OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics had their four-game winning streak snapped...are 12-12 over the last 24 contests after going 16-2 over the previous 18 games... are third in the Wild Card race, ½ game behind second place Baltimore... are 3-1 on this six-game homestand against Cleveland (3-0) and Minnesota (0-1).
- Brandon McCarthy allowed a season-high six runs (previous: 5, twice; last: April 16 at Los Angeles) in a season-low 3.1 innings (previous: 5.0, April 6 vs. Seattle)...is 0-2 with a 6.19 ERA (11 er in 16.0 ip) in three starts since being reinstated from the disabled list August 10.
- Travis Blackley tossed 5.2 innings, the longest outing by an A's reliever this season (previous: 3.2, Blackley, May 22 vs. Los Angeles and Norberto, Aug. 4 vs. Toronto).
- Yoenis Cespedes (1 for 4) is batting .372 (48 for 129) since the All-Star Break, which leads the American League.
- Josh Donaldson (1 for 3) is 11 for 27 (.407) with five RBI in seven games since he was recalled from Triple-A Sacramento last Tuesday.
- Josh Reddick (0 for 4) is batting .143 (12 for 84) with three walks and 30 strikeouts over his last 20 games.
- The A's acquired shortstop Stephen Drew from the Arizona Diamondbacks in exchange for minor league infielder Sean Jamieson, the club announced this evening.

MINNESOTA NOTES

- The Minnesota Twins snapped their five-game losing streak...are 1-3 on this 10-game road trip against Seattle (0-3), Oakland (1-0) and Texas
- The Twins were 4 for 11 (.364) with runners in scoring position after going 3 for 28 (.107) with RISP in their previous three games in Seattle.
- Brian Duensing is 2-3 with a 3.47 ERA (19 er in 49.1 ip) in 24 games, five starts, on the road compared to 1-5 with a 5.86 ERA (23 er in 35.1 ip) in 18 games, four starts, at home...is 3-1 with a 3.30 ERA (11 er in 30.0 ip) in eight career games, four starts, against Oakland.
- Pedro Florimon (3 for 3) had his first career three hit game...is 6 for 12 (.500) in four games since his contract was selected from Triple-A
- Joe Mauer (3 for 5) had three hits, his 16th game of three or more hits this season...his season-high is four hits (May 20 at Milwaukee).
- Justin Morneau (1 for 5) is on a 10-game hitting streak (12 for 39, .308).
- Josh Willingham (3 for 5) had a season-high tying three hits (fourth time)...is 12 for 27 (.444) with five home runs and 14 RBI against the A's this year.
