Baltimore Orioles (13-9) vs. Oakland Athletics (13-10)

LH Wei-Yin Chen (1-2, 3.38) vs. LH Tommy Milone (3-1, 4.26)



TONIGHT'S GAME: The Orioles and Athletics meet in the second game of their four-game set and game two of a three-city, 11-game road trip to Oakland, Seattle and Anaheim (four games in Oakland and Anaheim)...The Orioles are coming off a 6-3 homestand where they took two of three from the Rays, Dodgers and Blue Jays.

VS. OAKLAND: The Orioles lead the season series, 1-0...The A's won the season series, 5-4, in 2012, going 3-3 in Baltimore and 1-2 in Oakland...The Orioles trail in the all-time series 246-249 (119-125 in Baltimore and 127-124 in Oakland)...The Orioles have not won a season series against the A's since 1998 (8-3)...The September 14-16 series in Oakland last year marked the first time the two clubs had both been over .500 when meeting in September since September 2, 1992...**The last Orioles series win in Oakland was July 20-22, 2007.**

A DECADE OF DOMINANCE: The Orioles scored 10 runs in the series opener Friday, marking the first time since May 23, 2002 (the last game at Oakland in 2002) that the Birds posted 10 or more runs in a game the Coliseum...**In the 10 seasons from 2003-2012 in between the last two 10+ run games in Oakland, the Birds averaged 3.17 runs per game in Oakland (120 runs in 38 games) and were just 9-29 in those 38 games...**The Orioles have lost 16 of their last 20 games at Oakland Coliseum dating back to May 5, 2008.

FINALLY: Wei-Yin Chen won for the first time since August 19, 2012 last Saturday as he beat the Dodgers 6-1...Chen went 0-6 with a 4.37 ERA (59.2IP, 29ER) over a 10-start span (regular season only)...**In those 10 games, the Orioles scored 15 runs while Chen was in the game and in his last 28 starts, the Orioles have scored three or fewer runs while he was in the game 19 times.**

GOTTA HAVE HEART: On Thursday, the Orioles' 3-4-5 hitters (Nick Markakis, Adam Jones and Chris Davis) combined to go 10-for-28 with two doubles, a homer, seven runs scored and drove in seven runs...In the first 22 games, the Orioles' 3-4-5 hitters are batting .346 (84-243) with 20 doubles, 14 homers, 51 runs scored and 55 RBI.

POWER OUTAGE: Between Adam Jones' third inning home run on Sunday against the Dodgers and Chris Davis' homer in the sixth inning Thursday, the Orioles were held homerless for a season-high 39 innings...The last time the Orioles went more than 39 innings without a homer was June 14-20, 2012, when they went 47 innings without a longball.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT....: The 10 runs the Orioles score were their most in a nine inning game since September 26, 2012 when they scored 12 against Toronto...The 15 hits were also a season-high and their most since September 22, 2012, when they also recorded 15 hits at Boston.

NATE THE GREAT: Nate McLouth has reached base safely in 15 of his last 25 plate appearances...Over his last six games, McLouth is batting .444 (8-for-18) with eight runs scored and seven walks...In the leadoff spot, McLouth is batting .328 (19-58) with 12 walks...McLouth is second in the AL in walks by a leadoff batter behind Oakland's Coco Crisp (14), but Crisp has five more games played than McLouth.

SELECT COMPANY: Since August 22, 2011, the Orioles are tied with the Nationals for the second-most wins in baseball with 128...Only the Rangers (131) have more wins...The Yankees and Reds have 127 wins...Since April 10, the Birds are 10-5 and tied with Boston for the best record in the American League.

KEEPING AN EYE ON COCO: The O's have caught an AL-best eight attempted base stealers (of 13)...Matt Wieters has thrown out seven of 11 potential thieves and Taylor Teagarden has nabbed one of two...**Orioles catchers have thrown out more runners than the Rangers (2), Angels (2), Tigers (1), Blue Jays (1) and Athletics (0) combined...**The A's are the only team that has not thrown out a potential base stealer (0-for-16).

