Baltimore Orioles (81-62) vs. Oakland Athletics (82-61)

LH Joe Saunders (2-1, 4.24 in AL) vs. LH Tommy Milone (12-10, 3.90)



**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Orioles and Athletics meet in the opener of their three-game set and the first game of a nine-game, 10-day road trip that will also take the Birds to Seattle and Boston...The Orioles are coming off a 5-2 homestand against the Yankees (2-2) and Rays (3-0)...Birds have won 26 of their last 37 games...**The Orioles' 81 wins in 2012 are their most since 1997 (won 98)**...Since their loss July 17 at Minnesota which dropped their record to 46-44, the Orioles are 35-18, with 19 of the 35 wins being decided by one (11) or two runs (eight).

**VS. OAKLAND:** The season series is tied, 3-3, with all six games being played in Baltimore thus far...The Birds dropped the season series in 2011, 4-5, as the Birds were 3-0 in Baltimore but just 1-5 in Oakland...The Orioles trail in the all-time series 244-247 (119-125 in Baltimore and 125-122 in Oakland)...The Orioles have not won a season series against the A's since 1998 (8-3)...Since the start of the 2001 season, the Orioles are 17-33 at home against Oakland.

**RESTORE THE ORDER:** With Thursday's win over the Rays, the Orioles assured themselves of at least a .500 record in 2012...Their 81<sup>st</sup> win snapped a skid of 14 consecutive losing seasons...Prior to that skid, the O's had 13 losing seasons in their first 44 seasons.

**KRYPTONITE:** In his 19 career starts against Oakland, **Joe Saunders** is 13-4 with a 3.34 ERA (116.0IP, 43ER) and 12 Quality Starts...**Since 2005, his .765 winning percentage against the A's is the best in baseball**...In his last four starts against the A's, Saunders is 4-0 with a 1.16 ERA (31.0IP, 4ER) and two complete games (one shutout)...In his seven career starts in Oakland, Saunders is 6-1 with a 2.47 ERA (47.1IP, 13ER) and five QS.

**SOUTHPAW SHIFT:** The Orioles are 24-14 in games where their opponent started a left-handed pitcher (16-6 at home)...The 24 wins are more than the O's produced against lefties in 2011 (19-28) or 2010 (18-33)...The last year the O's had a winning record when their opponent started lefties was in 1997 (33-19).

**THE WEST IS A PEST:** The Orioles have posted a 12-16 record (.429) against the AL West this season, putting them on just a 69-win pace over 162 games...**Baltimore is 69-46 (.600) against the rest of baseball, a 97-win pace over a full season.**

**ROAD WARRIORS:** The Orioles have 39 road wins this year, nine more than their total in 2011 (30) and their most since 2004, when they won 40...The O's have 12 road games left counting tonight...**The 39 road wins are fourth in the AL behind Texas, New York and Oakland's 40.**

**EARNING IT:** The Orioles have played the most innings in all of baseball (1303.0)...The Athletics have played the fourth-most in baseball (1296.0) and second-most in the AL...The Nationals (1302.0) are second in the majors.

**WORLD BASEBALL CLASSIC QUALIFIERS:** Two Orioles farmhands will be playing in qualifying tournaments next week in hopes of reaching the 2013 World Baseball Classic...**OF Robbie Widlansky** will play for Team Israel and **OF Steven Bumbry**, son of Orioles Hall of Famer **Al Bumbry**, will play for Team England.

**YESTERDAY:** **Manny Machado** recorded his first career walk-off hit, a single in the 14<sup>th</sup> inning...The Orioles played their fourth game of 14 or more innings and improved to 4-0 in those games...Their only loss in a game of more than 10 innings was a 12-inning loss to the Yankees April 10 (8-1 in games lasting more than 10 innings).

**GIVE US SIX:** The Orioles are 64-18 (.780) when their starting pitchers go 6.0 innings or more...The Birds are just 17-44 (.279) when the starters work fewer than 6.0 innings.

**IMPACT GLOVE:** From Opening Day through August 8, Orioles third basemen combined for 24 errors and were last in the majors with a .914 fielding percentage (the team had a .980 fielding percentage, the worst in the majors)...**Since the Orioles selected the contract of Manny Machado on August 9, he has played every inning at third base, making just two errors for the third-best fielding percentage among AL third basemen (.979) and the Orioles as a team have made just 13 errors, for a .989 fielding percentage, which is second-best in the AL behind Kansas City (.990)**...Both of Machado's errors were throwing errors.

