#### ON THE ROAD AGAIN

The Mari e Mariners conclude their road schedule w/this 6-game trip to LAA & OAK...Seattle finishes the road schedule w/55.000 miles flown/trained to 3 countries.

#### ON THE AIR

Mariners will use rotation of announcers this season, all former partners of HOF announcer Dave Niehaus...Rick Rizzs, Dave Sims and Mike Blowers will work nearly all games...tonight Sims & Blowers will call the game on ROOT Sports, with Rizzs and **Dan Wilson** calling the action on the Mariners Radio Network. TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners begin the final road series of the season with the first of three at Oakland...trip began with three games in Los Angeles (1-2)...will close out the season with a threegame "homestand" vs. the Angels Oct. 1-3...tonight's game will be televised on ROOT Sports in HD and broadcast live on 710 ESPN Seattle & the Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...won yest. to snap a 3G losing streak...are 3-3 in last 6 but have lost 7 of last 10, including a 4-game losing streak, and 9 of last 13 games...3-8 in last 11 games at Safeco Field, after winning 17 of 20 from July 26-Sept. 3...season-high 8-game win streak Aug. 14-22; longest win streak since 2007...won 12 of last 21 series...are 9-14 in Sept. after posting back-to-back winning months in August (15-12) and July (15-11)...37-32 (.536) post All-Star break.

- Head West -- Finished 10-19 (.345) when playing in the Eastern Time Zone this season.

  Thefts -- Successful in 24 of last 30 SB attempts (80.0%), 2nd-highest pct. in MLB since Aug. 14.
- Close Games -- 106 of 156 games decided by 3 or less runs, combining to go 52-54; 1-Run: 25-28, 2-Run: 13-16; 3-Run: 14-10...most 1-run games (53) among all AL teams...won 7 of last 14 1-run G.
- 2012 WINS -- With 73 wins, Mariners have passed their win total from 2011 (67) & 2010 (61).
- Gold Gloves -- Mariners lead the Majors with .988 FLD%...played error-free in 96 of 156 games.
- Tom Wilhelmsen has recorded a save in 8 of the Mariners 9 wins this month (29-for-33 in '12).
- **Pinch Hitting -- John Jaso** (.353/6x17, 4 RBI) is 2nd in the AL with 6 pinch hits (Ibañez, 7). **Left on Left --** LH **Charlie Furbush** has held LH batters to a .149 batting average (11x74).

**SEATTLE VS. ATHLETICS**...tonight is the 17th of 19 games between the Mariners and A's in 2012... the Mariners trail the season series 7-9, going 3-6 in SEA, 3-2 in OAK and 1-1 in Tokyo...the Mariners went 10-9 against the A's last season, but were 4-5 at the Coliseum...Seattle is 60-51 vs. Oakland since 2007, which is the Mariners highest winning percentage vs. any AL team over that stretch... Seattle trails the all-time series 224-301, including a 96-166 (.366) mark here in the Coliseum.

INITIAL IMPRESSION ... the A's are starting A.J. Griffin tonight, and Seattle faced C.J. Wilson on Wednesday...the Mariners are 0-4 this season in games started by pitchers who use their initials, losing in games started by C.J. twice (May 27, Sept. 26), C.C. Sabathia (Aug. 3) and A.J. on Sept. 7.

JOLTIN' JASO ... John Jaso hit his 10th homer of the season yesterday...he now has 10 longballs in 103 games (343 PA) this season...entering this season he had 10 HR in his career in 203 games (687 PA).

D-FICIENT...the Mariners have committed an uncharacteristic 10 errors in their last 12 games (4-8), a .980 fielding percentage, and have posed just 3 errorless games...in the seasons first 144 games, Seattle committed just 57 errors, a .989 fielding percentage, and had 96 errorless games.

SMOAKIN'...Justin Smoak is batting .348 (23x66) with 10 runs, 4 doubles, 5 HR and 9 RBI in 20 games in September, including 19-for-his-last-44 (.432) since Sept. 13 (12 G); counting his 7 walks during that stretch, he's reached base safely in 26 of his last 51 plate appearances (.510 OBP, .841 SLG, 1.351 OPS)...HR BOTH SIDES OF PLATE...Tuesday, Justin became just the fourth player in Mariners history to homer from both sides of the plate, joining Larry Milbourne (7/15/78); Donnie Scott (4/29/85) and David Segui (4/1/98).

HOMER HAPPY...Mariners have homered in 16 straight games (see chart in box at left), collecting 21 total HR during streak...it's the longest streak this season (prev: 11, Aug. 17-28) for Seattle...the last season the Mariners had 2 streaks of 11+ consecutive games w/a HR was 1997 (14, 8/19-9/1 and 13 8/5-8/17).

MISPING IN ACTION...the Mariners were 3-for-8 (w/6 RBI) with Men In Scoring Position yest., after posting a 4-for-57 (.070) mark over their previous 7 games...that stretch included an 0-for-17 Sept. 18 (see page 9).

