WHEN THE LIGHTS GO DOWN: Cleveland is in the early portion of a 10-day, 9-game road trip through Anaheim, Oakland and Seattle while holding a 13-7 (.650) record against teams from the A.L. West, the 3rd-highest winning pct. vs. that division by any team in the majors this season behind Chicago-AL and Tampa Bay (both .654, 17-9)...**Cleveland has batted .278 (188-677) with a .353 OBP, .403 SLG and 4.7 runs-per-game (94 R/20G) in those 20 games against the A.L. West, while the Tribe's pitching staff has registered a 3.40 ERA (68 ER/180.0 IP) and .247 avg. against...** this marks just the 2nd time all season for the Tribe to travel west of the 95th meridian, as the Indians had played just 2 road series against A.L. West foes to this point in the season (@Seattle & @Oakland as part of a 7-2 trip April 13-22).

THE STANDINGS: The Indians have lost 1.5 games worth of ground since Wednesday's 8-4 defeat to the Angels, as **Cleveland is a season-high 11.5 games behind Chicago in the A.L. Central standings...**the Tribe is also 10.0 games back in the A.L. Wild Card standings...Cleveland has been in 3rd place for 33 straight days after spending 56 consecutive days in either first or 2nd place (April 24-July 14)...of the 134 days of the Indians' season, Cleveland has been in first place for 40 days, 2nd place for 46 days and 3rd place for 38 days...**Cleveland held a season-high 4.0-game first place lead on May 17, but has gone 32-48 (.400) since.**

WINS AND LOSSES: Cleveland is 1-2 to start the club's 10-day, 9-game road trip through Los Angeles-AL (1-2), Oakland (3 games) and Seattle (3 games)...Cleveland finished a recent 7-game homestand at 3-4 against Minnesota (1-2) and Boston (2-2)...the Indians have not had a winning homestand or road trip since July 2-8 when the club went 4-3 against the Angels (2-1) and Rays (2-2) during a 7-game stretch at Progressive Field...the Indians have won 4 of their last 8 games, but have still lost 20 of 27 and 23 of their last 32 games - a stretch that was significantly impacted by a season-high 11-game losing streak from July 27-Aug. 7 that saw Cleveland lose 7.0 games in the divisional standings...**Cleveland has held a lead at some point in 7 of the club's last 15 losses...**the Indians finished July at 11-15 for their 2nd consecutive losing month after going 11-9 in April and 16-14 in May...club is 4-11 to start August...Cleveland's overall 2012 record sits 10 games below the .500 mark (54-64) to match a season low-water mark, 18 games shy of the club's season high-water mark (8G, 26-18 on May 24)...the Indians have been at or above the .500 mark for 102 of the last 123 days, including 97 consecutive days from April 15-July 21...Cleveland is one game above the .500 mark at home (30-29), winning 13 of 24, 19 of 36 and 28 of the last 51 games at Progressive Field after starting the year 2-6 in Cleveland...club's road record sits 11 games below the .500 mark (24-35), losing 12 of 13 and 13 of last 15 away from Cleveland.

SINCE THE BREAK: Cleveland is 10-23 (.303) since the All-Star break, the lowest winning pct. in the A.L. for the 2nd "half", 2nd-lowest in majors ahead of Houston (.182, 6-27)...the Indians' .518 (44-41) winning pct. in the first "half" was 7th-best in the A.L....the club is hitting .238 (258-1084) with 116 runs scored (7.8 H/G, 3.5RS/G) in the second "half" with a .676 OPS (.303 OBP/.373 SLG)...club averaged 8.9 hits and 4.5 runs per game in the first half (.258 AVG/.735 OPS)...also batting just .218 (53-243) w/ RISP (.250 w/ RISP in first "half")...staff has a 5.53 ERA (176 ER/286.1 IP) in the 2nd "half" after posting a 4.50 figure (381 ER/762.0 IP) before the All-Star break; team's 5.53 ERA in 2nd "half" is 2nd-highest in the majors ahead of only Colorado (5.92)...with that said, the starting rotation (6.76 ERA in 2nd "half") is largely responsible for that inflated figure (175.2 IP, 132ER)...**Tribe starters have 6 quality starts (2.31 ERA, 10 ER/39.0 IP) over the club's last 9 games, but a 12.83 ERA (19 ER/13.1 IP) in those 3 non-QS's...** relievers have posted a 3.58 ERA (44 ER/110.2 IP) since the All-Star break, this while logging nearly 40% of the team's innings in the 2nd "half" (38.6%, 110.2 of 286.1).

