Baltimore Orioles (81-64) vs. Oakland Athletics (84-61)

LH Randy Wolf (2-0, 5.68 in AL) vs. RHP Dan Straily (2-0, 3.42)

TODAY'S GAME: The Orioles and Athletics meet in the final game of their three-game set and the third game of a nine-game, 10-day road trip that will also take the Birds to Seattle and Boston...The O's are coming off a 5-2 homestand against the Yankees (2-2) and Rays (3-0)...Birds have won 26 of their last 39 games...**The Orioles' 81 wins in 2012 are their most since 1997 (won 98)**...Since their loss July 17 at Minnesota which dropped their record to 46-44, the O's are 35-20, with 19 of the 35 wins being decided by one (11) or two runs (eight).

VS. OAKLAND: The A's lead the season series, 5-3...The Birds dropped the season series in 2011, 4-5, as the Birds were 3-0 in Baltimore but just 1-5 in Oakland...The Orioles trail in the all-time series 244-249 (119-125 in Baltimore and 125-124 in Oakland)...The Orioles have not won a season series against the A's since 1998 (8-3)...According to Elias, Friday night's game marked the first time since September 2, 1992 the O's and A's had faced each other this late in the season with both teams above .500.

HOUSE OF PAIN: The Orioles have lost 16 of their last 18 games at Oakland Coliseum dating back to 2008..The Birds have been outscored 90-55 by the A's in those contests...O's pitchers have a 4.93 ERA and .276 opponents' average, while A's pitchers have a 2.69 ERA and have held O's batters to a .228 average over the span...The Birds are 8-29 in Oakland since the 2003 season.

GOOD AFTERNOON: The Orioles are 27-14 in day games (12-8 at home, 15-6 on the road)...Their .659 winning percentage in day games is the best in the AL and second in the majors behind Cincinnati (34-17, .667).

SERIES FINALES: The Orioles are 25-21 in series finales in 2012 (14-10 at home and 11-11 on the road).

AT HOME ON THE ROAD: In 14 games on the road, **Manny Machado** has batted .353 (18-51) with six runs, five extra base hits with four RBI...He is hitting .213 (16-75) with 10 runs, seven extra base hits and 11 RBI in 20 games at home.

MINIMIZE THE DAMAGE: Last night's loss marked only the second time since August 4 the Birds have lost back-to-back games...The Birds are 26-13 over that time...The last time they lost back-to-back games to the same opponent was July 27-28, also against the A's.

THE WEST IS A PEST: The Orioles have posted a 12-18 record (.400) against the AL West this season, putting them on just a 65-win pace over 162 games...**Baltimore is 69-46 (.600) against the rest of baseball, a 97-win pace over a full season.**

IMPACT GLOVE: From Opening Day through August 8, Orioles third basemen combined for 24 errors and were last in the majors with a .914 fielding percentage (the team had a .980 fielding percentage, the worst in the majors)...**Since the Orioles selected the contract of Manny Machado on August 9, he has played every inning at third base, making just two errors for the third-best fielding percentage among AL third basemen (.980) and the Orioles as a team have made just 13 errors, for a .991 fielding percentage, first in the American League**...The Birds have not committed more than one error in a game over that span after committing multiple errors in a game in 24 of their first 111 games...Both of Machado's errors were throwing errors.

RESTORE THE ORDER: With Thursday's win over the Rays, the Orioles assured themselves of at least a .500 record in 2012...Their 81st win snapped a skid of 14 consecutive losing seasons...Prior to that skid, the O's had 13 losing seasons in their first 44 seasons.

ROAD WARRIORS: The Orioles have 39 road wins this year, nine more than their total in 2011 (30) and their most since 2004, when they won 40...The O's have 10 road games left counting today...**The 39 road wins are fourth in the AL behind Texas, New York and Oakland's 40.**

EARNING IT: The Orioles have played the most innings in all of baseball (1319.0)...The Athletics have played the fourth-most in baseball (1314.0) and second-most in the AL...The Nationals (1318.1) are second in the majors.

GIVE US SIX: The Orioles are 64-19 (.771) when their starting pitchers go 6.0 innings or more...The Birds are just 17-45 (.274) when the starters work fewer than 6.0 innings.