THE CLOSER: In his last nine appearances, Jim Johnson is 1-1 with six saves and a .161 batting average against (five singles in 31 at-bats)...He has converted a career-best 29 consecutive saves dating back to July 30, 2012, the second-longest streak in franchise history (Randy Myers, 34, May 6-September 27, 1997) and the longest active streak in the majors...Since September 7, 2011, he leads the major leagues with 66 saves (Craig Kimbrel 54, Fernando Rodney 51, Rafael Soriano 49, Jason Motte 48 round out the top 5)...He has converted 95.7% of his opportunities (66 of 69), the best percentage of any closer with at least 10 saves since Sept. 7, 2011.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: Per Elias, the Orioles have won a franchise-record 101 consecutive regular season games when leading after seven innings (last loss was August 8, 2011)...It is the second-longest streak for any club during the expansion era (since 1961), trailing just the 1998-99 Yankees (116).

SAVING THE (O')DAY: In his last 23 appearances since September 18, 2012 (regular season and postseason included), Darren O'Day is 2-0 with a 0.36 ERA (25.0IP, 1ER) and the Orioles are 19-4 in those 23 games...Opponents are hitting just .111 (9-81) with one home run (James Loney on Thursday) and eight singles.

CRUSH DAVIS: Chris Davis is 12-for-29 in his last eight games with four multi-hit games, three doubles, two homers and five RBI...Over his last 29 regular season games (dating back to September 26, 2012), he has separate home run streaks of six games, four games and two-games...**Davis has a total of 15 homers in those 29 games and is batting .366/.445/.881 with 37 RBI over that stretch.**

JONESIN': Adam Jones has reached base safely in all but one (April 12 at NYY) of the Orioles' 22 games this season and has at least one hit in 20 of those contests.

LOCKDOWN LEFTY: Since moving to the Orioles bullpen on August 24, 2012, Brian Matusz has stranded all 24 runners he has inherited, leaving all 14 on base in 2012 and all 10 in 2013.

EARL IS LOVING THIS: The Orioles have had runners on base for 14 of their 26 home runs (54%) in 2013, leading the majors in multi-run HR...Last season, 92 of their 214 homers were of the multi-run variety (43%)...This season, 43 percent of the Orioles' runs have scored via the longball (48 of 111; eight two-run homers, four three-run homers and two grand slams)...In 2012, 47.3% of the Orioles' runs (337 of 712) scored directly on homers (122 solo, 64 two-run, 25 three-run and three grand slams)...**Of the 26 home runs the Orioles have hit this season, 11 have given the Birds the lead, and three more have tied the game.**

TOMORROW'S STARTER: RH Chris Tillman makes his fifth start of the year and second road start...In his only career start against the A's, May 27, 2011 in Oakland, Tillman worked 4.1 innings and allowed two runs (one earned) on six hits and three walks while striking out two.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER: #16 WEI-YIN CHEN

How Acquired: January 10, 2012; signed by the Orioles as a non-drafted free agent to a three-year contract with a club option for 2015

QUICK HITS: Name pronounced Way-In...First Taiwanese-born player in Orioles history... His 12 wins in 2012 were the most by an O's rookie since **Daniel Cabrera** won 12 in 2004...**His 12 wins in 2012 were the most by an Oriole pitcher since Erik Bedard won 13 in 2007...**Struck out **Curtis Granderson** in the first inning April 10, 2012 for his first MLB strikeout...Recorded first win April 17, 2012 at Chicago...Earned the win in Game 2 of the 2012 ALDS vs. NYY (6.1IP, 8H, 2R/1ER, BB, 3K), becoming the third Taiwanese-born pitcher in ML history to record a post-season victory...Missed 2006 and 2007 seasons in Japan after having "Tommy John" surgery.

CHEN VS. ATHLETICS: Is making his first career start in Oakland...In two career starts against Oakland, Chen is 2-0 with a 0.71 ERA (12.2IP, 1ER) and one Quality Start...The only run Chen allowed against the Athletics was a solo home run by **Jonny Gomes** April 28, 2012 in Baltimore...**Among AL hurlers with two or more starts against the A's in 2012, Chen's 0.71 ERA was fourth-best behind Jered Weaver (0.29 in four starts), Alex Cobb (0.56 in two starts) and Justin Verlander (0.69 in two starts).**

AT ORIOLE PARK: In 18 home starts, he is 7-6 with a 3.96 ERA (109.0IP, 48ER) and 10 Quality Starts...Fell one out short of a QS twice (4/10 vs. NYY and 7/29 vs. OAK).

