#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost the past three games, their first three-game losing streak since August 12-15...the losing streak follows the A's season-high nine-game winning streak...went 3-3 on this six-game homestand against Boston (3-0) and Los Angeles (0-3)...begin a seven-game road trip to Seattle (three games) and Los Angeles (four games) on Friday.
- The A's had their streak of 11 consecutive games with at least one home run snapped...hit 23 home runs total over that span.
- Brandon McCarthy** left the game in the fourth inning after being hit in the head by line drive off the bat of Aybar...he did not experience a loss of consciousness...was taken to Summit Hospital in Oakland for precautionary reasons.
- Brandon Moss** (1 for 2) had a pinch hit single in the seventh inning...is now 4 for 9 (.444) with three walks and two RBI as a pinch hitter.
- Derek Norris** (1 for 1) walked a career-high three times (previous: 2, August 11 at Chicago).

#### LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels have won eight of the last nine games and 12 of the last 15 to improve to a season-high 11 games over .500...swept the A's in Oakland for the first time since October 2-4, 2009...went 5-1 on this six-game road trip to Seattle (2-1) and Oakland (3-0)...begin a seven-game homestand against Detroit (three games) and Oakland (four games) on Friday.
- Dan Haren** is 4-2 with a 3.50 ERA (17 er in 43.2 ip) in eight starts since the All-Star Break...went 6-8 with a 4.86 ERA in 17 starts before the break...is 3-3 with a 3.51 ERA (23 er in 59.0 ip) in nine career starts against Oakland...including 1-1 with a 2.89 ERA (6 er in 18.2 ip) in three starts this year.
- Kevin Jepsen** has not allowed a run in 25 of his 27 appearances since being recalled from Triple-A Salt Lake July 5.
- Torii Hunter** (2 for 5) recorded three RBI, his sixth game of three or more RBI this year (last: July 25 vs. Kansas City)...is 17 for 34 (.500) with three doubles, one home run and nine RBI over his last eight games.
- Howie Kendrick** (2 for 4) has hit safely in 30 of his past 33 games (44 for 128, .344).
- Kendrys Morales** (1 for 2) walked a career-high three times (previous: 2, seven times; last: April 27, 2012 at Cleveland).
- Albert Pujols** (1 for 5) doubled in the third inning to extend his hitting streak to 14 games (21 for 58, .362)...it was his 40<sup>th</sup> double of the season, his seventh season of 40 or more doubles...now has 495 doubles in his career.