INDIANSPRESSBOX.COM: In conjunction with MLBAM, the Cleveland Indians operate indianspressbox.com, a private, media-only website that serves as a central archive for various documents, video and audio clips produced by the club's Baseball Information Department. Available content includes press releases, game notes, lineups, rosters and the Indians 2012 Information and Record Book.

LEFTIES OF LATE: Cleveland's offense is batting .282 (59-209) with 14 XBH's (9-2B, 5-HR) vs. left-handers over the club's last 11 games (beginning August 1), while the Indians have won 4 of last 5 games they have faced a left-handed starting pitcher (wins against: Brian Duensing, Felix Doubrant, Franklin Morales, C.J. Wilson)...Cleveland is 14-25 overall this season in games started by opposing lefties.

THAT'S THE POWER OF GLOVE: Cleveland's pitching staff absorbed 3 more unearned runs in Wednesday night's loss to the Angels, all resulting from the 3 errors committed by the Tribe's defense in the 2nd inning...**Cleveland hurlers have been charged with 55 unearned runs this season, 2nd-most in the A.L. and 4th-most in the majors behind Detroit (58), Houston (57) and San Diego (57)...17 of those 55 unearned runs (or 31%) have come in the span of the Indians' last 10 games,** while the Tribe's defense has been charged with 9 errors during that same stretch for a .976 fielding pct. (9 ER/378 TC)...Cleveland's .985 overall team fielding pct. this season is still 4th-best in the A.L. and 5th in the majors.

OAKLAND STROKE: Tonight the Indians and Athletics will meet for just the 2nd time in 2012 after Cleveland took 2 of 3 in Oakland back on April 20-22...Tribe is 98-133 all-time at the Coliseum, but has won 5 of last 8 there.

...MORE VS. OAKLAND: Former Athletic **JACK HANNAHAN** has a career .333 (16-48) avg. against Oakland, collecting 4 doubles, 3 homers and 10 RBI in 17 games; Hannahan is 10-for-24 (.417) with 3 HR and 8 RBI over his last 6 games vs. the A's, going 4-for-9 this season...**JASON KIPNIS** is 5-for-11 (.455) in 3 career games against Oakland, all coming in 2012 here at the Oakland Coliseum...**SHIN-SOO CHOO** has a career .300 (24-80) avg. against Oakland with 2 homers and 10 RBI in 24 games; Choo has doubled in all 3 of his games vs. the A's this season, going 5-for-14 at the plate.

AROUND THE BLOCK: Cleveland has gone 25-13 in series openers this season...with Choo's 3-run blast Wednesday, Indians left-handed batters have now connected for 69 home runs in 2012, tied with Toronto for most in the majors...**CODY ALLEN** has logged 11.1 consec. SHO innings since having his contract selected from Triple-A Columbus July 20, the longest scoreless streak to begin a career exclusively in relief with the Indians since **TOM WADDELL** had a streak of 12.1 scoreless IP April 15-May 5, 1984.

