**TODAY'S TILT**... the Mariners (2-1) conclude their season-opening series of the 2013 season today with the final game (2-1) of a four-game series vs. the Oakland Athletics at O.co Coliseum... Mariners travel to Chicago following today's game to complete this seven-game road trip to open the season...open up Safeco Field on Monday, April 8 vs. Houston, as part of a 10-game homestand vs. the Astros (3 G), Rangers (4 G) and Tigers (3 G)...today's game will be televised on **ROOT Sports** in high definition & broadcast live on 710 ESPN Seattle & Mariners Radio Network.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...Mariners are 2-1, tied for the AL West lead with Texas.

- **Runs Saved - Brendan Ryan** has 91 defensive runs saved since 2009 (508 G), leading all shortstops.
- **Grinders** - The Mariners will open the season with 14 consecutive games before their first off day.
- **Michael Saunders** (Canada) was named to the METLIFE All-WBC Team (.727 AVG, HR, 7 RBI).
- **Spring Wins** - Mariners set a spring club record with 22 wins, trailing only KC (25) for most in MLB.

**ON A JET PLANE**...the Mariners fly to Chicago following today's game to start a three-game road trip tomorrow in the Windy City...the Mariners will fly roughly 55,000 miles this season.

**ERROR FREE**...the Mariners have not made an error in the first three games, handling 104 total chances flawlessly...first time since 2009 (4 straight) to open the season with at least 3 consecutive error-free games.

**MiLB OPENING DAY**...today is Opening Day for four Mariners minor league affiliates...the AAA Tacoma Rainiers open the season at Fresno, AA Jackson opens on the road with a 5-game series at Jacksonville, High-A High Desert opens at Lancaster and Low-A Clinton is also on the road with a 4-game series at Burlington...complete MiLB Opening Day rosters are available for download at MarinersMedia.com.

**HOMERS IN BUNCHES**...**Michael Morse**, who led the spring training with 9 home runs, has three home runs in the first three games of the season to lead the Majors...hit a pair of home runs Tuesday and hit a solo homer last night...marks the 11th time in Morse's career to hit homers in consecutive games (last: Aug. 9-10, 2012), which includes a trio of streaks of 3 or more games with a HR (last: Sept. 25-27, 2011)...had a career-high 4-game HR streak May 23-27, 2011 with the Nationals.

**GUTI LEADOFF HR**...**Franklin Gutierrez** hit his second career leadoff home run last night, in just his 18th career start batting in the first spot in the order...his previous leadoff HR was Aug. 6, 2008 at Tampa Bay (off Scott Kazmir) with Cleveland...Guti is the 21st Mariners player to record a leadoff HR in club history, with yesterday's being the 69th leadoff HR in club history (37 by Ichiro).

**YOUNG STARTER**...**Brandon Maurer** is making his Major League debut today at 22 years, 275 days...will be the 17th Mariners starting pitcher to make his MLB debut under the age of 23, and first since **Michael Pineda** (22.077) and **Blake Beavan** (22.167) in 2011.

**THE KING & KUMA**...the Mariners first two starting pitchers, **Felix Hernandez** and **Hisashi Iwakuma**, combined to go 2-0, 0.66 ERA (1 ER, 13.2 IP) while allowing 1 walk and striking out 15.

**HOMER HERE, HOMER THERE**...**Michael Morse** recorded his sixth career multi-homer game Tuesday night...he hit a 3-run home run in the 3rd inning (while playing right field) and a solo home run in the 9th inning (while playing left field)...it marked the first time a Mariners player hit two home runs in a game while playing two different *outfield* positions, and just the second time a Mariners player has ever homered twice in a game at *different positions*...David Bell hit a pair of home runs Aug. 23, 2001 vs. Detroit with one each while playing first base and third base.

**GOOD START**...the Mariners opened the season allowing 3 hits in each of the first two games (Monday & Tuesday), and limited the A's to only one run (2-0 win, 7-1 win)...the Mariners became the first team to open the season with back-to-back games allowing 3 or fewer hits in each game since the Cincinnati Reds in 1970 (4/6 vs. MON - 3 H, 4/7 at LAD - 2 H).

**OPENING DAY SHUTOUTS**...**Felix Hernandez** (7.2 IP), **Charlie Furbush** (1 BF), **Stephen Pryor** (0.1 IP) and **Tom Wilhelmson** (1.0 IP) combined for the third Opening Day shutout in club history (also: 3-0 in '95 vs. DET, 4-0 in '07 vs. OAK) with Monday's 2-0 win over the A's...it was also the 300th shutout victory in club history...Felix has been the winning pitcher in 25 of the 300 shutouts, 2nd-most in club history behind Randy Johnson (26) after passing Jamie Moyer (24).

**HE'S PRETTY GOOD**...**Felix Hernandez** recorded his 99th career victory Monday night with his 4th career Opening Day win (in 6 OD starts)...is the only pitcher in club history to record an Opening Day start of at least 7.0 shutout innings, and he has done it twice (also: 4/2/07 vs. OAK, 8.0 ShO IP).

**SPRING HOMERS**...the MLB-leading 58 HR hit by the Mariners were 2nd-most by any team in spring play over the last 20 years (since '94)...according to the *Elias Sports Bureau* only the Cubs (62 in '99) hit more spring homers dating back to 1994...the 9 home runs by **Michael Morse** not only led the Majors, but were the most by a Cactus League player since 2003 when Barry Bonds hit 10.