20 VISION...Justin Smoak hammered his career-high 19th homer Wednesday, his third in two games, and needs just one more for his first 20 homer season...Seattle has not had a 20-homer guy since 2009, when Russell Branyan (31) and Jose Lopez (25) each turned the trick...2010 and 2011 were the first seasons since 1983 (when Pat Putnam led w/19) that Seattle has failed to have at least one player reach 20 homers.

SWING AND A MISS...Seattle matched an MLB record (and their own club-record) with 20 strikeouts Tuesday at LAA (Seattle also struck out 20 times vs. Roger Clemens in 1986)...it marked the sixth time in club history (including extra inning games) that Seattle has struck out 18 or more times; the club did it twice in 1986 and have done it twice this season, and have also now done it twice here.

STINGY LEFTY...Lucas Luetge, the Mariners 2012 Rule 5 pick, has stranded 42 of the 50 runners he's inherited this season...that's the 7th-best mark in franchise history (see chart on left/min: 30 inherited).

CLOSING IT OUT...Tom Wilhelmsen has not allowed a run in his last 12.1 innings in relief...since Sept. 3, he has limited opponents to a .116 average (5x43) with 3 walks and 11 strikeouts, while recording 7 saves in 10 relief appearances...Wilhelmsen is 1 save away from becoming the 13th pitcher in franchise history with 30 saves in a single season, while his 76.2 innings pitched are the most by a Mariners reliever in a season since Brandon League tossed 79.0 innings in 2010.

**DOUBLE-DIGIT DINGERS**...Seattle has 7 players with at least 10 HR this season...Justin Smoak (19), Kyle Seager (18), Michael Saunders (17), Jesus Montero (15), Dustin Ackley (12), Miguel Olivo (12) and John Jaso (10)...marks the first time since 2000 the Mariners have had 7 players with doubledigits in home runs (Rodriguez/Martinez/Buhner/Cameron/Olerud/Bell/Oliver)... Casper Wells has 8, and if he reaches 10 HR, will be first time since 1997 (9 players) that 8 or more players hit 10+ HR...2012 is also the first time with 4 players with 15+ home runs since 2009 (Branyan/Griffey Jr./Gutierrez/Lopez).

AS YOU KNOW...Seattle has played 53 one-run games this season, posting a 25-28 mark, but DID YOU KNOW?...that since the start of the 2008 season, Seattle has played 259 one-run games, the (tied) most in the Majors?...Seattle and Minnesota are tied with 259 games, tops among all MLB teams, and ahead of TOR (250), KC (244) & TB (239) among AL teams...OAK is 26th in MLB at 217.

- Acquired w/ 1B Justin Smoak, RH Josh Lueke & INF Matt Lawson for Cliff Lee & Mark Lowe July 9, 2010.
- Made ML debut with Seattle earning the win July 3, 2011 vs. San Diego (7.0,3,1,1,2,4).
- Drafted by TEX in 1st round, 17th overall, in June '07.
- Made professional debut in 2008 with A Clinton in Midwest League: 10-6, 2.37, in 23 GS.
- 2010 Texas League Pitcher of the Year...Texas League Post-Season All-Star...AA Frisco: 10-5, 2.78 ERA (34 ER,110.0 IP) in 17 GS.

Texas on Sept. 22...allowed 8 hits, while walking 1 and striking out 2 over 7.0 scoreless innings...1 of only 8 starters this season to hold the Rangers scoreless over at least 7.0 innings.

**UNCHARACTERISTIC...** walked 2 batters Aug. 30, and 3 (tying his career high for a single game) Aug. 25...in 39 career starts, has walked 2 or more batters only 12 times.

BACK ON TRACK...is 7-4, 3.61 ERA (31 ER, 77.1 IP) with 35 strikeouts (10 BB) in 12 starts since being recalled from AAA...career-high 4-G winning streak 7/17-8/1 (prev: 2, 3 times)...in 3 starts prior to being sent to AAA was 1-2, 11.77 ERA (17 ER, 13.0 IP) with 4 strikeouts...in his first 9 GS of the season was 2-4, 4.38 ERA (24 ER, 39.1 IP) with 26 strikeouts.

**DOWN ON THE FARM**...optioned to AAA Tacoma on June 13...went 4-0 with a 2.61 ERA (11 ER, 38.0 IP) in 6 starts with the Rainiers... tossed at least 6.0 IP 5 times, while recording 4 quality starts.

PRECISION CONTROL...has issued just 36 walks in 236.2 innings in his 39 career starts...has not walked a batter in 16 of 39 starts, and 1 or fewer in 27 of 39 GS...among all qualifying pitchers (min 200.0 IP) since the beginning of 2011 season, ranks 1st in ML in fewest-walks-per-9.0 innings at 1.37 (Cliff Lee, 1.46, Carl Pavano - 1.52, Josh Tomlin, 1.54).

**THANKS FOR NOTHING...** Beavan and Kyle Lohse (StL) share the Major-League lead with 10 starts each this season in which they have not allowed a walk.

MAKE 'EM EARN IT...has yet to allow an unearned run this season, in 24 GS (139.2 IP)...in fact, has not allowed an unearned run in his career: 39 GS, 236.2 IP, 118 R, 118 ER.