34 ZACH MCALLISTER RHP

(5-4, 3.46)

TONIGHT'S START: The 24-year-old right-hander is slated to make his 14th start and appearance tonight at the Oakland Coliseum to open a 3-game set against the Athletics, also the 18th start and appearance of his major league career... **Cleveland is 8-5 in his 13 starts...**has a 3.05 ERA (14 ER/41.1 IP) and .224 avg. against over his last 7 starts to drop from 3.93 to 3.46, but is just 2-3 during that stretch, receiving exactly one run of support in 4 of his last 5 starts...will be pitching on extended 5 days' rest with yesterday's off day after posting a 5-2 win over Boston on Saturday... **has permitted 3 ER-or-less in 11 of his 13 outings...** is in his 3rd stint of 2012 with Cleveland, this time taking the place of Jeanmar Gomez (optioned to AAA June 25); the first was necessitated by a May 7 doubleheader, while the 2nd included 3 starting assignments in place of an injured Josh Tomlin (15-day DL, right wrist soreness)... **has averaged 8.0 strikeouts-per-9.0 IP this season** (7.8 SO-per-9.0 IP for his major league career)...has recorded 69 strikeouts over 78.0 IP for Cleveland against just 20 walks, issuing one-or-zero free passes in 7 of his 13 starts...was named the 6th-best prospect in the Indians organization entering 2012 according to *Baseball America*.

LAST START: Posted his 5th win in a 5-2 victory over Boston on Saturday night at Progressive Field (8.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R-ER, 0 BB, 4 SO, 100 pitches/66 strikes)... **Red Sox right-handed batters were 0-for-14 against McAllister...**retired 9 straight batters to start the contest until giving up a lead-off 2B to Jacoby Ellsbury in the 4th; after a pair of fielder's choice plays, he allowed his only runs of the night on a 2-run 2B by Adrian Gonzalez...following that 2B, McAllister went on to set down 13 of the final 14 batters he faced to log a career-high 8.0 inning.

VS. OAKLAND: Slated to face the Athletics for the first time in his career.

ON THE ROAD: Will be making his 5th road start this season, going 2-2 with a 4.01 ERA (11 ER/24.2 IP) in 4 previous tilts away from Cleveland (3-2, 3.21 ERA in 9 home starts)...just one of his last 5 starts have come on the road.

2012 STARTS-CLEVELAND: The Indians are 8-5 in his 13 starts...was the first starter outside of season-opening rotation used by Cleveland (6th overall)...was first recalled to start G1 of a DH on 5/7 vs. CWS as 26th man* on roster and earned his first major league victory in an 8-6 win over the Sox...posted a QS, as only 2 of 4 runs were earned...was returned to Columbus following the game (*10-day option rule not in effect)...recalled on May 12 when Josh Tomlin was placed on DL (right wrist soreness) and took a 4-1 loss that night in his Fenway Park debut...took ND in 6-5, walk-off win 5/17 vs. SEA; held M's 3-for-21, but allowed 5 walks and exited with 3-0 deficit; Tribe scored all 6 runs in 7th-or-later...took ND in a 4-2 win 5/23 vs. DET; retired 14 of first 18 faced and exited in a 2-2 tie in the 7th...recalled from Columbus 6/28 and earned first career road win that night at BAL; both runs on Hardy 2-run HR...earned 9-5 win 7/3 vs. LAA; retired 12 of first 14 before giving up all 5 runs in 5th inning, including HR's to Trout/Pujols...took ND in Indians' final game before All-Star break, a 7-6 loss 7/8 vs. TB; retired 13 of first 14 BF, holding Rays scoreless thru 5.0 before 4 unearned runs in 6th-exited w/ 5-4 lead, but TB scored 3 runs off C. Perez in 9th to win...earned 3-2 win 7/16 at TB, holding Rays 3-for-19...tossed career-high 7.2 IP in 3-1 loss 7/21 vs. BAL; shut out O's on 2 hits thru 6 before HR's to Thome/Flaherty...took ND in 5-3 comeback win 7/26 vs. DET, as Tribe trailed 3-1 before plating 4 runs on 5 hits off Verlander in the 7th...charged with 7 unearned runs (9 runs total) in 14-3 loss 8/6 vs. MIN, shortest start of MLB career (1.2 IP); gave up back-to-back HR's to Willingham/Morneau to start 2nd inn.

