April 25, 2013 • Game #22 • Road Game #10 Baltimore Orioles (12-9) vs. Oakland Athletics (13-9) RH Jason Hammel (2-1, 4.74) vs. RH Jarrod Parker (0-3, 7.50)

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Orioles and Athletics meet in the opener of their four-game set and the first game of a three-city, 11-game road trip to Oakland, Seattle and Anaheim (four games in Oakland and Anaheim)...The Orioles are coming off a 6-3 homestand where they took two of three from the Rays, Dodgers and Blue Jays.

VS. OAKLAND: The A's won the season series, 5-4, in 2012, going 3-3 in Baltimore and 1-2 in Oakland...The Orioles trail in the all-time series 245-249 (119-125 in Baltimore and 126-124 in Oakland)...The Orioles have not won a season series against the A's since 1998 (8-3)...The September 14-16 series in Oakland last year marked the first time the two clubs had both been over .500 when meeting in September since September 2, 1992.

HOUSE OF PAIN: The Orioles have lost 16 of their last 19 games at Oakland Coliseum dating back to May 5, 2008..The Birds have been outscored 95-64 by the A's in those contests...The Birds are 9-29 in Oakland since July 11, 2003.

STREAK SNAPPED: The Orioles fell in 11 innings Wednesday in Baltimore snapping their streak of 17 consecutive extra innings games (11 on the road)...Their last regular season loss in extra innings was April 11, 2012 against the Yankees...The Orioles also lost Game 3 of the 2012 ALDS at New York in 12 innings...The 17-game streak is tied with the 1949 Indians for the second-longest streak in major league history.

<u>NATE THE GREAT:</u> Nate McLouth has reached base in 12 of his last 19 plate appearances...Over his last five games, McLouth is batting .462 (6-for-13) with six runs scored and six walks...In the leadoff spot, McLouth is batting .321 (17-53) with 11 walks...McLouth is second in the AL in walks by a leadoff batter behind Oakland's Coco Crisp (14), but Crisp has five more games played than McLouth.

POWER OUTAGE: The Orioles did not homer in the three-game set against Toronto after having just three homerless games in their first 18 contests...In 2012, they went a season-long five straight games without a home run, June 15-19, and had three other streaks of three games (August 3-5, July 7-13 and June 5-7).

SELECT COMPANY: Since August 22, 2011, the Orioles are tied with Reds and Nationals for the second-most wins in baseball with 127...Only the Rangers (130) have more wins...The Yankees have 126 wins...Since April 10, the Birds are 9-5 and tied with Boston for the best record in the American League.

KEEPING AN EYE ON COCO: The O's have caught an MLB-best 62 percent (8-for-13) of attempted base stealers...**Matt Wieters** has thrown out seven of 11 potential thieves and **Taylor Teagarden** has nabbed one of two...**Orioles catchers have thrown out as many runners as the Mariners (2), Rangers (2), Tigers (1), Angels (1) Blue Jays (1) and Athletics (0) combined.**

ROUGH DEBUT: RH **Josh Stinson** made his Orioles debut Wednesday against Toronto and allowed four home runs, **the most in Orioles history by a pitcher in his debut with the club...** The last Oriole to allow three in his club debut was **Chris Tillman** (July 29, 2009 against Kansas City)... The last Oriole to allow four homers in a game was **Jason Hammel** on May 30, 2012 against Toronto... Following the game, Stinson was optioned to Triple-A Norfolk.

THE CLOSER: In his last nine appearances, **Jim Johnson** is 1-1 with six saves and a .161 batting average against (five singles in 31 at-bats)....He has converted a career-best 29 consecutive saves dating back to July 30, 2012, the second-longest streak in franchise history (**Randy Myers**, 34, May 6-September 27, 1997) and the longest active streak in the majors...Since September 7, 2011, he leads the major leagues with 66 saves (**Craig Kimbrel** 54, **Fernando Rodney** 51, **Rafael Soriano** 49, **Jason Motte** 48 round out the top 5)...He has converted 95.7% of his opportunities (66 of 69), the best percentage of any closer with at least 10 saves since Sept. 7, 2011.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: Per *Elias*, the Orioles have won a franchise-record 100 consecutive regular season games when leading after seven innings (last loss was August 8, 2011)...It is the second-longest streak for any club during the expansion era (since 1961), trailing just the 1998-99 Yankees (116).

GO FIGURE: The Orioles are third in the AL (fourth in MLB) in fielding (.991) and since April 14, they are first in the AL (.997, one error)...The last fielding error by an Oriole was **Adam Jones'** dropped fly ball April 12 at New York...The last two errors were throwing errors by **J.J. Hardy**...The Orioles' three 2012 Gold Glove Award winners (Hardy, Jones and **Matt Wieters**) have made five of the Orioles' seven errors (Wieters-2, Hardy-2, Jones 1)

SAVING THE (O')DAY: In his last 23 appearances since September 18, 2012 (regular season and postseason included), **Darren O'Day** is 2-0 with a 0.36 ERA (25.0IP, 1ER) and the Orioles are 19-4 in those 23 games...Opponents are hitting just .111 (9-81) with one home run (**James Loney** on Thursday) and eight singles.