BUCK-BALL: Since the start of the 2011 season, the Orioles are 49-30 (.620) in one-run games, the highest winning percentage in baseball (Giants are second at .598 (61-41))...Since **Buck Showalter** took over as manager on August 3, 2010, the Orioles are 61-35 (.635) in one-run games...With their 27-8 (.771) record in one run games this year, **the Orioles are on pace to have the highest winning percentage in major league history in one-run games**...The record is currently held by the 1981 Orioles, who were 21-7 (.750) in one-run affairs.

SECOND-YEAR SENSATION: In **Buck Showalter's** second full season as manager, the Orioles are on pace to win 90 games, which would be a 21-game improvement over last year's 69-93 mark...**In 2004, Showalter's second full year in Texas, he led the Texas Rangers to an 18-game improvement and was named the AL Manager of the Year**...In Showalter's second full year in Arizona (1999), he led a 35-game improvement...His second full year in New York (1993) resulted in a 12-game improvement...The O's are 184-180 under Showalter.

PRODUCTIVE SEPTEMBERS: In three Septembers under **Buck Showalter**, the Orioles are 37-31...The 37 wins are third-most in the AL behind Texas (43) and Detroit (42).

MAKING A GOOD IMPRESSION: In his seven relief appearances, rookie **Steve Johnson** is 1-0 with a 1.35 ERA (13.1IP, 2ER) and opponents are batting .133 (6-45) against him as a reliever...In his two outings as a starter, Johnson is 2-0 with a 3.00 ERA (12.0IP, 4ER) and opponents are batting .214 (9-42) against him.

THE SAVE-IOR: **Jim Johnson** notched his 42nd save on September 8, the second-most in one season in O's history (**Randy Myers** holds the record with 45 in 1997)...Johnson recorded his 30th save on July 22, becoming the second-fastest pitcher (95 games) to reach 30 saves in a season for the Birds...**Lee Smith** recorded his 30th in 1994 in the 87th game on July 14...**Johnson is on pace for 47 saves.**

NOT MESSING AROUND: Since allowing six earned runs in one-third of an inning July 27 against Oakland, **Jim Johnson** has made 16 appearances, recording 12 saves and allowing just nine runners into scoring position (one scored, four to third base and four to second)...In those 16 games, he has allowed 11 hits and two walks while striking out 11 over 15.2 innings...Opponents are batting .196 against him (11-56) in those 16 outings...**In those 16 outings, Johnson retired the side in order nine times.**

TOMORROW'S STARTER: **Chris Tillman** will make his 12th start of the season and his 7th start on the road...Tillman is 2-0 with an 0.57 ERA (15.2IP, 3ER) in two starts against the Mariners this season and 3-0 with an 0.83 ERA (21.2IP, 2ER) in three career starts against his former team...He is 4-1 with a 3.26 ERA (30.1IP, 11ER) in his six road outings in 2012.

SOUTHPAW SHIFT: The Orioles are 24-15 in games where their opponent started a left-handed pitcher (16-6 at home)...The 24 wins are more than the O's produced against lefties in 2011 (19-28) or 2010 (18-33)...The last year the O's had a winning record when their opponent started lefties was in 1997 (33-19).

A NEW ROLE: Since his recall from Triple-A on August 24, **Brian Matusz** has worked in relief in 10 games, allowing just three hits (one a solo homer by **Curtis Granderson**), one intentional walk and two earned runs over 7.1 innings while striking out 11...He has stranded all nine inherited runners.

FLIP THE SCRIPT: With 13 games left to play against the AL East, the Orioles already have more wins in 2012 against the East (35) than they did the entire 2011 season (28)...The Birds won 24 games against the East in 2010 and 2009 and won just 22 in 2008...The last time the Birds won 35 or more games against the East was 2005 (36).

HOME COOKING: The Orioles have won 42 games at home for the first time since 2000, when they won 44... **Their win Wednesday clinched a winning home record for the first time since 2000, when the Birds went 44-37 (.543)**...The Orioles have homered in 39 of their 42 home wins (only wins without a homer were August 15 vs. Boston and Wednesday night and Thursday afternoon).

EXTRA INNINGS: The Orioles have won their last 13 extra innings games, extending a franchise record...The Birds have played 46 extra innings this year and have outscored their opponents 26-5 in extra frames...**The 13-game win streak in extra innings is tied with the 1995 Cleveland Indians for the longest extra innings win streak in the last 27 seasons**...The Orioles have played eight games that went 12 or more innings this year...The Birds are 7-1 in those games (only loss was April 10 vs. New York)...According to Elias, the last time the O's played more than eight games that went 12 or more innings was 1966 (10) and the all-time franchise record was set by the St. Louis Browns in 1914, with 13 games that went 12 or more innings... The Orioles have played four games of 14 or more innings and are 4-0 in those games...In the games that followed extra innings contests, the O's are 11-4 (5-3 at home, 6-1 on the road).

