FRESH START IN HOUSTON
The Astros organization has undergone several changes in recent months. Below is a listing of some of those changes:
-NEW MANAGER: At 40, Bo Porter enters the 2013 season as the youngest current manager in the Majors.
-NEW TV PARTNER: Comcast SportsNet Houston is the Astros new Regional Sports Network.
-NEW RADIO STATION: Games are now aired on SportsTalk 790 AM.
-NEW TV BROADCASTERS: Bill Brown will be joined by Alan Ashby and Geoff Blum.
-NEW RADIO BROADCASTERS: Robert Ford and Steve Sparks are the new radio team. HOF broadcaster Milo Hamilton retired after 2012.
-NEW UNIFORMS/LOGO: The Astros used fan feedback in making the decision to bring back the blue and orange colors of the past.
-NEW LEAGUE: The Astros are the first team in MLB history to move from the National League to the American League in 2013.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros will look to win the finale of this three-game series today in a 2:35 p.m. CT matchup opposite the Oakland A's... Houston will send Opening Day starter **RHP Bud Norris** (2-1) to the mound, who will be opposed by RHP Bartolo Colon (1-0) and the A's.

ROSEBUD: **RHP Bud Norris** is a San Francisco Bay-Area native, having been born in nearby Greenbrae and raised in Novato...today is his first career appearance at the Coliseum, but his fourth in the Bay Area...he has three career starts at AT&T Park, where he's posted a 4.41 ERA (8ER.16.1IP) with two quality starts.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Astros dropped a tough ballgame last night by a score of 4-3... Houston entered the 8th inning in a 3-2 deficit, which was erased by an opposite field solo home run by **1B Carlos Pena** (1x2, RBI, 2BB)...with two outs and nobody on in the bottom of the 8th, A's RF Josh Reddick walked before scoring on a triple by 3B Josh Donaldson...the triple fell inches away from the right field foul line and inches away from the glove of **RF Rick Ankiel**...Astros starter **RHP Brad Peacock** (3ER/4.1IP) did not factor into the decision, while **LHP Dallas Keuchel** (0ER/3IP) came in to relieve Peacock and kept the game close in his 3.0 innings of work.

PEACOCKIN': **RHP Brad Peacock** cruised thru his first 3.0 innings (1H, 1BB) before running into trouble in the 4th and 5th innings and eventually exiting after 4.1 frames...on the night, Peacock recorded a career high seven strikeouts, which is also a club high this season, while allowing just four hits...he's allowed just a .216 (11x51) opponent's batting average this season and a .194 (18x93) average in his MLB career (25.2IP).

SELECT COMPANY: **1B Carlos Pena** has been on a solid run over his last seven games, posting a .360 (9x25) batting average with four doubles, one homer, five RBI, six walks and a .484 on-base percentage...in this series, he's gone 3x7, which includes a home run and a bunt single...Pena is one of three active players with at least 25 bunt hits and at least 250 career home runs...the other two are SS Derek Jeter and OF Carlos Beltran.

ON THE ROAD: Today marks game nine of 81 road contests that the Astros will play in 2013... this trip began in Seattle (2-1), went to Los Angeles (1-2) and finishes in Oakland (0-2) today before a return to Houston tonight...the Astros have gone 3-5 on their current trek.

VS. THE ATHLETICS: This series is the second of five between the two clubs this season, with Oakland sweeping a three-game series in Houston from 4/5-7...the Astros own an all-time record of 1-10 against their new AL West opponent... prior to this series, the last time Houston played in Oakland was in 2002 (0-3).

FOR STARTERS: As a whole, Astros starting pitchers have performed well this season and have limited the competition to three earned runs or fewer in 12 of the club's 14 games...**RHP Bud Norris** leads the staff in wins (2) and ERA (1.96), **RHP Philip Humber** leads the staff in innings pitched (18.2IP), **RHP Brad Peacock** has allowed just a .216 opponent's batting average and leads the club in strikeouts (15) and **RHP Lucas Harrell** ranks tied for sixth in the AL in groundball/flyball ratio.

GLOVEWORK: **3B Matt Dominguez** has handled more total chances at third base this season (51) than any other Major League player... despite the largest number of chances, he is still one of nine MLB third baseman without an error in 2013...he handled four total chances last night.

HOMER HAPPY: The Astros have combined for 13 homers through the club's first 14 games this season...last year, Houston connected for just 14 home runs in 23 games in April...the Astros were one of the top offensive clubs in baseball during Spring Training, finishing second in the Grapefruit League in home runs with 47.

F-MART ON REHAB ASSIGNMENT: **OF Fernando Martinez** continued his rehab assignment yesterday for Triple A Oklahoma City and went 1x5 with a run scored five plate appearances as the right fielder...in his three games at OKC, Martinez has gone 1x11 with 2 RBI...the left-handed hitting corner outfielder has been on the club's 15-day Disabled List since the season started with a strained left oblique.

AFFILIATES START 29-18: The Astros four minor league teams currently in season have combined to post a 29-18 record, which includes an 8-3 mark at Class A Quad Cities and an 8-4 record at High A Lancaster...all four affiliates are at .500 or better as Double A Corpus Christi entered today 7-5 and Triple A Oklahoma City entered at 6-6...Quad Cities has been impressive on the mound, as they own a 3.03 team ERA (34ER/101IP) in 12 games.