<u>CRUSH DAVIS</u>: Chris Davis is 10-for-26 in his last seven games with three multi-hit games, three doubles, a homer and three RBI...Over his last 28 regular season games (dating back to September 26, 2012), he has separate home run streaks of six games, four games and two-games...Davis has a total of 14 homers in those 28 games and is batting .357/.430/.857 with 35 RBI over that stretch.

JONESIN': Adam Jones has reached base safely in all but one (April 12 at NYY) of the Orioles' 21 games this season and has at least one hit in 19 of those contests.

LOCKDOWN LEFTY: Since moving to the Orioles bullpen on August 24, 2012, **Brian Matusz** has stranded all 24 runners he has inherited, leaving all 14 on base in 2012 and all 10 in 2013.

EARL IS LOVING THIS: The Orioles have had runners on base for 14 of their 25 home runs (56%) in 2013, leading the majors in multi-run HR...Last season, 92 of their 214 homers were of the multi-run variety (43%)...This season, 47 percent of the Orioles' runs have scored via the longball (47 of 101; eight two-run homers, four three-run homers and two grand slams)...In 2012, 47.3% of the Orioles' runs (337 of 712) scored directly on homers (122 solo, 64 two-run, 25 three-run and three grand slams)...Of the 25 home runs the Orioles have hit this season, 11 have given the Birds the lead, and three more have tied the game.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: LH Wei-Yin Chen makes his fifth start of the year and fourth road start...It will be his first career start in Oakland...In two career starts against Oakland, Chen is 2-0 with a 0.71 ERA (12.2IP, 1ER) and one Quality Start...The only run Chen allowed against the Athletics was a solo home run by Jonny Gomes April 28, 2012 in Baltimore...Among AL hurlers with two or more starts against the A's in 2012, Chen's 0.71 ERA was fourth-best behind Jered Weaver (0.29 in four starts), Alex Cobb (0.56 in two starts) and Justin Verlander (0.69 in two starts).

QUICK HITS: Is making his fifth start of 2013 and his third home start...Won his first career Opening Day start at Tampa Bay on April 2 (6.0IP, 3ER)...Was third on the team with 118.0 IP in 2012...Had right knee surgery last July and was limited to 20 starts in 2012... Orioles are his third major league team (Rockies 2009-11 and Rays 2006-08).

CAREER VS. OAKLAND: Has appeared in six games, including two starts...Overall is 3-1 with a 5.00 ERA (18.0IP, 10ER)...In two starts against Oakland (one in 2007 and one in 2009), he is 1-1 with a 6.97 ERA (10.1IP, 8ER) and one Quality Start...In his only start at Oakland (June 26, 2009), Hammel worked 7.1 innings and allowed two earned runs on four hits and two walks with five strikeouts...In four relief outings (all in 2008), is 2-0 with a 2.35 ERA (7.2IP, 2ER).

LAST START: Allowed three runs in the top of the first inning but held the Dodgers to one more run over the next five innings Saturday in Game 1 of the DH...Allowed a Eutaw Street home run to Andre Ethier...Did not factor in the decision as the O's rallied for a 7-5 win.

AT ORIOLE PARK: In two starts this season, is 0-1 with a 5.68 ERA (12.2IP, 8ER)...In 10 starts in 2012, was 4-2 with a 3.44 ERA (55.0IP, 21ER) and four Quality Starts...In his three starts at Camden Yards with the Rays from 2006-08, he was 0-2 with a 6.28 ERA (14.1IP, 10ER)...Overall, he is 4-5 with a 4.28 ERA (82.0IP, 39ER).

ON THE ROAD: Is 2-0 with a 3.75 ERA in two road starts in 2013...In 10 road starts in 2012, Hammel was 4-4 with a 3.43 ERA (63.0IP, 24ER) and five Quality Starts...In 70 career starts on the road, Hammel is 23-27 with a 4.63 ERA (404.0IP, 208ER) with 36 Quality Starts.

FAST STARTER: In five April 2012 starts, went 3-1 with a 1.97 ERA (32.0IP, 7ER) and 30 strikeouts...Held opposing hitters to a .200 batting average and .560 OPS in April...Was 6-1 in his first nine starts and as of May 25, 2012 was tied for the AL lead with six wins.

CENTRAL COMMAND: In four starts against the AL Central in 2012, went 3-1 with a 1.96 ERA (23.0IP, 5ER) and 27 strikeouts without allowing a home run...Is 0-1 with a 5.40 ERA (6.2IP, 4ER) in his only start against the Central this season (4/7/13 vs. MIN).

