OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics snapped their two-game losing streak...hit back-to-back home runs in the seventh inning (Lowrie and Young)...it is the first time the A's have hit back-to-back home runs since Sept. 22, 2012 at New York-AL (Gomes and Cespedes)...had five doubles, their most in a game since also hitting five doubles in a 20-2 win vs. Boston August 31, 2012.
- Tommy Milone** is 3-1 with a 2.63 ERA (11 er in 37.2 ip) in six career starts against Seattle...including 1-0 with a 2.41 ERA (5 er in 18.2 ip) in three starts in Oakland...allowed two home runs, both in the first inning...last year, allowed two home runs in a game in Oakland only once in 15 starts (Sept. 3, 2012 vs. Los Angeles-AL)...
- Nate Freiman** (2 for 3, rbi) made his Major League debut with a start at first base...recorded his first ML hit in the second inning, a RBI single.
- Jed Lowrie** (3 for 3, r, 2 2b, hr, 3 rbi, bb) hit a go-ahead, two-run double in the fourth inning...has started each of the first three games at shortstop and reached base via hit or walk in all three contests...is a .311 (59 for 190) career hitter in the month of April, his best average for any month of the season.
- Scott Sizemore** (1 for 4, 2b, 2 so) started at second base...it was his first appearance in a Major League game since September 28, 2011 at Seattle, a start at third base...has hit safely in each of his last six games dating back to 2011, which is the longest hitting streak of his career...has a nine-game hitting streak against Seattle (11 for 29, .379) and is a .302 (16 for 53) career hitter against the Mariners.

SEATTLE NOTES

- The Seattle Mariners had their two-game winning streak snapped...it was the eighth 2-0 start in Mariners history (also 1979, 1983, 1985, 1995, 1996, 2007, 2011).
- Joe Saunders** was charged with the loss...allowed four runs in 4.0 innings, his shortest start since Aug. 20, 2012 vs. Miami (3.2 ip)...Mariners starting pitchers allowed one run in 13.2 innings (0.66 ERA) in their first two games.
- Franklin Gutierrez** (1 for 4, r, hr, rbi) hit a leadoff home run, the second of his career (also: August 6, 2008 at Tampa Bay).
- Michael Morse** (1 for 4, r, hr, rbi, 2 so) hit a home run in the first inning...now has three home runs and five RBI in his past two games.
