### THE LATEST:

- HAPPY BIRTHDAY: Today Manager John Farrell celebrates
- Last night, the Blue Jays lost 5-4 in game two of a 4-game series at Oakland...Are a season high four games below .500 (51-55)...Had not been four games below .500 since July 8, 2011 (43-47)...Have not been five games below .500 since July 7, 2011(42-47)...Have scored 12 runs over their last six contests...Over the three games prior to July 29, had scored a total of 23 runs over that span...Overall have lost eight of the last 11 games
- The Jays have lost a season high six straight longest losing streak since nine straight, May 19-27, 2009...During the streak are batting .205(45-219),12R, 8-2B, 4HR, 11BB, 59K...Pitchers have posted a 4.55 ERA, 28ER, 55.1IP, 7HR, 22BB, 46K.

### **HOW WE STACK UP:**

- Are 5<sup>th</sup> in the AL East, 11.5 GB of the 1<sup>st</sup> place Yankees (62-43)...Are 5.0 GB of 2<sup>nd</sup> place Rays (56-50), 4.0 GB of 3<sup>rd</sup> place Orioles (55-51) & are 1.5 GB of the 4<sup>th</sup> place Red Sox (53-54). Are 10-17 vs. the AL West this season (3-11 on the road)...
- Have lost five straight & seven of their last eight contests vs. the AL West.

### **ON THE ROAD AGAIN:**

- Today, the Blue Jays continue an 11-day, 10-game road trip with the third of a 4-game set vs. Oakland...Are currently 0-5 on the trip (0-3 vs. SEA & 0-2 vs. OAK) after dropping last night's 15 inning games, 5-4...Have been outscored 25-9 over the five games on this road trip...Following the series at OAK, enjoy an off-day on Aug. 6 before concluding the trip with a 3-game set vs. the Ravs.
- Are 23-32 on the road this season, having lost five consecutive contests...Have dropped four of their last five completed series on the road, going 5-12 over that span...The last three completed series on the road have all resulted in sweeps (L, 0-3 at NYY, W, 3-0 at BOS & L, 0-3 at SEA).

#### **BLUE JAYS vs. ATHLETICS:**

- 2012: Play the A's nine times this season, three at Rogers Centre & six at Alameda County Coliseum...Are 2-5 vs. OAK (1-2 at home & 1-3 on the road)...The Jays have dropped ten of their last 15 meetings vs. the A's dating back to 2011...Have also dropped seven of their last ten games on the road dating back to 2010.
- On July 25, TOR lost 16-0 vs. OAK representing the largest margin of defeat vs. the A's in club history.
- LAST SEASON: Posted an overall record of 5-5 (3-3 at home & 2-2 on the road).
- ALL-TIME: Overall are 174-202, 83-104 at home & 91-98 on the road...TOR will drop the season series vs. OAK for the first time since 2007...The Jay have won three of their last five season series in OAK dating back to 2006, are 13-11 over that stretch.

#### **NOT WORTH THE WAIT:**

- The Blue Jays lost 5-4 in 15 innings last night and are now 3-5 in extra inning games this season...Longest game this season was 16 innings on Opening Day in Cleveland, won 7-4. Last night was the **16**<sup>th</sup> **time in franchise history** to play 15 or
- more innings in a game, are now 5-11...Of the 16 games of 15 or more innings, five have been against the Athletics and are 0-5...Of the five games, four have been in Oakland...Longest game vs Oakland was July 3, 1988, a 16-inning 9-8 loss in Oakland (WP- Burns, LP- Cerutti).

#### **ROSTER MOVES:**

- Following last night's game the team announced that LHP Brett Cecil was optioned to Las Vegas (AAA), RHP Drew Carpenter was designated for assignment, recalled RHP Jesse Chavez and infielder Adeiny Hechavarria from Las Vegas.
- Hechavarria is set to become the seventh Blue Jay to make his ML debut in '12(Crawford, Dyson, Gomes, Gose, Loup, Sierra).

### **ROAD WARRIORS:**

- Among the AL on the road, Toronto ranks T-2<sup>nd</sup> in HR (72) &  $3^{rd}$  in runs (253)...Among AL leaders on the road, Colby Rasmus ranks T2nd in XBH (28), T-4<sup>th</sup> in RBI (41) & TB (109).
- ♣ Among the AL on the road, dating back to May 13, Edwin Encarnacion ranks 3<sup>rd</sup> in OPS (1.045), SLG (.619), 4<sup>th</sup> in OBP (.426) & T4th in AVG (.333, 42-126)...Teammate, Colby Rasmus, ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> in XBH (22) & T-2<sup>nd</sup> in RBI (33) over that same period.

- Rajai Davis has recorded a hit in a season high eight straight contests...Over that stretch, is batting .303 (10-33) with 2-2B, 1-

Over the last **nine** games, in a span of **31.1** innings, **TOR** relievers have allowed just 5-ER (1.44 ERA), allowing 18 hits, eight walks while striking out 36.

Has received 6.18 runs per game ranking 7<sup>th</sup> in the AL - however team has scored just one run for him in his last five starts and just eight runs over his last seven, including four consecutive games being shutout.

### A LITTLE UNUSUAL:

Has walked 70 in his 129.2 innings for a 4.9 per nine total...Had a 3.5 per nine total coming into 2012...Has had trouble early in games, allowing hitters to bat .298 the 1<sup>st</sup> time through the order...2<sup>nd</sup> time through is .263 and 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> time through is .244.

#### **REVERSE LEFTY:**

• In his career has fared better vs. right-handed hitters holding them to a .235 average (.255 in 2012)...Lefthanded hitters are batting .283 (.297 in 2012).

### LAST START:

- July 30<sup>th</sup>, recorded his 10<sup>th</sup> quality start despite losing his 7<sup>th</sup> straight in a 4-1 loss at SEA...Allowed two in the 1<sup>st</sup> and one in the 2<sup>nd</sup> (unearned) before finishing six innings with three earned runs.
- Blue Jays suffered the biggest shutout loss in franchise history, falling 16-0 to OAK...Marked the shortest outing of his career when he allowed eight runs in 1.1 innings...Also marked the 4<sup>th</sup> straight outing the team has been shutout in his starts...
- Lost 6-0 at NYY on July 18...Allowed four 1<sup>st</sup> inning runs and six in total in his six innings.
- Team was shutout for a second consecutive time, losing 1-0 to CLE on July 13...Went six innings, allowing only a Travis Hafner home run.
- Allowed four or more runs in eight consecutive starts from May 23-July 2 and gave up a career high eight in back-to-back starts (June 27 & July 2)
- Won four straight decisions for the 2<sup>nd</sup> time this season after defeating Miami on June 22.
- Was the Opening Day starter on April 5<sup>th</sup> at Cleveland...Has started two consecutive opening days.