**BUCK-BALL:** Since the start of the 2011 season, the Orioles are 49-29 (.628) in one-run games, the highest winning percentage in baseball (Giants are second at .594 (60-41)...**Since Buck Showalter** took over as manager on August 3, 2010, the Orioles are 61-34 (.642) in one-run games...With their 27-7 (.794) record in one run games this year, **the Orioles are on pace to have the highest winning percentage in major league history in one-run games**...The record is currently held by the 1981 Orioles, who were 21-7 (.750) in one-run affairs.

**GET IT DONE:** A win today would put the Orioles 20 games over .500 for the first time since the end of the 1997 season...If the O's win and Yankees lose, it would be the first time the O's had sole possession of first place in the AL East in the month of September since the end of the 1997 season, when the Birds went wire-to-wire in first place, finishing 98-64...The '97 Birds made it to the ALCS, where they lost to Cleveland, four games to two.

**A FAMILY AFFAIR:** With his third win of the season September 11, **Steve Johnson** improved to 3-0 in his big league career...Combined with his father **Dave's** 22-25 career record, they are 25-25...According to Elias, the Johnsons are just the 13<sup>th</sup> father-son duo in baseball history to combine for a .500 or better mark in their careers with a minimum of 50 decisions...Other notable father-son tandems at or above .500 include **Dizzy** and **Steve Trout**, **Mel** and **Todd Stottlemire**, **Doug** and **Kyle Drabek** and **Pedro Borbon Sr** and **Jr**.

**EXTRA INNINGS:** The Orioles have won their last 13 extra innings games, extending a franchise record...The Birds have played 46 extra innings this year and have outscored their opponents 26-5 in extra frames...**The 13-game win streak in extra innings is tied with the 1995 Cleveland Indians for the longest extra innings win streak in the last 27 seasons**...The Orioles have played eight games that went 12 or more innings this year...The Birds are 7-1 in those games (only loss was April 10 vs. New York)...According to Elias, the last time the O's played more than eight games that went 12 or more innings was 1966 (10) and the all-time franchise record was set by the St. Louis Browns in 1914, with 13 games that went 12 or more innings...In the games that followed extra innings contests, the O's are 11-3 (5-3 at home, 6-0 on the road).

**PRODUCTIVE SEPTEMBERS:** In three Septembers under **Buck Showalter**, the Orioles are 37-29...The 37 wins are third-most in the AL behind Texas (41) and Detroit (40).

**GOLD GLOVE WORTHY:** **J.J. Hardy** leads major league shortstops in fielding percentage (.991), assists (473, 60 more than next guy), total chances (688) and range factor per game (4.91).

**TOMORROW'S STARTER:** LH **Zach Britton** will make his 11<sup>th</sup> start and sixth road start...In his five road starts, he is 3-1 with a 3.71 ERA (26.2IP, 11ER) and three Quality Starts...In his last two road starts (at Detroit and Toronto) he has not allowed a run over 14 innings...In three career starts against Oakland, Britton is 1-1 with a 6.62 ERA (17.2IP, 13 ER)...He completed five innings in all three starts, but completed six innings just once.

**FLIP THE SCRIPT:** With 13 games left to play against the AL East, the Orioles already have more wins in 2012 against the East (35) than they did the entire 2011 season (28)...The Birds won 24 games against the East in 2010 and 2009 and won just 22 in 2008...The last time the Birds won 35 or more games against the East was 2005 (36).

**HOME COOKING:** The Orioles have won 42 games at home for the first time since 2000, when they won 44... **Their win Wednesday clinched a winning home record for the first time since 2000, when the Birds went 44-37 (.543)**...The Orioles have homered in 39 of their 42 home wins (only wins without a homer were August 15 vs. Boston and Wednesday night and Thursday afternoon).

**BULLPEN IN EXTRA INNINGS:** In games that have gone extra innings this year, the Oriole bullpen has pitched to a 1.42 ERA (89.0IP, 14ER)...After the ninth inning in those games, the bullpen has pitched to a 0.98 ERA (46.0IP, 5ER) in extra inning play and has a 5.86 K/BB rate (41/7) in those games.

**CHARM CITY CRUSHERS:** The Birds have clubbed 110 homers at Camden Yards this season, tying the 1987 team for the second-most home runs at home in club history...**The club record is 121, done by the 1996 team and the 2012 club is on pace for 125**...Last year's squad hit 106 long balls at home...Only the Yankees (117) and White Sox (113) have more home runs at home.

