**FRESH START IN HOUSTON**  
The Astros organization has undergone several changes in recent months. Below is a listing of some of those changes:  
-**NEW MANAGER:** At 40, Bo Porter enters the 2013 season as the youngest current manager in the Majors.  
-**NEW TV PARTNER:** Comcast SportsNet Houston is the Astros new Regional Sports Network.  
-**NEW RADIO STATION:** Games are now aired on SportsTalk 790 AM.  
-**NEW TV BROADCASTERS:** Bill Brown will be joined by Alan Ashby and Geoff Blum.  
-**NEW RADIO BROADCASTERS:** Robert Ford and Steve Sparks are the new radio team. HOF broadcaster Milo Hamilton retired after 2012.  
-**NEW UNIFORMS/LOGO:** The Astros used fan feedback in making the decision to bring back the blue and orange colors of the past.  
-**NEW LEAGUE:** The Astros are the first team in MLB history to move from the National League to the American League in 2013.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Astros will look to even up this three-game series tonight at 9:05 p.m. CT behind rookie starter **RHP Brad Peacock** (1-1)...he will be opposed by RHP A.J. Griffin (2-0) and the Athletics...Peacock and Griffin will be reuniting tonight after spending parts of the 2012 season in the same rotation at Triple A Sacramento in Oakland's organization.

**PEACOCKIN':** **RHP Brad Peacock** is coming off his first win of the season, a 5.0-inning performance at SEA (3ER)...the 25-year-old right-hander has now gone 3-1 with a 2.25 ERA (5ER/20IP) in his four career MLB starts...Peacock was one of the Astros top pitching performers this spring, which earned him a spot in the Astros rotation...he posted a 2.78 ERA (7ER/22.2IP) in eight appearances this spring, including a 0.94 ERA (2ER/19IP) in his final five apps.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Astros got behind early last night and weren't able to recover from a six-run 1st inning by the Athletics and ended up dropping the opener of this three-game series by a score of 11-2...reliever **RHP Paul Clemens**, who was pushed into action with one out in the first inning, shined for Houston, tossing 5.1 scoreless innings, while allowing just one hit and two walks...offensively, the Astros collected eight hits, including a 2x4 performance by **1B Carlos Pena**.

**CLEMENS IN RELIEF:** Astros pitcher **Paul Clemens** has two relief appearances this season, a 4.0-inning win on 4/9 at SEA and last night's 5.1-inning scoreless performance...the last Astros reliever to toss at least 5.1 innings of scoreless relief was **RHP Shane Reynolds** on 7/17/94 at PIT (7IP)...the last Astros reliever to go 5.1 or more innings in a game was **RHP Dave Borkowski** on 8/15/06 vs. CHC (2ER/6IP).

**SELECT COMPANY:** One of **1B Carlos Pena's** hits last night was a bunt single, which was his 26th career bunt hit...Pena is one of three active players with at least 25 bunt hits and at least 250 career home runs...the other two are SS Derek Jeter and OF Carlos Beltran.

**ON THE ROAD:** Tonight marks game eight of 81 road contests that the Astros will play in 2013...it's also eight of 29 games the Astros will play this season in the Pacific time zone...this trip began in Seattle (2-1), went to Los Angeles (1-2) and continues in Oakland this week (0-1) before a return to Houston following Wednesday's game...the Astros have gone 3-4 on their current trek.

**VS. THE ATHLETICS:** This series is the second of five between the two clubs this season, with Oakland sweeping a three-game series in Houston from 4/5-7...the Astros own an all-time record of 1-9 against their new AL West opponent...prior to this series, the last time Houston played in Oakland was in 2002 (0-3).

**FOR STARTERS:** As a whole, Astros starting pitchers have performed well this season and have limited the competition to three earned runs or fewer in 11 of the club's 13 games...**RHP Bud Norris** leads the staff in wins (2), ERA (1.96) and strikeouts (14), **RHP Philip Humber** leads the staff in innings pitched (18.2IP), **RHP Brad Peacock** has allowed just a .206 opponent's batting average and **RHP Lucas Harrell** ranks tied for seventh in the AL in groundball/flyball ratio.

**WHEN IT COUNTS:** Astros **OF Rick Ankiel** is averaging two RBI per hit on the season and currently leads the club with eight RBI in 10 games played...the reason for his efficiency has been his .571 (4x7) batting average with runners in scoring position, which ranks second in the American League (min. 7 ABs) to Oakland's **1B Brandon Moss** (.600, 6x10).

**GLOVEWORK:** **3B Matt Dominguez** has handled more total chances at third base this season (47) than any other Major League player...despite the largest number of chances, he is still one of 10 MLB third baseman without an error in 2013...he handled four total chances yesterday.

**HOMER HAPPY:** The Astros have combined for 12 homers through the club's first 13 games this season...last year, Houston connected for just 14 home runs in 23 games in April...the Astros were one of the top offensive clubs in baseball during Spring Training, finishing second in the Grapefruit League in home runs with 47.

**F-MART ON REHAB ASSIGNMENT:** **OF Fernando Martinez** continued his rehab assignment yesterday for Triple A Oklahoma City and went 0x3 with walk, a run scored and an RBI in four plate appearances as the right fielder...in his two games at OKC, Martinez has gone 0x6 with 2 RBI...the left-handed hitting corner outfielder has been on the club's 15-day Disabled List since the season started with a strained left oblique.

