TONIGHT'S TILT... the Mariners (2-0) continue their season-opening series of the 2013 season tonight with the third (2-0) of a four-game series vs. the Oakland Athletics at O.co Coliseum... Mariners will also travel to Chicago (3 G) to complete this seven-game road trip to open the season... open up Safeco Field next Monday, April 8 vs. Houston, as part of a 10-game homestand vs. the Astros (3 G), Rangers (4 G) and Tigers (3 G)...tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT Sports** in high definition & broadcast live on 710 ESPN Seattle & Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS.

- Seager on Base Kyle Seager reached base in all 5 of his plate appearances (3 H, 2 BB) last night.
- Runs Saved Brendan Ryan has 90 defensive runs saved since 2009 (507 G), leading all shortstops.
- Grinders The Mariners will open the season with 14 consecutive games before their first off day.
 Opening Day Seattle has won 7 straight Opening Day games, tied for longest active streak with ARI.
- Michael Saunders (Canada) was named to the METLIFE All-WBC Team (.727 AVG, HR, 7 RBI).
- Spring Wins Mariners set a spring club record with 22 wins, trailing only KC (25) for most in MLB.

HE'S PRETTY GOOD...Felix Hernandez recorded his 99th career victory Monday night with his 4th career Opening Day win (in 6 OD starts)...is the only pitcher in club history to record an Opening Day start of at least 7.0 shutout innings, and he has done it twice (also: 4/2/07 vs. OAK, 8.0 ShO IP).

3-0?...the Mariners have opened the season with consecutive wins for the 8th time in club history (last in 2011)...with a win tonight would record just the third 3-0 start in club history, joining 1985 and 1995...for those curious, the best start in club history is a 6-0 start in 1985.

HOMER HERE, HOMER THERE...Michael Morse recorded his sixth career multi-homer game last night...he hit a 3-run home run in the 3rd inning (while playing right field) and a solo home run in the 9th inning (while playing left field)...it marked the first time a Mariners player hit two home runs in a game while playing two different *outfield* positions, and just the second time a Mariners player has ever homered twice in a game at *different positions*...David Bell hit a pair of home runs Aug. 23, 2001 vs. Detroit with one each while playing first base and third base.

THE KING & KUMA...the Mariners first two starting pitchers have set a pretty good example, with **Felix Hernandez** and **Hisashi lwakuma** combining to go 2-0, 0.66 ERA (1 ER, 13.2 IP) while allowing only 1 walk and striking out 15.

PATIENCE AT THE PLATE...through the first two games the Mariners have drawn a Major League-leading 12 walks (MIL is 2nd w/9), including 8 in last night's 7-1 win...by comparison, the Mariners drew only one walk in the first two games of the season last year, and the single-game high was 8 walks...Justin Smoak and Brendan Ryan are tied for the AL lead with 3 walks apiece.

MORSE HR KING...Michael Morse finished spring training leading the Majors with 9 home runs, including homers in three of his last four games (7 HR in last 13 G)...Morse set the Mariners single-spring record with his 9 HR, passing Mike Wilson's 8 home runs in 2009...Morse also hit 9 home runs during spring play with the Washington Nationals in 2011, and went on to have a career season batting .303 with 31 HR, 95 RBI and a .910 OPS.

OPENING DAY SHUTOUTS...Felix Hernandez (7.2 IP), Charlie Furbush (1 BF), Stephen Pryor (0.1 IP) and Tom Wilhelmsen (1.0 IP) combined for the third Opening Day shutout in club history (also: 3-0 in '95 vs. DET, 4-0 in '07 vs. OAK) with Monday's 2-0 win over the A's...it was also the 300th shutout victory in club history...Felix has been the winning pitcher in 25 of the 300 shutouts, 2nd-most in club history behind Randy Johnson (26) after passing Jamie Moyer (24).

