OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have been shut out a Major League leading 13 times...that includes two shutouts in the past seven games after going 48 consecutive games without being blanked...have lost three straight, five of the last seven and six of the last nine...are now ½ game behind Los Angeles for the second American League Wild Card spot and one game behind Detroit for the first Wild Card...had held at least a share of a playoff spot each of the previous 16 days...are 17-18 against AL West teams...are 3-5 on this 10-game homestand against Tampa Bay (1-2), Toronto (2-2) and Los Angeles (0-1).
- Jarrod Parker is 2-3 with a 5.95 ERA (24 er in 36.1 ip) over his past six starts...went 5-3 with a 2.46 ERA over his first 13 starts...started today on four days rest...is 3-6 with a 4.35 ERA (31 er in 64.0 ip) in 11 starts on four days rest or fewer and 4-0 with a 2.56 ERA (15 er in 52.2 ip) in eight starts on five days rest or more.
- Brandon Inge (2 for 3) has hit safely in 15 of his past 16 games (19 for 69, .275)...that includes a career-high tying 13-game hitting streak that was snapped Saturday.
- Josh Reddick (0 for 3) had his 13th assist of the season, which is the most among Major League outfielders...since 1985, the only A's outfielder with as many assists is Matt Stairs, who also had 13 in 1999.

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels have a **Major League leading** 15 shutouts...it is their most since they had 20 shutouts in 1989...are 41-27 (.603) over the last 68 games after going 18-24 (.429) in the first 42 games...are 4-4 on this 10-game road trip to Texas (2-2), Chicago (1-2) and Oakland (0-1).
- **Jered Weaver** tossed the 11th complete game of his career, the sixth shutout...earned his **American League leading** 15th win...has won each of his last nine starts (11 er in 62.0 ip, 1.60 ERA), which is the second longest such streak in the majors this season (Dickey, NYM 11)...is 10-0 with a 1.64 ERA (14 er in 77.0 ip) over his past 12 starts...is 8-7 with a 2.47 ERA (42 er in 153.0 ip) in 23 career starts against Oakland.
- Erick Aybar (3 for 4) recorded three hits, his third game of three or more hits this season...his season-high is four hits (May 19 at San Diego).
- Torii Hunter (1 for 4) is on a seven-game hitting streak (12 for 32, .375), which ties his season high (third time, last: July 21-28)...has hit safely in 14 of his past 15 games and is 25 for 62 (.403) with one home run and 15 RBI over that span.
- Howie Kendrick (0 for 3) had his eight-game hitting streak snapped...was 12 for 31 (.387) during the streak.
- Mike Trout (2 for 3) had a career-high tying three stolen bases (third time, last: July 5, 2012 vs. Baltimore) and now has a Major League leading 36 for the season...has been successful in each of his past 27 stolen base attempts, which is an on-going franchise record... is 11 for 33 (.333) with 11 runs, three home runs and 10 RBI on the road trip.