THE FLIP SIDE OF HISTORY...on April 21, Beavan became the 21st losing pitcher in a perfect game in Major League history (now 23)... White Sox starter (and fellow Texan) Philip Humber retired all 27 Mariners he faced in the 4-0 win at Safeco Field...ironically, Beavan (Irving High School) and Humber (Carthage High School) had the same high school baseball coach, Jay Malone.

WELCOME TO THE CLUB...Kyle Seager (82 RBI) is just the 4th player in Mariners history to record 80 or more RBI in either of the first two seasons of a Major League career...he joins Alvin Davis (116 in 1984 - rookie), Jim Presley (84 in 1985 - 2nd year) and Ken Griffey Jr. (80 in 1990 - 2nd year)...since 2008, Seager is one of just 5 AL players with an 80+ RBI season in the first two years of a career, joining Mark Trumbo (2011), Evan Longoria (2008-09) and Josh Hamilton (2008).

<u>AFFILIATES UPDATE</u>...the Mariners 9 minor league affiliates put together the best season in club history, combining for a 496-406 (.550) record...all but three of the Mariners affiliates qualified for the postseason in 2012...the organization led all Major League farm systems in wins (496) and winning percentage (.550).

LET'S ALL START "FELIXING"...Felix Hernandez was named the American League Pitcher of the Month for August...Hernandez compiled a perfect 4-0 record with a 1.08 ERA (5 ER, 41.2 IP) and 3 shutouts in 5 starts...all three shutouts were by 1-0 score, becoming the third pitcher in Major League history with three 1-0 shutouts in a calendar month...threw the 23rd Perfect Game in MLB history Aug. 15 vs. Tampa Bay in a 1-0 victory...the monthly award was the 3rd of Felix's career (also: June & Sept, 2009)...combined with Jason Vargas to become only the second set of Mariners teammates to receive back-to-back Pitcher of the Month Awards (also: Felix and Jarrod Washburn in June and July, 2009)

<u>0-for-17 MISP...</u>Seattle was 0-for-17 with runners in scoring position Sept. 18; that marked the most hitless at-bats with runners in scoring position in a single game since Boston went 0-for-19 in a 12-inning, 3-2 win over the Yankees on April 24, 2004 (according

to Baseball-Reference.com).

ROAD WARRIOR...Kyle Seager has recorded 58 of his team-leading 82 RBI this season on the road...ranks T1st in the AL and T4th in the Majors in road RBI...Seager is batting .295 (88x298) with 14 of his 18 HR in 73 games on the road...ranks 6th in the AL with 36 extra base hits on the road (16 at home).

STILL GOLDEN...Franklin Gutierrez made an error Sept. 11 at Toronto, his first since Aug. 20, 2009...Guti went 301 consecutive games in the outfield (293 starts) without an error, with an American League record 846 consecutive chances between fielding miscues...the previous AL record was 723 consecutive errorless chances by Darin Erstad, and fell short of the MLB record of 938 by Darren Lewis.

**THE SECRET TO SUCCESS**...the Mariners are 53-19 (.736) when scoring 4+ runs, compared to 20-64 (.238) when scoring 3 or less... scored 3 or fewer in 17 of last 24 G, going 9-15 during stretch.

JUMPING AHEAD...the Mariners have scored first in 87 of their 156 games this season, ranking 2nd in the Majors behind the Angels (94 of 156)...the Mariners are 57-30 (.655) when scoring first, and 28-20 (.583) when scoring in the first inning.

HITTING CATCHERS...John Jaso (37 GS) and Jesus Montero (53 GS) have combined to start 90 of the Mariners 156 games...each is batting over .295 when playing catcher, with Montero ranking 2nd among AL catchers (.311/64x206) and Jaso 3rd (.295/36x122) -- min. 35 G as catcher...Montero (10 HR), Miguel Olivo (11 HR) and Jaso (5 HR) have combined for a club-record 26 home runs by catchers (old record was 22 in 2000)...overall, Mariners backstops rank 2nd in AL batting .276 (162x588), trailing the Twins (.307).

FIVE SPOT...Felix Hernandez recorded his 5th shutout of the Aug. 27 at Minnesota...the 5 shutouts are a Mariners single-season record, and tied for the most in a season by American League pitcher dating back to the 1989 season...only Roger Clemens (1992), David Wells (1998) & Bert Blyleven (1989) have had 5 ShO in a season since then.

MONTERO MASH NOTES...Jesus Montero hit his 15th home run Sept. 2 off Jered Weaver; he is 4th on the team in HR (Smoak, 19; Seager-18; Saunders, 17)...currently 6th-most in rookie club history...if he leads the team in HR, will become first Mariners rookie as team leader in longballs since Alvin Davis in 1984.

**DOWN ON THE FARM...** of all minor leaguers with at least 250 PA in 2012, the Mariners had 5 players in the top 25: 2. Jesus Ugueto-VSL Mariners (.388/107x276), 10. Jack Marder-High Desert (.360/100x278), 16. Dario Pizzano-Pulaski/Everett (.354/74x209), 18. Stefen Romero-High Desert/Jackson (.352/167x474), 21. Gabriel Guerrero-DSL Mariners/Peoria (.349/96x275).