BULLPEN IN EXTRA INNINGS: In games that have gone extra innings this year, the Oriole bullpen has pitched to a 1.42 ERA (89.0IP, 14ER)...After the ninth inning in those games, the bullpen has pitched to a 0.98 ERA (46.0IP, 5ER) in extra inning play and has a 5.86 K/BB rate (41/7) in those games.

CHARM CITY CRUSHERS: The Birds have clubbed 110 homers at Camden Yards this season, tying the 1987 team for the second-most home runs at home in club history...**The club record is 121, done by the 1996 team and the 2012 club is on pace for 125**...Last year's squad hit 106 long balls at home...Only the Yankees (119) and White Sox (113) have more home runs at home.

LAUNCHING PAD: There have been 202 home runs hit at Camden Yards in 2012, the seventh-most in park history...The 214 homers hit in 2011 were the second-most behind the 229 homers in 1996...In 2012, only U.S. Cellular Field (CWS) – 208 in 73 games, and Coors Field (COL) – 203 in 74 games have seen more home runs.

WINNING SERIES: The Orioles have won 27 series in 2012 after winning just 16 series in 2011...The last time the Orioles won 27 or more series in one year was 1997, when they won 31...The 1997 season was also the last winning season for the Birds.

COMEBACK KIDS: The Orioles are 33-43 when their opponent scores first...In the past two years, the Birds were 44-128 when their opponent scored first (22-63 in 2011 and 22-65 in 2010).

THANK YOU, PLEASE COME AGAIN!: The Orioles and Rays drew 25,130 fans for Thursday's game, pushing the Orioles' season attendance to 1,893,421 for the year, eclipsing their season total for each of the past two seasons...The Orioles have six home dates left and are on pace to draw more than 2,000,000 fans for the first time since 2007.

A FAMILY AFFAIR: With his third win of the season September 11, **Steve Johnson** improved to 3-0 in his big league career...Combined with his father **Dave's** 22-25 career record, they are 25-25...According to Elias, the Johnsons are just the 13th father-son duo in baseball history to combine for a .500 or better mark in their careers with a minimum of 50 decisions...Other notable father-son tandems at or above .500 include **Dizzy** and **Steve Trout**, **Mel** and **Todd Stottlemire**, **Doug** and **Kyle Drabek** and **Pedro Borbon Sr** and **Jr**.

FRESH FACES: When **OF L.J. Hoes** makes his Orioles debut, he will become the 51st Oriole to play in a game this year and the 31st to make his Orioles debut this year...He will become the first position player to be born in Maryland to wear an Orioles uniform since **Cal Ripken, Jr.** made his debut on August 10, 1981...It will be the second time in franchise history the Orioles have used more than 50 more players in a season (the 1955 Orioles used 54 players)...The Birds used 50 players in 2011 and 2000...The 31 Oriole debuts are the most since the club's first two seasons (1954-55, when all players were new and 43 players debuted in 1955)...The next highest total was 25 Orioles debuts in 2000.

ANOTHER BEAST IN THE EAST: The Orioles have **won eight of their 10 road series against AL East opponents** (three in New York, two each in Boston and Toronto and one in Tampa Bay)...The Birds were swept in Toronto, May 28-30 and dropped a series at Tampa Bay, June 1-3...The Orioles' five wins in Boston are their most since 2005 (also five) and their six wins in New York are their most since 1976 (eight).

A BAD BREAK: **Nick Markakis** suffered a broken left thumb Saturday after being hit by a **C.C. Sabathia** pitch...Markakis, who had never broken a bone in his life entering the season, has now suffered a broken right hamate bone and broken left thumb since May 30...Following the first DL stint of his career for the hamate bone (May 30-July 8), Markakis batted in the leadoff spot in each game (first time in his career he has led off) with the Orioles going 33-21 in those games as he batted .335 (74-221) with 15 doubles, two triples, five homers, 34 runs scored, 28 RBI and an .879 OPS in the leadoff spot...During that span, he raised his average from .256 to .298.