**LAUNCHING PAD:** There have been 202 home runs hit at Camden Yards in 2012, the seventh-most in park history...The 214 homers hit in 2011 were the second-most behind the 229 homers in 1996...In 2012, only U.S. Cellular Field (CWS) – 208 in 73 games, and Coors Field (COL) – 203 in 74 games have seen more home runs.

**WINNING SERIES:** The Orioles have won 27 series in 2012 after winning just 16 series in 2011...The last time the Orioles won 27 or more series in one year was 1997, when they won 31...The 1997 season was also the last winning season for the Birds.

**THANK YOU, PLEASE COME AGAIN!:** The Orioles and Rays drew 25,130 fans for Thursday's game, pushing the Orioles' season attendance to 1,893,421 for the year, eclipsing their season total for each of the past two seasons...The Orioles have six home dates left and are on pace to draw more than 2,000,000 fans for the first time since 2007.

**MAKING A GOOD IMPRESSION:** In his six relief appearances, rookie **Steve Johnson** is 1-0 with a 1.74 ERA (10.1IP, 2ER) and opponents are batting .143 (5-35) against him as a reliever...In his two outings as a starter, Johnson is 2-0 with a 3.00 ERA (12.0IP, 4ER) and opponents are batting .214 (9-42) against him as a starter.

**FRESH FACES:** When OF **L.J. Hoes** makes his Orioles debut, he will become the 51<sup>st</sup> Oriole to play in a game this year and the 31<sup>st</sup> to make his Orioles debut this year...He will become the first position player to be born in Maryland to wear an Orioles uniform since **Cal Ripken, Jr.** made his debut on August 10, 1981...It will be the second time in franchise history the Orioles have used more than 50 more players in a season (the 1955 Orioles used 54 players)...The Birds used 50 players in 2011 and 2000...The 31 Oriole debuts are the most since the club's first two seasons (1954-55, when all players were new and 43 players debuted in 1955)...The next highest total was 25 Orioles debuts in 2000.

**ANOTHER BEAST IN THE EAST:** The Orioles have **won eight of their 10 road series against AL East opponents** (three in New York, two each in Boston and Toronto and one in Tampa Bay)...The Birds were swept in Toronto, May 28-30 and dropped a series at Tampa Bay, June 1-3...The Orioles' five wins in Boston are their most since 2005 (also five) and their six wins in New York are their most since 1976 (eight).

**A BAD BREAK:** **Nick Markakis** suffered a broken left thumb Saturday after being hit by a **C.C. Sabathia** pitch...Markakis, who had never broken a bone in his life entering the season, has now suffered a broken right hamate bone and broken left thumb since May 30...Following the first DL stint of his career for the hamate bone (May 30-July 8), Markakis batted in the leadoff spot in each game (first time in his career he has led off) with the Orioles going 33-21 in those games as he batted .335 (74-221) with 15 doubles, two triples, five homers, 34 runs scored, 28 RBI and an .879 OPS in the leadoff spot...During that span, he raised his average from .256 to .298.

**SECOND-YEAR SENSATION:** In **Buck Showalter's** second full season as manager, the Orioles are on pace to win 92 games, which would be a 23-game improvement over last year's 69-93 mark...**In 2004, Showalter's second full year in Texas, he led the Texas Rangers to an 18-game improvement and was named the AL Manager of the Year**...In Showalter's second full year in Arizona (1999), he led a 35-game improvement...His second full year in New York (1993) resulted in a 12-game improvement...The O's are 184-178 under Showalter.

**AMAZING AUGUST:** The Orioles were 18-9 (.667) in August (12-4 at home, 6-5 on the road), marking their most wins in any month this season (previous high was 15 in May)...The last time the Birds won 18 games in a month was September 2004 (18)...**According to Elias, the Orioles' winning percentage was the best in the majors in August and marked the first time the Orioles have produced the majors' highest winning percentage (or even tied for the highest) in any month in which every big-league team played at least 10 games since May of 1997**, when the Birds went 20-8 under Davey Johnson.

**CLOSE CALLS:** The Orioles' franchise-record streak of 13 consecutive wins in one-run games (dating back to June 22) was snapped September 1...According to Elias, it was the longest winning streak in one-run games since the 1984 Toronto Blue Jays won 19 straight one-run games...The O's are 49-20 in games decided by one (27-7) or two (22-13) runs.