OPENING DAY FELIX...Felix Hernandez made his sixth career Opening Day start Monday night vs. the A's, tying Randy Johnson for most in club history...has started each of the Mariners last five Opening Days (since 2009)...tossed 7.2 scoreless innings Monday (3 H, 8 K) vs. the A's, and is now 4-0 with a 1.33 ERA (7 ER, 47.1 IP) all-time on Opening Day...here is a look at Felix's 6 OD starts:

SPRING HOMERS...the MLB-leading 58 HR hit by the Mariners were 2nd-most by any team in spring play over the last 20 years (since '94)...according to the *Elias Sports Bureau* only the Cubs (62 in '99) hit more spring homers dating back to 1994...the 9 home runs by **Michael Morse** not only led the Majors, but were the most by a Cactus League player since 2003 when Barry Bonds hit 10.

YOU PROBABLY KNOW...that the Mariners have opened the season allowing 3 hits in each of the first two games, and limited the A's to only one run in the two games combined (2-0 win, 7-1 win)...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...the Mariners are the first team to open the season with back-to-back games allowing 3 or fewer hits in each game since the Cincinnati Reds in 1970 (4/6 vs. MON - 3 H, 4/7 at LAD - 2 H)?...according to *Baseball-Reference.com* only the 4th time since 1940.

<u>ABOUT SAUNDERS</u>...31-year-old lefty is making his 1st start of the season & his 190th career appearance (all starts) tonight.

- Signed as a free agent Feb. 12, 2013.
- Selected by LAA as the 12th overall pick of 2002 draft.
- Made ML debut (7.1 IP, 2 ER) in ND 8/16/05 vs. TOR (w/ LAA) ...picked up first MLB win 7/18/06 vs. CLE (7.0 IP, 1 ER).
- Named to AL All-Star Team in 2008.
- Played in college at Virginia Tech, going 27-7 w/Hokies.
- Received special permission from Commissioner Selig to wear a Virginia Tech hat on April 20, 2007 vs. Seattle to honor the victims of the Virginia Tech tragedy.

APRIL FLOWERS...is 13-9, 3.25 in his career in the month of April (177.1 IP, 64 ER)...3.25 is his best ERA in any month...was 2-0, 0.90 (30.0 IP, 3 ER) in four starts in April 2012.

SPRING TRAINING... was 1-1, 11.57 in 4 games, 3 starts, during spring training (11.2 IP, 15 ER)...also pitched in two minor league intrasquad games, and a 'B' game...ERA was inflated by his final A game start,

March 24 at Arizona when he was charged with 8 runs in 5.0 innings of work, including a five-run third for the DBacks.

2012 RECAP...combined to go 9-13 with a 4.07 ERA in 28 starts with Arizona (21 GS) and Baltimore (7 GS) last season...made 2 post-season starts for the Orioles, going 1-0 with a 1.59 ERA (2 ER, 11.1 IP)...was the starting and winning pitcher in the Orioles one-game wild card playoff win at Texas (5.2 IP, 6 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 4 SO).

LEFT OUT... limited left-handed batters to a .199 batting average (33x166) with zero HR allowed and only 5 extra base hits (all doubles) in 2012...over last two seasons held LHB to a .205 avg (69x336).

CAREER...in 8 Major League seasons with the Angels (2005-2010), Diamondbacks (2010-2012) and Orioles (2012) is 78-65 with a 4.15 ERA in 189 career starts.

DOMINATING SAFECO FIELD...Saunders is 6-0 with a 2.13 ERA (13 ER, 55.0 IP) in 9 career starts at Safeco Field...over his last 8 Safeco Field starts (since 2008), is 6-0, 1.19 ERA (7 ER, 53.0 IP)...amongst MLB pitchers with at least 5 starts at Safeco, ranks 8th in ERA and is one of only three pitchers with a perfect winning percentage -- Joe Blanton (5-0, 6 GS) & Daisuke Matsuzaka (2-0, 6 GS).

<u>DURABLE LEFTY</u>...has been one of the more dependable left-handed starting pitchers in all of baseball over the last 5 seasons...over the last five season (2008-2012) he ranks 6th the Majors in amongst **left-handed pitchers** in games started (156), 6th in wins (63) and 7th in innings pitched (974.0)...over the last 5 seasons has averaged 13 wins, 31 starts and 195.0 innings per season (63-57, 156 GS, 974.0 IP).
