OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost their first two games...it is just the third time in the last nine seasons the A's have started the season 0-2 (also 2007, 2011).
- A's hitters are 6 for 60 (.100) with one run, four walks and 17 strikeouts in their first two games.

W — Iwakuma (1-0) L — Parker (0-1)

- Jarrod Parker was charged with the loss...the loss snapped his career-high four-game winning streak dating back to last season...is 1-2 with a 5.94 ERA (11 er in 16.2 ip) in three career starts against Seattle.
- Ryan Cook allowed a career-high three walks (previous: 2, 7 times; last: Sept. 5, 2012 vs. Los Angeles-AL)...allowed one run in 0.2 innings...had not allowed a run in eight career appearances and 9.0 innings in the month of April.
- Yoenis Cespedes (1 for 4, r, hr, rbi, 3 so) hit a solo home run in the second inning...now has seven home runs and 15 RBI in 21 career games against Seattle, his best figures against any team.

SEATTLE NOTES

- The Seattle Mariners have won their first two games, the eighth time they have opened the season 2-0 (also 1979, 1983, 1985, 1995, 1996, 2007, 2011).
- **Hisashi lwakuma** earned the win in his season debut...did not allow a walk, his fourth career start in which he has not allowed a walk (last: Sept. 27, 2012 at Los Angeles-AL)...is 9-4 with a 2.58 ERA (29 er in 101.0 ip) in 17 career starts compared to 1-1 with a 4.75 ERA (16 er in 30.1 ip) in 14 relief appearances.
- Michael Morse (2 for 4, 2 r, 2 hr, 4 rbi, hbp, gidp) hit a career-high tying two home runs (sixth time, last: Sept. 27, 2012 at Philadelphia).
- Michael Saunders (1 for 4, r, bb, 2 sb) had two stolen bases, his second career game with multiple steals (also June 23, 2012 at San Diego).
- Kyle Seager (3 for 3, 2 r, 2 2b, 2 bb) reached base a career-high tying five times...had three hits, his 14th career game of three or more hits...it was his fifth career game of two or more doubles.