ORGANIZATIONAL LEADERS: Multiple minor league players are off to hot starts, including **IF Jake Elmore** at Oklahoma City, who's hitting .447 (21x47) with a .509 on-base percentage, five doubles, a homer and seven RBI, **RHP Asher Wojciechowski** at Corpus Christi, who's posted a 0.00 ERA (0ER/14IP) with 14 strikeouts in three appearances, **OF Preston Tucker** at Class A Lancaster, who's hitting .354 (17x48) with three doubles, four home runs, 12 RBI and a .407 on-base percentage in eight games, and **RHP Vince Velasquez** at Class A Quad Cities, who's 2-0 with a save and a 1.93 ERA (3ER/14IP) in three games, including two starts.

LAST APP - 4/12 at LAA: in his 100th career MLB start, hurled 7.0 shutout innings against the Angels to earn his 2nd victory of the season...allowed just 3 hits and struck out 5 on 96 pitches...was his 1st career start opposite the Angels.

DEALIN': in his last 5 starts dating back to last season, is 4-1 with a 1.14 ERA (4ER/31.2IP) and a .179 opponents batting average...right-handed hitters are 5x35 (.143) off him this season with no extra-base hits.

TODAY: marks his 4th start of the season and his 1st during the day...will also be his 1st career start at O.co Coliseum.

VS. OAK: making his 2nd career appearance vs. the Athletics...took on the club during his 2nd start of the season on 4/6 at Minute Maid Park, receiving the loss after giving up 5 runs (2 earned) on 6 hits in 5.2 innings...threw 122 pitches that night, his most since tossing a career-high 123 pitches on 8/19/10 vs. NYM.

OPENING DAY: 28-year-old right-handed pitcher made his 1st career Opening Day start this season, defeating Texas on Sunday Night Baseball, 8-2...struck out 5 and gave up just 2 runs on 5 hits in his 5.2 innings of work...had started the Astros 3rd game of the season (2011-12) and the 4th game (2010) in his career.

• became the 4th different pitcher to start for Houston on Opening Day over the last 4 years, joining Roy Oswalt (2003-10), Brett Myers (2011) and Wandy Rodriguez (2012).

THIS SPRING: made 5 official appearances, posting a 2-0 record and a 3.92 ERA (9ER/20.2IP).

AT HOME: has gone 18-15 with a 3.50 ERA in 50 career starts at Minute Maid Park...led the NL and ranked 2nd in the Majors in home ERA (min. 10 starts) in 2012 with a 1.71 ERA (14ER/73.2IP), trailing only Justin Verlander...also ranked 3rd all-time in Astros history for a single season (min. 10 starts) behind Mike Cuellar's 1.57 mark (1968) and Bob Knepper's 1.22 mark (1981).

• currently ranks 1st in MMP history in strikeouts per 9.0 innings among starters, averaging 9.03 (302SO/301.OIP) in 50 starts.

STRIKEOUTS: has fanned nearly one hitter per inning in his career, striking out 567 in 582.0 innings...over the last four seasons (2010-13), ranks 8th in the Majors in strikeouts per 9.0 innings (min. 400 IP).

• ranked 10th in the NL with 8.52 strikeouts per 9.0 innings pitched (165SO/168.1IP) in 2012.

• Tied a Major League record for strikeouts in an inning on 4/24/12 at MIL, recording 4 K's in the 3rd inning...was the 4th Astros hurler to accomplish the feat and the 1st since RHP Brad Lidge did so on 6/13/04 at MIL...the last Astros starter with 4 K's in an inning was RHP Mike Scott on 9/3/86 at CHC.

• Struck out 12 batters without issuing a walk on 6/6/12 vs. STL...became the 1st Astros pitcher to record 12+ strikeouts without issuing a walk since RHP Shane Reynolds (14K), who accomplished the feat on 8/15/99 vs. PIT.

VS. THE AL: has only 6 career starts against American League opponents, with 3 coming against AL West foes...is 2-2 with a 3.93 ERA (15ER/34.1IP) and 39 strikeouts in games against the AL.

IN 2012: made 29 starts in what was his 3rd full season in the Majors...led the club in strikeouts (165) and quality starts (17).

• began the year with a 5-1 record thru late May before running into a winless run of 18 consecutive starts...despite the run, pitched well over his last 12 starts, posting a 3.75 ERA (30ER/72IP) with 64 strikeouts.

WITH HOUSTON: is a home-grown product after originally being selected by HOU in the 6th round of the June 2006 draft.

• was arbitration eligible for the first time in his career this off-season and avoided the process by signing a 1-year deal on 1/18/13.

LAST APP - 4/13 at LAA: got back on track despite receiving the loss in the Astros 5-4 defeat at Angels Stadium...went 5.2 innings, allowing 1 run on 6 hits with 5 strikeouts...had gone 5.2 scoreless frames before giving up a solo homer to Josh Hamilton in the 6th inning...has tossed at least 5.0 innings in 33 of his last 35 starts.

ON THE GROUND: 27-year-old right-hander pitcher ranks T-6th in the AL with a 2.00 groundballs/flyball ratio...ranked 3rd in the Majors with a 2.44 mark last season, which was also the 5th highest GB/FB ratio all-time for a rookie in a single season since 1990.

VS. CLE: has faced Cleveland twice in his career...held the Indians to 1 run on 2 hits over 7.0 innings in a start on 6/22/12...struck out 9 and received the loss in the Astros 2-0 defeat at Minute Maid Park.

2013 DEBUT: pitched well despite receiving the loss in his first start of the season on 4/2 vs. TEX...6.0 IP, 1 ER...opposed RHP Yu Darvish, who came within 1 out of a perfect game.

IN 2012: led the Astros in wins, innings pitched and starts in 2012...went 5.0-or-more innings in all but one of his 32 starts...his 2.34 ERA (21ER/80.2IP) at home ranked fifth in the National League (min. 75 IP) and fourth all-time in Astros history among rookies (min. 10 starts).
