FRESH START IN HOUSTON
The Astros organization has undergone several changes in recent months. Below is a listing of some of those changes:
-**NEW MANAGER:** At 40, Bo Porter enters the 2013 season as the youngest current manager in the Majors.
-**NEW TV PARTNER:** Comcast SportsNet Houston is the Astros new Regional Sports Network.
-**NEW RADIO STATION:** Games are now aired on SportsTalk 790 AM.
-**NEW TV BROADCASTERS:** Bill Brown will be joined by Alan Ashby and Geoff Blum.
-**NEW RADIO BROADCASTERS:** Robert Ford and Steve Sparks are the new radio team. HOF broadcaster Milo Hamilton retired after 2012.
-**NEW UNIFORMS/LOGO:** The Astros used fan feedback in making the decision to bring back the blue and orange colors of the past.
-**NEW LEAGUE:** The Astros are the first team in MLB history to move from the National League to the American League in 2013.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros will open up the final leg of their three-city, nine-game, 10-day road trip tonight with a 9:05 p.m. CT matchup with the Oakland A's...Houston will send **LHP Erik Bedard** (0-0) to the mound opposite fellow southpaw LHP Tommy Milone (2-0) and the Athletics.

ABOUT BEDARD: LHP Erik Bedard enters his start tonight having tossed 7.1 consecutive scoreless innings this season...Bedard has made two appearances in 2013, a 3.0-inning save on 3/31 vs. TEX and a 4.0-inning start on 4/9 at SEA...in addition to his 7.1 shutout innings this regular season, Bedard did not allow an earned run in his 6.0 official innings this Spring Training (three apps.).

ASTROS DROP RUBBER GAME AT LAA: The Astros dropped yesterday's rubber game at Los Angeles by a count of 4-1...RHP Philip Humber (0-3) started for Houston and continued his success this season despite the loss, tossing 7.0 innings, while allowing two runs on seven hits...the Astros managed only one run off of Angels starter C.J. Wilson, which came on an RBI double by **3B Matt Dominguez**.

THE HUMBER GAMES: RHP Philip Humber has extended his Spring Training success into the regular season and has posted a 2.89 ERA (6ER/18.2IP) thru his first three regular season starts...this spring, Humber went 2-2 with a 1.73 ERA (5ER/26IP) and led the club in innings pitched.

GLOVEWORK: **3B Matt Dominguez** has handled more total chances at third base this season (43) than any other Major League player...despite the largest number of chances, he is still one of 11 MLB third baseman without an error in 2013...he handled six total chances yesterday.

HOMER HAPPY: The Astros have combined for 12 homers through the club's first 12 games this season...last year, Houston connected for just 14 home runs in 23 games in April...the Astros were one of the top offensive clubs in baseball during Spring Training, finishing second in the Grapefruit League in home runs with 47.

ON THE ROAD: Tonight marks game seven of 81 road contests that the Astros will play in 2013...it's also seven of 29 games the Astros will play this season in the Pacific time zone...this trip began in Seattle (Mon.-Wed.), went to Los Angeles (Fri.-Sun.) and continues in Oakland this week (4/15-17) before a return to Houston following Wednesday's game...the Astros have gone 3-3 on their current trek.

VS. THE ATHLETICS: This series is the second of five between the two clubs this season, with Oakland sweeping a three-game series in Houston from 4/5-7...the Astros own an all-time record of 1-8 against their new AL West opponent.

CELEBRATING JACKIE: Major League Baseball will celebrate Jackie Robinson Day today throughout baseball to honor the legacy of the legendary Hall of Famer...this is the fifth consecutive year that all players and on-field personnel will wear Number 42...the annual celebration commemorates the 66th anniversary of Robinson breaking Baseball's color barrier in 1947...the last Astro to wear the number 42 on a regular basis was **RHP Jose Lima** from 1997-2001...the Astros will recognize Jackie Robinson Day at Minute Maid Park on April 19.

ASTROS MAKE MINOR LEAGUE TRADE: This morning, the Astros announced that the club had acquired **LHP Eric Berger** from the Cleveland Indians in exchange for **C Chris Wallace**...Berger, who was at Double A Akron, will report to Triple A Oklahoma City...Berger had posted a 4.15 ERA (2ER/41.1IP) in two relief appearances at Akron in 2013.