<u>A BEAST VS. THE EAST:</u> In nine starts against the AL East in 2012, Hammel went 2-2 with a 3.06 ERA (50.0IP, 17ER)...Only four starters with nine or more starts against the East had a lower ERA (**David Price**-2.51, **Felix Hernandez**-2.58, **Jeremy Hellickson**-2.81 and **Jarrod Parker**-2.98)...Is 1-0 with a 4.50 ERA (6.0IP, 3ER) in one start against the East this year (4/2/13 @ TB).

<u>CAREER IN POSTSEASON:</u> Is 0-1 with a 4.80 ERA (15.0IP, 8ER) in three starts...Started Game 3 of the NLDS for Colorado against Philadelphia in 2009 (no decision) and started Games 1 and 5 of the 2012 ALDS against the Yankees and was 0-1 with a 3.18 ERA (11.1IP, 4ER)...His teams have scored a total of eight runs in those three games.

QUITE A RUN: In a span of two starts June 16-22, 2012, Hammel went 17 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run...According to Elias, it was the first time an O's starter had consecutive starts of 8.0 innings or more without allowing an earned run in a single season since **Scott Erickson** did it in 1997...**Jeremy Guthrie** also accomplished the feat in his final start of 2010 (October 1) and first start in 2011 (April 1).

SOMETHING CLICKED: In 29 games (24 starts) since he was moved to the Rockies bullpen on August 24, 2011, Hammel is 9-8 with a 3.31 ERA (155.0IP, 126H, 57ER) and 135 strikeouts...Opponents are batting .221 (126-570) against him during that span...In his previous 25 games (all starts) in 2011 for Colorado, he was 7-12 with a 5.24 ERA (146.0IP, 160H, 85ER) with 77 K's.

INTERLEAGUE STUD: In four starts last year, Hammel was 3-0 with a 2.54 ERA (28.1IP, 8ER)...In 15 career starts, he is 8-3 with a 3.99 ERA (94.2IP, 42ER) and six Quality Starts.

NICE OPENING ACT: In his Orioles debut April 8, 2012 in Baltimore against the Twins, Hammel carried a no-hitter into the eighth inning before allowing consecutive doubles to lead off the eighth...According to Elias, the last pitcher to throw 7.0 hitless innings in a team debut was **Hideo Nomo**'s no-hitter for Boston in 2001 (vs. BAL)...The outing tied his career-high for innings and gave the O's a sweep of the Twins.

ONE-HITTER: His one-hit shutout June 16 at Atlanta was the 33rd one-hitter in Orioles history ...Only hit came with two outs in the seventh on a single by Jason Heyward...His outing marked the first time an Oriole pitcher had allowed just one hit in a shutout since Mike Mussina accomplished the feat August 1, 2000 against Minnesota...The club's last one-hitter came on September 28, 2006, when Daniel Cabrera came within two outs of a no-hitter at Yankee Stadium...Since the Braves moved south in 1966, Hammel is the first pitcher to throw a complete-game one-hitter in Atlanta...Three visiting pitchers have thrown complete-game, no-hit victories in Atlanta: John Montefusco in 1976, Randy Johnson (a perfect game) in 2004 and Ubaldo Jimenez in 2010.

<u>LUCKY SEVENS:</u> Hammel picked up his seventh win June 16 last year and **Wei-Yin Chen** added his seventh June 17...It marked the first time since 1999 the Orioles have had two pitchers with at least seven wins by June 17 (**Mike Mussina-8**, **Sidney Ponson-7**).

GREAT FIRST IMPRESSION: Hammel allowed two or fewer runs in each of his first six starts in 2012, joining **Jay Tibbs** (May 24-June 21, 1989) and **Jim Palmer** (April 7-May 4, 1977) as the only pitchers in Orioles history start a season with six starts of two or fewer runs allowed...Nobody has gone seven starts with two or fewer allowed.

OF NOTE: Recorded first MLB win and recorded first MLB hit (RBI double off Livan Hernandez in first MLB plate appearance) on June 18, 2008 at Arizona...Earned first career save September 10, 2008 at Boston...Threw first complete game July 1, 2009 at Los Angeles (NL)...On July 16, 2006 against Columbus he combined with Juan Salas for the first-ever no-hitter in Bulls Triple-A history and just the second ever at Durham Bulls Athletic Park...Was named 2005 Rays Minor League Pitcher of the Year and Southern League midseason All-Star...Named Class-A Bakersfield's 2004 Pitcher of the Year.

BACKGROUND: Was selected by the Rays in the 10th round of the 2002 draft out of Treasure Valley (OR) Community College...Graduated from South Kitsap (WA) High School...Shares a birthdate with his son, Beckett (2011).