**ASTROS ACQUIRE BERGER:** Yesterday, the Astros announced that the club had acquired **LHP Eric Berger** from the Cleveland Indians in exchange for **C Chris Wallace**...Berger, who was at Double A Akron, will report to Triple A Oklahoma City...Berger had posted a 4.15 ERA (2ER/41.IP) in two relief appearances at Akron in 2013.

**AFFILIATES START 28-14:** The Astros four minor league teams currently in season have combined to post a 28-14 record, which includes a 7-2 mark at Class A Quad Cities and an 8-3 record at High A Lancaster...all four affiliates are over .500 as Double A Corpus Christi entered today 7-4 and Triple A Oklahoma City is 6-5...Corpus Christi has been impressive on the mound, as they own a 2.62 team ERA (28ER/96.1IP) in 11 games.

**LAST APP - 4/10 at SEA:** earned his 1st victory of the season, defeating the Mariners, 8-3...allowed 3 runs in 5.0 innings of work.

**PEACOCKIN':** 25-year-old right-hander made his 1st appearance on an Opening Day roster this season as the Astros No. 4 starter...his previous 3 Major League appearances came as a September call-up for the Nationals in 2011.

**MLB CAREER:** tonight marks Peacock's 6th MLB appearance, his 5th start, and his 3rd since September of 2011...is 3-1 with a 2.53 ERA in those appearances...won both of his 2011 starts, while tossing a combined 10.2 scoreless innings in those apps.

**THIS SPRING:** pitched his way into the starting rotation this spring after posting a 2.78 ERA (7ER/22.2IP) in 8 appearances, including 4 starts...over his final 5 appearances, posted a 0.94 ERA (2ER/19IP).

- did not allow a homer in his 22.2 inning pitched this spring...was 1 of 5 players to throw at least 20 innings during Spring Training without allowing a homer.

**IN 2012:** spent last season in Oakland's organization at their Triple A affiliate in Sacramento, registering a 12-9 mark in 28 games, 25 starts...had career-highs in games and matched his high in games started...his 12 wins were the most in the A's farm system and tied for 4th in the PCL...ranked 3rd in the PCL in strikeouts per 9.0 innings (9.10) and 7th in strikeouts.

**vs. OAK:** set to face his former team for the 2nd time this season...made his Astros debut against Oakland on 4/5 at Minute Maid Park, tossing 4.1 innings and allowing 2 runs on 3 hits with 5 punchouts...was a member of the Athletics organization in 2012 after being acquired by the club as part of the Gio Gonzalez trade with Washington.

**FIRST YEAR ASTRO:** was acquired by Houston from Oakland along with OF Chris Carter and minor league C Max Stassi on Feb. 2 in exchange for IF Jed Lowrie...at the time of his acquisition, was rated as the Athletics' top pitching prospect.

**PROSPECT RANKINGS:** at the time of *Baseball America's* publication of the Prospect Handbook in 2013, was named Oakland's No. 4 prospect entering this season...was also named Oakland's No. 2 prospect entering 2012 and Washington's No. 10 prospect entering the 2011 season.

**41st ROUND:** drafted by Washington as a "draft and follow" after his senior season in the 41st round of the June 2006 draft, but did not sign immediately...elected to attend Palm Beach Community College (currently known as Palm Beach State College), where he went 8-2 with 82 strikeouts in 75 innings with the PBCC Panthers...signed by Washington following that season.

**LAST APP - 4/12 at LAA:** in his 100th career MLB start, hurled 7.0 shutout innings against the Angels to earn his 2nd victory of the season...allowed just 3 hits and struck out 5 on 96 pitches.

**DEALIN':** in his last 5 starts dating back to last season, is 4-1 with a 1.14 ERA (4ER/31.2IP) and a .179 opponents batting average.

**STRIKEOUTS:** has fanned nearly one hitter per inning in his four-year career, striking out 567 in 582.0 innings...over the last four seasons, ranks 8th in the Majors in strikeouts per 9.0 innings (min. 400 IP).

- ranked 10th in the NL with 8.52 strikeouts per 9.0 innings pitched (165SO/168.1IP) in 2012.

**IN 2012:** made 29 starts in what was his third full season in the Majors...led the club in strikeouts (165) and quality starts (17).

- began the year with a 5-1 record thru late May before running into a winless run of 18 consecutive starts...despite the run, pitched well over his last 12 starts, posting a 3.75 ERA (30ER/72IP) with 64 strikeouts.

**vs. OAK:** will make his 2nd start of the season and his career against Oakland tomorrow...went 5.2 innings on 4/6 against the A's at Minute Maid Park, giving up 5 runs (2 earned) on 6 hits in the 6-3 loss.

- has spent his last 2 seasons on the Nationals, where Bo Porter was the club's 3rd base coach...hit .228 (36x158) with five home runs last year in 68 games for the Nats.

- has started every game this season (7 in LF, 6 at DH)...ranks T-4th in the AL with 4 homers on the season...recorded his 1st career multi-homer game on 4/9 at SEA...all 4 of his homers have come while hitting out of the clean-up spot in the lineup (hitting .324 while batting #4).