**COMEBACK KIDS:** The Orioles are 33-43 when their opponent scores first...In the past two years, the Birds were 44-128 when their opponent scored first (22-63 in 2011 and 22-65 in 2010).

**SWINGMAN:** **Adam Jones** hit the 100<sup>th</sup> home run of his career August 28 and his 100<sup>th</sup> as an Oriole on September 6...The August 28 homer snapped a 110 at-bat homerless stretch for Jones, the longest of his career...He became the 786<sup>th</sup> major leaguer to hit 100 home runs and the 22<sup>nd</sup> Oriole to hit 100 homers for the Birds...His 29 homers in 2012 are a career-high...**The O's are 20-8 when Jones homers and 18 of his 29 homers have tied the game (3) or given the O's the lead (15)**...Jones fell two hits and one double shy of becoming the first player in franchise history to record 100 hits, 50 runs, 20 doubles, 20 home runs and 10 stolen bases before the All-Star break...He has recorded a hit in 112 of his 143 games played...Jones' game winning single in the bottom of the 14<sup>th</sup> inning August 7<sup>th</sup> was his fourth game-winning RBI in the 12<sup>th</sup> inning or later this year...According to Elias, the last player to have four game-winning RBI in the 12<sup>th</sup> inning or later in one season was Houston's **Rafael Ramirez** in 1989...Jones has six career walk-off RBI, including three HR and a walk-off bunt single (August 16, 2010).

**A NEW ROLE:** Since his recall from Triple-A on August 24, **Brian Matusz** has worked in relief in 10 games, allowing just three hits (one a solo homer by **Curtis Granderson**), one intentional walk and two earned runs over 7.1 innings while striking out 11...He has stranded all nine inherited runners.

**THE SAVE-IOR:** **Jim Johnson** notched his 42<sup>nd</sup> save Saturday, the second-most in one season in O's history (**Randy Myers** holds the record with 45 in 1997)...Johnson recorded his 30<sup>th</sup> save on July 22, becoming the second-fastest pitcher (95 games) to reach 30 saves in a season for the Birds...**Lee Smith** recorded his 30<sup>th</sup> in 1994 in the 87<sup>th</sup> game on July 14...**Johnson is on pace for 48 saves**...He became the first Oriole to be named MLB's Delivery Man of the Month in May (award began in '05).

**NOT MESSING AROUND:** Since allowing six earned runs in one-third of an inning July 27 against Oakland, **Jim Johnson** has made 16 appearances, recording 12 saves and allowing just nine runners into scoring position (one scored, four to third base and four to second)...In those 16 games, he has allowed 11 hits and two walks while striking out 11 over 15.2 innings...Opponents are batting .196 against him (11-56) in those 16 outings...**In those 16 outings, Johnson retired the side in order nine times.**

**STRANGE BUT TRUE:** In their 143 games played, the O's have had 41 games where they failed to get a hit with runners in scoring position and 29 more where they posted just one hit with RISP...**The Orioles have won 15 of the 41 games in which they did not get a hit with RISP and have won 14 of the 29 games in which they recorded just one hit with RISP.**

**ROSTER CHAOS:** Despite playing just 142 games, the Orioles have made 168 roster moves this year since setting their Opening Day roster (40-man and 25-man roster included)...The Birds have optioned 33 players, recalled 34, placed 19 on the 15-day DL, selected the contract of 18, designated 17 for assignment, reinstated 12 from the DL, placed nine on the 60-day DL, outrighted nine, lost four on waivers, traded for five, traded away two, claimed one on waivers, had one take paternity leave, added one player, signed one as a free agent and had one elect free agency.

**FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH:** **Lew Ford** went 2-for-4 with a solo home run, a stolen base and two RBI Saturday with his first multi-RBI game this season and first since June 30, 2007, when he had three at Detroit as a member of the Minnesota Twins...It was his first stolen base since July 31, 2007.

**QUICK HITS:** Is making his fourth start for the Orioles after being acquired on August 26... Orioles are his third major league team (Angels 2005-10 and Diamondbacks 2010-12)... Was a 2008 American League All-Star... His 33 wins from 2008-09 were second only to **Roy Halladay's** 37... Named Angels Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2005 and 2006... Acquired by the D-backs from the Angels on July 25, 2010, along with LHP **Patrick Corbin**, RHP **Rafael Rodriguez** and LHP **Tyler Skaggs** in exchange for RHP **Dan Haren**... Was selected by the Angels in the 1<sup>st</sup> round of the 2002 draft out of Virginia Tech.

