OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost the past two games to snap their nine-game winning streak...are now 9-4, which is tied for the fifth best mark in Athletics history after 13 games.
- The A's allowed 10 runs on 14 hits...the runs allowed are a season-high (previous: 7, twice) and the hits match a season-high (also: April 10 at Los Angeles).
- Jarrod Parker** allowed eight runs on nine hits in 3.1 innings...the runs are a career-high (previous: 6, four times; last: July 27, 2012 at Baltimore) and the hits matched his career-high (fourth time, last: April 13, 2013 at Los Angeles)...is 0-2 with a 10.80 ERA (14 er in 11.2 ip) in his first three starts.
- Josh Donaldson** (0 for 2, bb) had his streak of five straight multiple hit games snapped, the first time he had put together more than two straight multiple hit games in his career...is the only Athletic to start all 13 games this year...each of his starts have come at third base.
- Brandon Moss** (0 for 2, bb, so) is 0 for his last 16, which is one short of the longest hitless streak of his career (17, September 10-29, 2010).
- Derek Norris** (1 for 2, 2b, rbi, so, sf) has made six starts, all at catcher, and has hit safely in each game (9 for 18, .500).

DETROIT NOTES

- The Detroit Tigers have won back-to-back games for the second time this season (also: April 5-6 vs. New York)...are 2-1 on this nine-game, 10-day road trip to Oakland (2-1), Seattle (three games) and Los Angeles (three games).
- Anibal Sanchez** tossed a season-high tying 7.0 innings (also: April 9 vs. Toronto)...is 2-0 with a 1.42 ERA (3 er in 19.0 ip) in his first three starts.
- Prince Fielder** (1 for 3, r, 2b, rbi, ibr, hbp) extended his hitting streak to nine games...is 16 for 30 (.533) with seven runs, four doubles, four home runs and 18 RBI during the streak.
- Torii Hunter** (3 for 5, 2 r, 2 2b, 3b, rbi) recorded his third three-hit game of the season (last: April 9 vs. Toronto), extending his hit streak to nine games (18 for 40, .450).
- Austin Jackson** (4 for 6, 3 r, hr, 3 rbi) had a season-high four hits, his 11th career game of four or more hits (last: 4, Aug. 5, 2012 vs. Cleveland)...it is his seventh multiple hit game of the season...has started each of the first 12 games and has reached base safely in all 12.