2012 SPLITS-CLEVELAND: Opponents batting .247 (75-304)...right-handers hitting just .238 (30-126) with 6 HR's (Cody Ross/J.J. Hardy/Mike Trout/Albert Pujols/Delmon Young/Josh Willingham), while lefties are hitting .253 (45-178) with 3 HR's (Jim Thome/Ryan Flaherty/Justin Morneau)...opponents hitting .265 (18-68) w/ RISP; .324 (11-34) w/ RISP & 2 outs...average with men on base (.274, 31-113) is higher than with bases empty (.230, 44-191)...opponents batting a combined .238 (50-210) the 1st & 2nd time thru the order; .266 (25-94) the 3rd time thru the order and beyond... **has a 1.91 ERA (8 ER/37.2 IP) and a .213 (30-141) opponents' avg. over innings 1-through-3...**holding batters to a .172 (28-163) mark with 2 strikes.

2012 FOR COLUMBUS: Began the year in the Clippers Opening Day rotation and has gone 5-2 with a 2.98 ERA (21 ER/63.1 IP) in 11 game/starts for Columbus so far this season in what is his 2nd full season at the Triple-A level; his 2.98 ERA ranked 8th in the IL following his most recent start on June 23...Clippers are 7-4 in his 11 trips to the bump...has 52 strikeouts against 19 walks... **has not allowed a HR over his last 29.1 consecutive innings at Triple-A...**named the 6th-best prospect in the Indians organization entering 2012 (*Baseball America*)... **SPLITS:** Opponents batting .251 (59-235) with 5 HR in 63.1 innings...left-handers are hitting at a .248 (26-105) clip, while right-handers are batting .254 (33-130)...has held teams to .175 (10-57) avg. w/ RISP, incl. a .185 (5-27) mark w/ RISP & 2 outs...is 3-0 w/ a 2.43 ERA (10 ER/37.0 IP) in 6 home starts at Huntington Park, going 2-2 w/ a 3.76 ERA (11 ER/26.1 IP) in 5 road starts.

2011: Spent most of season at Triple-A Columbus, going 12-3 w/ a 3.32 ERA (154.2IP, 155H, 61R/57ER, 31BB, 128K, 11HR, .261 avg) in 25 starts...ranked among IL leaders in CG (T1st, 3), wins (T3rd, innings (4th), WHIP (5th, 1.20), ERA (7th) and K's (7th)...was selected to the mid-season IL All-Star team...led all Indians minor league pitchers in wins, ranking 5th in ERA, 2nd in IP and 4th in K's...was 1-1 w/ a 3.21 ERA (14.0IP, 16H, 5R/ER, 2BB, 9K) in 2 postseason starts for the IL-Champion Clippers... **WITH CLEVELAND:** Went 0-1 w/ a 6.11 ERA (12 ER/17.2 IP) in 4 scattered starts for the Tribe...recalled from Columbus July 7 & made MLB debut that night vs. TOR, a 5-4 Indians win, however did not factor into the decision as he pitched 4.0IP (5H, 3R/2ER, 3BB, 4K, 94P/56K)...optioned back to AAA Columbus July 8th...recalled from AAA Columbus for 2nd time on Aug. 22 and suffered the loss in his 2nd big league start on Aug. 23 vs. SEA, in Game 2 of the doubleheader, a 12-7 loss to the M's (3.1IP, 9H, 10R/8ER, 2BB, 2K)...optioned back to Columbus Aug. 24...recalled again Sept. 20 to start that night vs. CWS (season/career-high 5.1IP)...over his last 2 starts with Cleveland posted a 1.74 ERA (10.1IP, 12H, 2ER).

CAREER: Is in his 2nd full season and 3rd overall with the Cleveland organization after being acquired from New York-AL on Aug. 20, 2010 to complete a trade of July 30, 2010 that sent OF Austin Kearns to the Yankees for a PTBNL... was originally selected by New York-AL in the 3rd round of the 2006 June draft out of Illinois Valley Central HS...is a native and current resident of Chillicothe, Illinois, a town located just north of Peoria and roughly 140 miles southwest of Chicago... his father, Steve, is a scout for the Arizona Diamondbacks.