F-MART ON REHAB ASSIGNMENT: **OF Fernando Martinez** began his rehab assignment yesterday for Triple A Oklahoma City and went 0x3 with an RBI in three plate appearances as the Designated Hitter...he's been on the club's 15-day Disabled List since the season started with a strained left oblique.

FOR STARTERS: As a whole, Astros starting pitchers have performed well this season and have limited the competition to three earned runs or fewer in 11 of the club's 12 games...**RHP Bud Norris** leads the staff in wins (2), ERA (1.96) and strikeouts (14), **RHP Philip Humber** leads the staff in innings pitched (18.2IP), **RHP Brad Peacock** has allowed just a .206 opponent's batting average, **RHP Lucas Harrell** ranks tied for seventh in the AL in groundball/flyball ratio, and **LHP Erik Bedard** has not allowed a run in 7.1 innings pitched this season.

AL LEADERBOARD: In their first 12 games, Astros starters rank fourth in the AL with a 3.39 combined ERA.

WHEN IT COUNTS: Astros **OF Rick Ankiel** is averaging two RBI per hit on the season and currently leads the club with eight RBI in 10 games played...the reason for his efficiency has been his .571 (4x7) batting average with runners in scoring position, which ranks first in the American League (min. 7 ABs).

AFFILIATES START 26-13: The Astros four minor league teams currently in season have combined to post a 26-13 record, which includes a 7-2 mark at Class A Quad Cities and 7-3 records at Double A Corpus Christi and High A Lancaster.

vs. OAK: Is 4-3 with a 2.73 ERA (21ER/69.1IP) in 11 career apps. vs. the A's...2.73 ERA is his lowest vs. any AL club...**is 4-0 in his last 5 starts vs. OAK with an 0.55 ERA (2ER/32.2IP) with 32 K's...**last app. vs. the A's was a start on 8/27/11 at Fenway Park while with BOS (ND in 4-0 win, 4 IP, 0 R).

at O.co Coliseum: 3-0 in 4 starts/apps. with a 1.61 ERA (5ER/28IP) with a .155 opp. avg and 29 K's in 28.0 IP...is his lowest ERA at any AL ballpark.

- has allowed just 2 hits in his 2 apps. (7.1 IP) for an .083 opp. avg....opp. are just 2x23 off him.
- on Opening Night this season, made his 1st relief appearance since 2004 and recorded his 1st career Major League save in the Astros 8-2 win over the Rangers on ESPN Sunday Night Baseball...went 3.1 innings, allowing no runs on 1 hit with 2 strikeouts...retired the first 8 batters he faced and 10 out of 11 total batters.
- was the first 3.0+ inning save recorded by an Astro since Ricky Stone on 7/10/03 vs. CIN...the last Astro with a save after pitching 3.1 innings was Kent Bottenfield on 4/24/01.

AL VETERAN: aside from his stint with the Pirates in 2012, has pitched his entire career in the American League with the Orioles (2004-05), Mariners (2008-11), Red Sox (2011) and now Astros.

- was one of the most effective left-handed starters in the AL from 2006-09, ranking 4th in winning percentage with a 39-23 record (.629), 2nd in ERA (3.40), 3rd in strikeouts (554) and 1st in opponents batting average (.232).
- against AL foes in his career, has gone 49-48 with a 3.98 ERA...owns a career 13-15 record with a 3.79 ERA in 40 starts against the AL West Division.
- ranked 8th in MLB with 10 double-digit strikeout games from 2006-08.

THIS SPRING: entered the spring as a non-roster invitee and won a spot in the rotation as the Astros 5th starter...made 3 appearances (1 start), allowing just 1 unearned run in 6.0 innings with 9 strikeouts.

IN 2012: Made 24 starts for the Pirates in what was his first NL season...posted a 3.12 ERA with 51 strikeouts over his first 10 starts of the year from 4/5-5/27.

- **CANADA!:** in 2007, became just the 6th Canadian-born player to strike out 200-or-more batters in a season...beame the 200th Canadian to play in the Major Leagues when he made his debut on 4/17/02.
- his 15 strikeouts on 7/7/07 are a Major League, single-game record for a Canadian-born pitcher...also matched an Orioles record that was previously accomplished by Mike Mussina.
- pitched in the 2006 World Baseball Classic for Team Canada.
