♦ On **July 25**, TOR lost **16-0** vs. OAK representing the **largest margin of defeat vs. the A's** in club history.

♦ Today, it was announced that Toronto Blue Jays have extended their player development contract with the **Lansing Lugnuts** (A) through **2014**...The **2012** Lugnuts currently boast the **best record in the Midwest League** at **70-37**...The **70 wins by Lansing represent the most victories among any minor league team in baseball**...The team set club records for most wins at the start of a season & **most victories in one half**, on their way to **clinching the 1st half Eastern Division title** & a **Midwest League postseason invitation**.

ARM STRENGTH:

♦ When newcomer, **Brad Lincoln**, entered the game for TOR in the **7th** inning of last night's game, it represented the **30th different pitcher used by the Blue Jays** this season...The **30** pitchers used by TOR represents the **most in the Majors** (SD ranks **2nd** with **26**)...Have used **six** more pitchers than the **two** closest AL teams (MIN/KC – **24**).

♦ **Casey Janssen** is **13-for-13** in save situations since **assuming the closers role on May 9**...Of those **13** saves has allowed just **six** base runners over **13.2** IP...In **nine** of those saves he has faced the minimum & **seven** of those he has retired all **three** batters he faced in order...**Currently ranks 5th among the active save leaders in the Majors (13-for-13)**...However, Casey has not had a **save situation** since **July 14**.

END OF THE LINE:

♦ Last night, **Yunel Escobar** had his **season high nine game hit streak snapped**, going **0-for-4** in the contest...Over that streak, batted **.355** (11-31) with **2-2B**, **1-HR**, **3-BB**.

TOUGH RELIEF:

♦ Over the last **seven** games, over a span of **19.0** innings, **TOR relievers** have allowed just **3ER** over that span (**1.42** ERA), allowing just **10** hits, **four** walks while striking out **20**.

THE LATEST:

♦ Last night, the Blue Jays lost the **series finale** at **Seattle** by a score of **5-3**...The Jays fall to **12-21** when the game is decided by **two runs or less** (**5-13** on the road)...In fact, it was the **1st** game that TOR has played in that resulted in **two runs or less** since an **11-9** victory vs. CLE at **Rogers Centre** on **July 14**, a span of **15** games in between...**Carlos Villanueva** had his **6-game** win streak snapped, suffering his **1st** loss of the season.

♦ The Jays have dropped **four consecutive contests**, their most since a **season high 5-game losing streak** from **May 22-27**...Were swept in a series for the **6th** time this year (**4th** on the road)...Have now lost **six** of their last **10** contests overall.
