-1 since the All-Star Break, which is tied with San Francisco for the **best record in the majors**...are 13-2 in the month of July, which is the **best record in the majors**...are 4-1 on this six-game homestand against Texas (1-1) and New York (3-0).
- The A's have won each of their last four games by one run, matching the longest such streak in Oakland history (fourth time, last: 1997)...now have a seven-game winning streak in one-run games, which is their longest since they also won seven straight from June 3-23, 2006.
- Jarrod Parker** tossed a career-high tying eight innings (also June 4, 2012 vs. Texas)...started today on five days rest and is 4-0 with a 1.70 ERA (9 er in 47.2 ip) in seven starts on five days rest or more...is 3-2 with a 2.28 ERA (15 er in 59.1 ip) in nine starts at home.
- Sean Doolittle** recorded his first Major League save.
- Yoenis Cespedes** (1 for 2) hit a home run in the fourth inning to extend his hitting streak to nine games, which is an ongoing career-high...is 19 for 33 (.576) with four home runs and 10 RBI during the streak.
- Brandon Inge** (1 for 3) hit a go-ahead solo home run in the eighth inning...now has nine home runs and 42 RBI in 64 games this year after tallying three home runs and 23 RBI in 102 games last year.

NEW YORK NOTES

- The New York Yankees have lost a season-high tying three consecutive games (sixth time, last: June 19-22)...had won nine consecutive games in Oakland prior to this series, their longest ever such streak at the Coliseum...are 0-3 on this seven-game road trip to Oakland (0-3) and Seattle (three games).
- The Yankees did not hit a home run, snapping their season-high tying streak of 11 consecutive games with a home run.
- Phil Hughes** is 8-4 with a 3.30 ERA (34 er in 92.2 ip) over his last 14 starts after going 1-4 with a 7.48 ERA over his first five starts.
- Robinson Cano** (0 for 4) had his career-high 24-game hitting streak snapped...batted .400 (36 for 90) during the streak, which was the longest active streak in the majors and longest by a Yankee since Derek Jeter had a 25-game streak Aug. 20-Sept. 16, 2006.
- Alex Rodriguez** (2 for 4) is 18 for his last 53 (.340).