**YOU ALREADY KNOW**...that **Brandon Maurer** is making his Major League debut today...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...that he is the first Mariners pitcher since 1993 to make the Opening Day rotation without pitching at Triple-A?...Maurer, who was the Double-A Southern League Pitcher of the Year with Jackson in 2012, is the first to make the jump from AA (or A) to the Opening Day rotation since Mike Hampton and John Cummings.

**ABOUT MAURER...**

- Pronounced: Brandon Maurer (MOW-er)
- Making his first career MLB start today vs. the A's.
- Made Mariners 2013 Opening Day roster for first time in career.
- Has spent entire career in the Mariners organization after being selected by Seattle in the 23rd round of the 2008 June draft out of Orange Lutheran (CA) High School...was high school teammates with RHP Gerrit Cole (Pittsburgh).
- Named 2012 Most Improved Player by the Seattle Mariners after going 9-2 with a 3.20 ERA in 24 starts with AA Jackson.
- Owns a career minor league record of 16-17 with a 3.65 ERA (131 ER, 323.0 IP) in 67 games/58 starts in 5 seasons.
- Made his professional debut in 2008 with the Mariners in the Arizona League: 1-2, 3.09 ERA in 8G/5GS...named AZL Mariners Pitcher of the Year by the Mariners.

**LAST TIME OUT...** recorded a ND is final start of Spring Training in 4-3 win over Colorado on March 30 at Salt Lake City...allowed 2 runs (both home runs) on 4 hits, while walking 1 and striking out 3 in 4.0 innings of work.

**SPRING TRAINING RECAP...** Maurer was named the Peoria Diamond Club Rookie of the Year, going 3-1 with a 1.50 ERA (4 ER, 24.0 IP) in 7 appearances (4 starts) during Spring Training...amongst qualifying Cactus League leaders, Maurer ranked first in ERA (1.50), T3rd in wins (3), T9th in innings pitched (24.0) and T5th in strikeouts (25).

**FIRST OPENING DAY ROSTER...** Maurer is the Mariners third rookie pitcher to crack the Opening Day starting rotation since 1999 (also: Michael Pineda in 2011 and Freddy Garcia in 1999).

**WHAT A JUMP...** Maurer is the Mariners first starting pitcher to jump from Double-A to a starting spot in the Major League rotation since starters Mike Hampton and John Cummings both did it out of Class A back in 1993.

**MAKING HIS MLB STARTING DEBUT...** Maurer is also only the fifth Mariners pitchers to make his Major League debut in a start since 2005, joining Anthony Vasquez (8/23/11), Blake Beavan (7/3/11), Michael Pineda (4/5/11) and Felix Hernandez (8/4/05).

**MINOR LEAGUE CAREER...** is 16-17 with a 3.65 ERA (131 ER, 323.0 IP) in 67 games/58 career starts over 5 seasons in the minor leagues...set career-highs in nearly every pitching category in 2012 with Jackson, including starts, innings pitched and strikeouts... began professional career with the AZL Mariners in 2008 and named team's Most Valuable Pitcher by the Seattle Mariners...limited to only 22 games, 17 starts, over the 2010-11 seasons due to injuries (4/1-8/13/10 with right elbow tendinitis and 6/11-29/11 & 7/18-9/1/11 with strained right elbow).

**2012 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS...**

- Named Southern League Most Outstanding Pitcher after going 9-2 with a 3.20 ERA (49 ER, 137.2 IP) in 24 starts with AA Jackson.
- Named Most Improved Player by the Seattle Mariners.
- Led the Southern League with an .818 winning percentage and ranked 5th in ERA.
- Tied for the Generals lead in wins (9), while leading the team in strikeouts (117) and innings pitched (137.1).
- Over final 14 starts of the season, June 1-Aug. 16) went 7-1 with a 2.50 ERA (24 ER, 86.1 IP) and recorded 10 quality starts.
- After only recording 7 wins in his first four seasons in the Mariners organization, Maurer set a career-high with 9 wins in 2012.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP BLAKE BEAVAN (11-11, 4.43 ERA in 2012 with Seattle)**

24-year-old right-hander is scheduled make his first start of the season tomorrow vs. the Chicago White Sox...**SPRING TRAINING REVIEW:** went 1-1 with a 6.52 ERA (14 ER, 19.1 IP) in 5 official Spring Training appearances (3 GS)...recorded the loss in final ST start on 3/23 vs. CLE (5.1,16,9,8,0,3,2HR)...**2012 RECAP:** went 11-11 with a 4.43 ERA (75 ER, 152.1 IP) in 26 starts with Seattle in 2012...posted career-highs in nearly every pitching category, including wins (11), starts (26), innings pitched (152.1) and strikeouts (67)...issued only 24 walks in 152.1 innings, 2nd-fewest in the Majors by any pitcher with at least 150.0 innings (Colon, 23)...became just the 9th pitcher in club history, and first since Felix Hernandez (12 in 2006) to post double-digits in wins in either the first or second season of a ML career...went 4-0 with a 2.61 ERA (11 ER, 38.0 IP) in 6 starts with AAA Tacoma...**CAREER:** Is 16-17 with a 4.37 ERA in 41 career starts...**vs. CWS:** Is 0-2 with a 5.73 ERA (7 ER, 11.0 IP) in 2 starts vs. the White Sox (both in 2012), including recording the loss at U.S. Cellular Field on Aug. 25 (5.0,7,4,4,3,2,2HR,2HB).
