### THE LATEST:

- Last night, the Blue Jays lost the opener of a 4-game series at Oakland by a score of 4-1...Have scored just eight runs over their last five contests...Over the three games prior to July 29, had scored a total of 23 runs over that span...Have drawn just two walks & struck out 17 times over their last three contests.
- The Jays have dropped five consecutive contests, their most since a season high 5-game losing streak from May 22-27...Have not lost six straight contests since a 9-game losing skid from May 19-27, 2009...Have fallen three games below .500 for the 1<sup>st</sup> time since July 9, 2011 (44-47)...Have not been four games below .500 since July 8, 2011 (43-47)...Overall, have dropped seven of their last 10 contests.

- HOW WE STACK UP:

  ↑ Are 5<sup>th</sup> in the AL East, 10.5 GB of the 1<sup>st</sup> place Yankees (61-43)...Are 4.0 GB of 2<sup>nd</sup> place Orioles (55-50) & Rays (55-50) & are 1.5 GB of the 4<sup>th</sup> place Red Sox (53-53).
- Are 10-16 vs. the AL West this season (3-10 on the road)...Have lost four straight & six of their last seven contests vs. the AL West.

### ON THE ROAD AGAIN:

- Tonight, the Blue Jays continue an 11-day, 10-game road trip with the 2<sup>nd</sup> of a 4-game set vs. Oakland...Are currently 0-4 on the trip (0-3 vs. SEA & 0-1 vs. OAK) after dropping last night's series opener vs. the A's, 4-1...Have been outscored 20-5 over the four games on this road trip...Following the series at OAK, enjoy an off-day on Aug. 6 before concluding the trip with a 3game set vs. the Rays.
- Are 23-31 on the road this season, having lost four consecutive contests...Have dropped four of their last five completed series on the road, going 5-11 over that span...The last three completed series on the road have all resulted in sweeps (L, 0-3 at NYY, W, 3-0 at BOS & L, 0-3 at SEA).

- BLUE JAYS vs. ATHLETICS:

  2012: Play the A's nine times this season, three at Rogers Centre & six at Alameda County Coliseum...Are 2-3 vs. OAK (1-2 at home & 1-1 on the road)...The Jays have dropped eight of their last 13 meetings vs. the A's dating back to 2011...Have also dropped five of their last eight games on the road dating back to 2010.
- On July 25, TOR lost 16-0 vs. OAK representing the largest margin of defeat vs. the A's in club history.

  LAST SEASON: Posted an overall record of 5-5 (3-3 at home &
- **2-2** on the road).
- ALL-TIME: Overall are 174-201, 83-104 at home & 91-97 on the road...TOR has not dropped a season series vs. OAK dating back to **2007**, going **23-18** over that span...The Jay have won **three** of their last **five** season series in OAK dating back to 2006, going 13-9 over that stretch.

- ★ Among the AL on the road, Toronto ranks T-2<sup>nd</sup> in HR (71) & 3<sup>rd</sup> in runs (249)...Among AL leaders on the road, Colby Rasmus ranks 3<sup>rd</sup> in XBH (27), T-4<sup>th</sup> in RBI (41) & TB (109).
   ★ Among the AL on the road, dating back to May 13, Edwin Encarnacion ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> in OPS (1.065), SLG (.639), 4<sup>th</sup> in OBP (.426) & AVG (.344, 42-122)...Teammate, Colby Rasmus, ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> in XBH (21) & T-2<sup>nd</sup> in RBI (33) over that same period.

### **AMONG THE BEST:**

Among the AL offensive leaders, Edwin Encarnacion ranks 4<sup>th</sup> in OPS (.959), T-4<sup>th</sup> in HR (28), 5<sup>th</sup> in TB (212), HR/AB (13.21), 6<sup>th</sup> in SLG (.573), times on base (167), 7<sup>th</sup> in RBI (72), OBP (.386), T-7<sup>th</sup> in XBH (48) & 9<sup>th</sup> in runs (66).

### **HEATING UP:**

- Over his last 11 contests, Yunel Escobar has hit .333 (13-39) with a .842 OPS over that span...Had a season high nine game hit streak during that stretch from July 18-31.
- Rajai Davis has recorded a hit in a season high seven straight contests...Over that stretch, is batting .321 (9-28) with 2-2B, 1-HR, 3-SB & has posted a .821 OPS.

### SEEING DOUBLE:

The Blue Jays have recorded at least one double in 18 of their last 20 contests dating back to July 8...Have hit a total of 46 doubles over that period which ranks T-1<sup>st</sup> in the Majors with the New York Mets.

### **TOUGH RELIEF:**

Over the last eight games, in a span of 22.0 innings, TOR relievers have allowed just 4-ER (1.64 ERA), allowing 13 hits, six walks while striking out 25...Opponents are batting .169 vs. TOR relievers over that stretch.

### DOWN ON THE FARM:

- RHP Justin Nicolino of the Lansing Lugnuts (A) has a 2.48 ERA this season with 94-SO & just 14-BB over 94.1 IP...His WHIP of 1.06 is the best in the Midwest League among qualifying pitchers...Justin was a 2<sup>nd</sup> round selection by Toronto in the 2010 June Draft.
- RHP Javier Avendano of the Vancouver Canadians (A) owns a 4-1 record with an ERA of 1.53 this year in 47.0 IP...He has the  $\mathbf{2}^{\text{nd}}$  best ERA in the Northwest League among qualifying pitchers...In his 47.0 IP, he has a league high 50-SO & just 15-BB, while holding opponents to a .213 AVG.

SAVING THE DAY:

◆ Casey Janssen Is 13-for-13 in save situations since assuming the closers role on May 9...Of those 13 saves has allowed just six base runners over 13.2 IP...In nine of those saves he has faced the minimum & seven of those he has retired all three batters he faced in order...Currently ranks 5<sup>th</sup> among the active save leaders in the Majors (13-for-13)...However, Casey has not had a save situation since July 14.
