#### THE LATEST:

- Last night, the Blue Jays lost the series finale at Seattle by a score of 5-3...The Jays fall to 12-21 when the game is decided by two runs or less (5-13 on the road)...In fact, it was the 1 game that TOR has played in that resulted in two runs or less since an 11-9 victory vs. CLE at Rogers Centre on July 14, a span of 15 games in between...Carlos Villanueva had his 6-game win streak snapped, suffering his 1<sup>st</sup> loss of the season.
- The Jays have dropped four consecutive contests, their most since a season high 5-game losing streak from May 22-27...Were swept in a series for the 6<sup>th</sup> time this year (4<sup>th</sup> on the road)...Have now lost six of their last 10 contests overall.

#### **HOW WE STACK UP:**

- Are 5<sup>th</sup> in the AL East, 10.0 GB of the 1<sup>st</sup> place Yankees (61-43)...Are 3.5 GB of 2<sup>nd</sup> place Orioles (55-50) & Rays (55-50) & are 1.5 GB of the 4<sup>th</sup> place Red Sox (53-52).
- Are 10-15 vs. the AL West this season (3-9 on the road)...Have lost five of their last six contests vs. the West.

#### **ON THE ROAD AGAIN:**

- Tonight, the Blue Jays continue an 11-day, 10-game road trip with the opener of a 4-game set vs. Oakland...Are 0-3 on the trip getting swept by the Mariners, dropping last night's finale by a score of 5-3...Were outscored 16-6 over that series vs. the M's...Following the series at OAK, enjoy an off-day on Aug. 6 before concluding the trip with a 3-game set vs. the Rays.
- Are 23-30 on the road this season...Have now dropped four of their last five series on the road, going 5-10 over that span...The last three series on the road have all resulted in sweeps (L, 0-3 at NYY, W, 3-0 at BOS & L, 0-3 at SEA).