AMAZING AUGUST: The Orioles were 18-9 (.667) in August (12-4 at home, 6-5 on the road), marking their most wins in any month this season (previous high was 15 in May)...The last time the Birds won 18 games in a month was September 2004 (18)...**According to Elias, the Orioles' winning percentage was the best in the majors in August and marked the first time the Orioles have produced the majors' highest winning percentage (or even tied for the highest) in any month in which every big-league team played at least 10 games since May of 1997**, when the Birds went 20-8 under Davey Johnson.

CLOSE CALLS: The Orioles' franchise-record streak of 13 consecutive wins in one-run games (dating back to June 22) was snapped September 1...According to Elias, it was the longest winning streak in one-run games since the 1984 Toronto Blue Jays won 19 straight one-run games...The O's are 49-21 in games decided by one (27-8) or two (22-13) runs.

SWINGMAN: **Adam Jones** hit the 100th home run of his career August 28 and his 100th as an Oriole on September 6...The August 28 homer snapped a 110 at-bat homerless stretch for Jones, the longest of his career...He became the 786th major leaguer to hit 100 home runs and the 22nd Oriole to hit 100 homers for the Birds...His 29 homers in 2012 are a career-high...**The O's are 20-8 when Jones homers and 18 of his 29 homers have tied the game (3) or given the O's the lead (15)**...Jones fell two hits and one double shy of becoming the first player in franchise history to record 100 hits, 50 runs, 20 doubles, 20 home runs and 10 stolen bases before the All-Star break...He has recorded a hit in 112 of his 143 games played...Jones' game winning single in the bottom of the 14th inning August 7th was his fourth game-winning RBI in the 12th inning or later this year...According to Elias, the last player to have four game-winning RBI in the 12th inning or later in one season was Houston's **Rafael Ramirez** in 1989...Jones has six career walk-off RBI, including three HR and a walk-off bunt single (August 16, 2010).

STRANGE BUT TRUE: In their 145 games played, the O's have had 42 games where they failed to get a hit with runners in scoring position and 30 more where they posted just one hit with RISP...**The Orioles have won 15 of the 42 games in which they did not get a hit with RISP and have won 14 of the 30 games in which they recorded just one hit with RISP**.

ROSTER CHAOS: Despite playing just 144 games, the Orioles have made 170 roster moves this year since setting their Opening Day roster (40-man and 25-man roster included)...The Birds have optioned 33 players, recalled 34, placed 19 on the 15-day DL, selected the contract of 18, designated 17 for assignment, reinstated 12 from the DL, placed nine on the 60-day DL, outrighted 10, lost four on waivers, traded for five, traded away two, released one, claimed one on waivers, had one take paternity leave, added one player, signed one as a free agent and had one elect free agency.

WORLD BASEBALL CLASSIC QUALIFIERS: Two O's farmhands will play in qualifying tournaments next week in hopes of reaching the 2013 World Baseball Classic...**OF Robbie Widlansky** will play for Team Israel and **OF Steven Bumbry**, son of Orioles Hall of Famer **Al Bumbry**, will play for Team Great Britain.

AWARD WINNERS: The Orioles have named their organizational players for the month of August – pitcher **Jacob Pettit**, nominated by Bowie, and outfielder **LJ Hoes**, nominated by Norfolk.

QUICK HITS: Is making his first start for the Orioles after making three relief appearances...Orioles are his sixth major league team (Phillies, Dodgers, Padres, Astros and Brewers)...Was a 2003 National League All-Star (game at Chicago-AL) when he won a career-high 16 games...Had Tommy John surgery in 2005...Was selected by the Phillies in the 2nd round of the 1997 draft out of Pepperdine...Brother, **Jim**, has been a major league umpire since 1999 (by rule, Jim is not allowed to work the plate when Randy pitches).

CAREER VS. OAKLAND: In two career starts against the A's, Wolf is 1-0 with a 2.77 ERA (13.0IP, 4ER) and two Quality Starts...His teams are 2-0 in his starts against Oakland.

LAST START: Was on August 18 against the Phillies for the Brewers...Was tagged with his fourth straight loss as a starter as he allowed five runs on 10 hits and two walks over 7.0 innings...Struck out four.

CAREER AS A STARTER: In 366 career starts, Wolf is 129-117 with a 4.18 ERA (2243.2IP, 1043ER) and 201 Quality Starts...His teams are 196-170 in games he starts.

AT HOME: In 181 starts, is 62-53 with a 4.02 ERA (1125.0IP, 502ER).

ON THE ROAD: In 185 starts, is 67-64 with a 4.35 ERA (1118.2IP, 541ER).

