OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics had their nine-game winning streak snapped, which was tied for the eighth longest in Oakland history...it was their longest winning streak since June 8-18, 2006 when they won 10 in a row...are 3-1 on this six-game homestand against Boston (3-0) and Los Angeles (0-1).
- The A's are 76-58 for the season, which is tied with the Yankees for the second best record in the AL...are in second place in the AL West and trail Texas by four games...are in sole possession of the first Wild Card slot, one game ahead of Baltimore and 2½ games ahead of third place Tampa Bay.
- The A's have homered in each of the last 10 games (22 home runs total) and now have a **Major League leading** 74 home runs since the All-Star Break.
- Tommy Milone** tossed 3.0 innings, the shortest start of his career (previous: 4.0 ip, June 13, 2012 at Colorado)...allowed a career-high tying 10 hits (also: July 14, 2012 at Minnesota)...has walked one batter or fewer in each of his last 13 starts, which is the second longest streak by a starting pitcher in Oakland history...it is one short of the record of 14 set by Gil Heredia from May 29-August 11, 1999.
- A's starting pitchers had their eight-game winning streak snapped...the streak of eight consecutive games with a win by the starting pitcher matched the second longest in Oakland history.
- Chris Carter** (2 for 4) has homered four times in his last eight games and has 14 home runs since June 29, the day he was called up from Triple-A.
- Josh Donaldson** (2 for 4) has homered in four of his past five games...is 24 for 71 (.338) with seven doubles, five home runs and 15 RBI in 19 games since he was recalled from Triple-A Sacramento August 14.

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels have won six of the last seven games and 10 of 13...are 3-1 on this six-game road trip to Seattle (2-1) and Oakland (1-0).
- The Angels hit three home runs, their 18th game of three or more home runs this season...the season-high is five (twice, last: August 8 at Oakland).
- C.J. Wilson** is 4-1 with a 2.11 ERA (9 er in 38.1 ip) in seven starts during the day compared to 7-8 with a 4.34 ERA (66 er in 137.0 ip) in 22 starts at night...is 7-7 with a 3.57 ERA (42 er in 106.0 ip) in 41 career games against Oakland...that includes 6-4 with a 3.01 ERA (26 er in 77.2 ip) in 12 starts.
- Erick Aybar** (2 for 5) has a .340 (53 for 156) career batting average in Oakland, which is tied for third highest in Coliseum history (min. 150 PA).
- Chris Iannetta** (3 for 4) had a season-high tying three hits (third time, last: August 23 at Boston)...is now batting .386 (22 for 57) over his last 16 games.
- Vernon Wells** (2 for 2) has four home runs and 12 RBI over his past 16 games after recording three home runs and 12 RBI in his previous 45 games.
