**THE TWINS:** The Twins opened their 10-game road trip with three consecutive losses in Seattle before winning last night in Oakland...tonight, the Twins will continue their three-game series in Oakland, with the second of three vs. the A's...following this series the Twins will travel to Texas (August 23-26) for a four-game series...12 of the Twins next 16 games will be played on the road...they are 27-33 away from Target Field this season.

**TWINS WAKE UP THE BATS, BEAT OAKLAND:** The Twins beat Oakland last night by a score of 7-2...Brian Duensing (3-8) was the starter and winner as he pitched 6.0 innings allowing two runs (one earned) on five hits...he struck out a season-high seven batters...Casey Fien pitched 2.0 perfect innings of relief while Alex Burnett tossed a scoreless ninth inning...the Twins scattered 15 hits, including three from each Joe Mauer, Josh Willingham and Pedro Florimon...Darin Mastroianni went 2-for-3 with two sacrifices and two rbi...the Twins went 4-for-11 with runners in scoring position and left 10 runners on base.

**TWINS RECALL HENDRIKS:** The Twins announced today that they have recalled right-handed pitcher **Liam Hendriks** from Triple-A Rochester...Hendriks, who was on the Twins Opening Day roster, has made eight starts in two previous stints with the Twins this year...in 16 starts for the Red Wings, the right-hander went 9-3 with a 2.20 ERA (106.1 ip, 26 er) with 28 walks and 82 strikeouts...Hendriks will join the team today in Oakland and is scheduled to start tomorrow vs. the Athletics.

**NEW KID ON THE BLOCK:** Last night, Pedro Florimon recorded a career-high with three hits in four at-bats, including three runs scored, one walk and stole his first career base...last night was just his eighth career Major League game between the Orioles and the Twins...since having his contract selected August 15, he is batting .500 (6-for-12) with four runs, one double, one triple, two walks, two strikeouts and a .571 on-base percentage in four games...he has gone 3-for-8 (.375) with a double and a walk from the left side of the plate while he is 3-for-4 (.750) with a triple and a walk from the right side.

**DROPPING THE HAMMER ON THE A's:** In his first game returning to the Oakland Coliseum after playing for the A's in 2011, Josh Willingham went 3-for-5 with one run scored and two runs batted in...in seven game against his former team, he has hit five home runs, while batting .444 with 14 runs batted in and a slugging percentage of 1.074...he has driven in multiple runs four times against the Athletics this season.

**WORKING WITH THE PEN:** The Twins have used 17 relievers this year and they have combined to go 20-15, 3.78 (412.1 ip, 173 er) in 119 games (two complete games by starters) with 139 walks and 294 strikeouts...the bullpen ranks third in baseball with 412.1 innings pitched, trailing only Colorado (473.0) and Kansas City (433.0)...last season, the bullpen went 17-28, 4.47 (460.2 ip, 229 er) in 155 games, having used 19 different relievers.

**BURTON THROWING BLANKS:** Dating back to May 26, Jared Burton has allowed just three runs (two earned) in 30.1 innings (0.59 ERA)...during that same span he has held opponents to a .196 batting average and has recorded five saves in six tries with seven holds...Burton has appeared in 48 games, six shy of his career high 54 in 2009.

**REVERE SEEKING 30:** Ben Revere is just two stolen bases away from becoming the fourth player in club history with consecutive 30-steal seasons (34 last season)...Chuck Knoblauch stole 30-plus in four straight seasons from 1994-97, Rod Carew stole 30-plus in four straight from 1973-76, and Cesar Tovar stole 30-plus in three straight from 1968-70.

#### THIS AND THAT:

- THE ROCHESTER RACE: The Red Wings are 3.5 games out of the International League Wild Card spot with 14 games to go...however, the Red Wings have four teams ahead of them - Pawtucket (70-61), Lehigh Valley (69-61), Columbus (67-63) and Norfolk (67-64).
- The Twins have struck out just 772 times this season, only the Royals (750) have struck out few times this year.
- Justin Morneau needs just one walk to pass Tony Oliva (448) and move into sole possession of ninth on the Twins all-time walks list.