AT ORIOLE PARK: In six career games, is 5-0 with a 3.55 ERA (25.1IP, 10ER)...In three career starts at Camden Yards, is 3-0 with a 3.10 ERA (20.1IP, 7ER)...He has not started a game at Camden Yards since May 20, 2005.

AMONG THE BEST: His 201 career Quality Starts are 13th-most among active pitchers...His 49 wins from 2008-11 were the third-most by a lefty in the NL behind **Ted Lilly** (51) and **Cole Hamels** (50).

THE WORKHORSE: Is one of 10 left-handed pitchers to register at least 30 starts and 200.0 innings every year since 2010 along with **Mark Buehrle**, **Gio Gonzalez**, **Cole Hamels**, **Clayton Kershaw**, **David Price**, **Ricky Romero**, **CC Sabathia**, **Joe Saunders** and **C.J. Wilson**.

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Has made four postseason starts...Started games in the 2009 NLDS and NLCS for Los Angeles and started in the 2011 NLDS and NLCS with Milwaukee...Has a 1-1 record with a 6.63 ERA (19.0IP, 14ER) in those four postseason starts.

RUNNER: On August 30, 2010 at Cincinnati, became the first pitcher in Brewers history to steal a base (against **Homer Bailey/Ryan Hanigan**).

MILESTONES: Recorded 100th win on September 5, 2009 for the Dodgers against San Diego...Recorded 500th strikeout July 3, 2002 (**Joe McEwing**), 1000th strikeout April 25, 2007 (**Todd Linden**) and 1,500th career strikeout September 5, 2010 at Philadelphia (**Jayson Werth**).

AT THE PLATE: Has five career home runs, including one two-homer game (August 11, 2004 vs. Colorado, solo homer off **Jason Jennings** and two-run homer off **Adam Bernero**)... Also homered August 22, 2002 at Milwaukee, April 24, 2004 at Montreal, August 16, 2009 at Arizona...In 2010, led major league pitchers with 11 runs scored and tied **Dan Haren** for the lead with 19 hits...Led major league pitchers with three home runs in 2004.

IN THE TRAINING ROOM: Had Tommy John surgery (**Dr. Lewis Yocum**) on July 1, 2005...Had arthroscopic shoulder surgery (Dr. Yocum and **Dr. Neal Elattrache**) on September 5, 2009.

CAREER FIRSTS: Made his major league debut and picked up the win for the Phillies on June 11, 1999 against Toronto...Struck out **Shawn Green** that day for his first MLB strikeout...Notched his first major league hit June 16, 1999 at San Diego with a single off **Sterling Hitchcock**...Hit first major league home run August 22, 2002 at Milwaukee off **Jimmy Osting**...Was the winning pitcher in the first game played at Houston's Minute Maid Park (then Enron Field) on April 7, 2000.

WORLD TRAVELER: Toured Japan with the Major League All-Star squad in November of 2002.

COLLEGE LIFE: Attended Pepperdine University, where he was named First Team All-West Coast Conference as a freshman, sophomore and junior...Was inducted into the Pepperdine Hall of Fame in 2010...Tossed a no-hitter vs. Gonzaga on May 15, 1996...Pitched for the U.S. National Team in 1995 (4-0, 1.90) and 1996 (2-0, 4.50)...Named 1997 West Coast Conference Pitcher of the Year and was named to the West Coast Conference 40th Anniversary Team in 2006.

A MAN OF THE PEOPLE: Co-hosted celebrity billiards tournaments while with the Phillies, which raised money for the Philadelphia Futures mentor program...Served as spokesman for the Children's Miracle Network while in Philadelphia...Won the Phillies' Community Service Award and was the team's nominee for the Roberto Clemente Award for his outstanding community service in 2003...Had a community program called the "Wolf Den" while pitching for the Dodgers...Treated Children's Hospital kids to tickets, food, and pre-game meet-and-greets...Was a member of the Greater Los Angeles Chapter and Greater San Diego Chapter of the ALS Association...Over the last two years has financed the building of a peace garden and art therapy room at the Ronald McDonald House of Milwaukee.

IF WALLS COULD TALK: In 2009, Wolf bought the house previously owned by guitarist "Slash" of Guns 'N Roses.

PERSONAL: Graduated from El Camino Real (CA) High School, where he threw a no-hitter and perfect game as a junior in consecutive starts...Enjoys poker and is an avid movie-goer.