**LIFETIME VS. OAKLAND:** In his 19 career starts against Oakland, Saunders is 13-4 with a 3.34 ERA (116.0IP, 43ER) and 12 Quality Starts... In his last four starts against the A's, Saunders is 4-0 with a 1.16 ERA (31.0IP, 4ER) and two complete games (one shutout)... In his seven career starts in Oakland, Saunders is 6-1 with a 2.47 ERA (47.1IP, 13ER) and five Quality Starts... His winning percentage against the A's (.765) is the best in baseball since 2005.

**LAST START:** Beat the Yankees and **CC Sabathia** September 8 in Baltimore as he worked 5.1 innings and allowed two runs on five hits and two walks... Struck out two and left with a 3-2 lead... The O's won 5-4.

**STRONG START:** Saunders retired the first 17 batters he faced September 3 at Toronto... According to Elias, it was the fourth game this season in which the Birds held their opponent hitless through at least 5.2 innings... **Jason Hammel** has done it twice and **Wei-Yin Chen** did it once... The Orioles had only two no-hit bids of that length (or longer) over the previous four seasons combined (2008-11), both by **Chris Tillman** (once each in 2010 and 2011).

**CAREER AS A STARTER:** In 185 career starts, Saunders is 77-63 with a 4.17 ERA (1133.2IP, 525ER) with 102 Quality Starts... His teams are 103-82 in games he starts.

**AT HOME:** In 97 starts, is 36-33 with a 4.62 ERA (584.0IP, 300ER).

**ON THE ROAD:** In 88 starts, is 41-30 with a 3.68 ERA (549.2IP, 225ER).

**AT ORIOLE PARK:** In five career starts he is 4-1 with a 5.40 ERA (28.1IP, 17ER) and two Quality Starts... For the Orioles, he is 1-1 with a 6.75 ERA (10.2IP, 8ER).

**OUCH:** Saunders was on the 15-day disabled list from June 23 (retro to June 17) to July 14 with left shoulder soreness... It was his second-ever stint on the Major League DL (also Aug. 8-26, 2008 with left shoulder irritation).

**HELP HIM OUT:** In his 24 starts in 2012, Saunders received one or no runs of support while he was in the game 10 times (no runs four times and one run six times).

**SELECT COMPANY:** Among left-handers since 2008, his 62 wins ranks sixth among left-handers behind **C.C. Sabathia** (89), **Jon Lester** (74), **Cliff Lee** (70), **Mark Buehrle** (66) and **Cole Hamels** (64)... His 946.1 innings pitched are seventh behind the above five and teammate **Randy Wolf** (981.0).

**THE WORKHORSE:** Is one of 10 left-handed pitchers to register at least 30 starts and 200.0 innings every year since 2010 along with **Mark Buehrle**, **Gio Gonzalez**, **Cole Hamels**, **Clayton Kershaw**, **David Price**, **Ricky Romero**, **CC Sabathia**, **C.J. Wilson** and **Randy Wolf**.

**AS A HITTER:** Is a career .138 (17-for-123) hitter with 6 RBI... Batted .197 with a double and 4 RBI in 2011... Has three career two-hit games: Sept. 4, 2010 vs. Astros, May 8 @ Padres and Aug. 6 vs. Dodgers.

**CAREER FIRSTS:** Made his major league debut August 16, 2005 against Toronto (no-decision)... Picked up his first major league win July 18, 2006 against Cleveland... Struck out **Corey Koskie** on August 16, 2005 for his first major league strikeout... Notched his first major league hit September 4, 2010 with a single against Houston's **Bud Norris**.

**HOKIE PRIDE:** Received special permission from **Bud Selig** to wear a Virginia Tech cap (his alma mater) in his April 20, 2007 start after the shootings on the Tech campus.

**PERSONAL:** Joseph Francis Saunders III and his wife, Shantal, have two daughters: Mattea and Avellina... Is a 1999 graduate of West Springfield (VA) HS... Attended Virginia Tech Univ. and went 27-7 for the Hokies... Joe and Shantel started the Team Saundo program (teamsaundo.com) in 2009 and in 2011, distributed backpacks filled with school supplies to local youth in need and hosted chronically-ill children and their families in suites for games in Phoenix.