ON THE ROAD: In 18 starts, is 6-7 with a 3.93 ERA (107.2IP, 47ER) and 10 Quality Starts...The O's are 10-8 in his 18 road starts...He has completed six innings on the road 10 times...In his last 13 road starts (since June 6, 2012), he is 5-5 with a 3.33 ERA (81.0IP, 30ER) and has pitched at least seven innings in six of those 13 outings.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS: With his April 20 win over the Dodgers, Chen tied **Hong-Chih Kuo** for the second-most victories by a Taiwanese-born pitcher in MLB history (**Chien-Ming Wang** leads with 61)...The other Taiwanese-born pitcher in ML history to win a game was **Chin-hui Tsao** (4).

HELP HIM OUT: In his brief Orioles career, the Birds have scored just 26 runs (2.00 per game) in the 13 games that Chen has been charged with the loss and have scored 70 runs (5.39 per game) in the 13 games when he recorded a win...Has been charged with the loss six times (out of 36 career starts) when making a Quality Start.

IMPRESSIVE: Chen was the only pitcher to make more than 20 starts for the O's in 2012, making the Orioles the only playoff team in history to have just one starter make more than 20 starts.

LUCKY SEVENS: When Chen pitches 5.0 or fewer innings, the Orioles are 2-6, but when he pitches 5.1 or more innings, the Birds are 18-10, including a **9-0 mark when he works 7.0 or more innings** (Chen is 7-0 in those nine outings).

CHEN-SATIONAL: Among AL rookies in the last 20 seasons dating back to 1993, Chen's 2012 season ranks 10th in innings pitched (192.2) and eighth in strikeouts (154).

INTERLEAGUE: In five starts against NL clubs (Dodgers, Pirates, Braves and the Nationals twice), Chen is 3-2 with a 4.08 ERA (28.2IP, 13ER) and two Quality Starts.

ROCK OF THE ROTATION: Led club with 32 starts in 2012, the only pitcher to make more than 20 starts for the O's in 2012...**Became the first Oriole starter to post a winning record with over 30 starts since Erik Bedard went 15-11 in 33 starts in 2006...**Allowed three or fewer earned runs in 23 of his 32 starts.

SUPER SOUTHPAW: Among qualifying AL lefties in 2012, tied for eighth in wins (12), tied for fifth in games started (32), ranked seventh in innings (192.2), ninth in strikeouts (154), 10th in ERA (4.02) and eighth in opponent batting average (.250)...Also had the seventh-lowest ground ball percentage in the major leagues (46.1) among qualifiers.

FIRST YEAR PHENOM: Among qualifying AL rookies (1 INN/Team G), finished among the leaders in: IP (1st, 192.2); wins (T-4th, 12); strikeouts (3rd, 154); games started (1st, 32), opponents' average (4th, .250) and ERA (6th, 4.02).

HISTORIC OUTING: On July 29, 2012 vs. Oakland, Chen struck out 12 in 5.2 innings, setting a major league record for strikeouts in a game by a Taiwanese-born pitcher, breaking **Chien-Ming Wang's** record (10), set June 17, 2007...It was the most strikeouts by an O's pitcher since **Erik Bedard** tied the franchise-record with 15 strikeouts on July 7, 2007 against Texas and Chen became first Oriole to strike out 10 or more batters in less than six innings.

GREAT START: Chen began his major league career 4-0 in 2012...The last Orioles starter to begin a season 4-0 was **Erik Bedard** (April 5-20, 2006).

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Allowed a home run to **Derek Jeter**, the first batter he faced in the majors April 10, 2012 at home...Became first pitcher since Cleveland's **Zach Putnam** to allow a homer to the first batter he faced in the big leagues (**Adrian Beltre**, September 13, 2011 in Texas).

JAPAN CAREER: Played five seasons for the Chunichi Dragons of the Nippon Professional Baseball League...Combined to go 36-30 with a 2.53 ERA (650.2IP, 183ER) and 520 K's in 127G (89GS) in 5 seasons in Japan...In his 127 game (89 GS) career in Japan, Chen threw 120 or more pitches 16 times...He threw 120-129 pitches nine times, 130-139 pitches six times and threw a career-high 145 pitches on July 18, 2010 at Hiroshima...Posted a 2.68 ERA (164.2IP, 49ER) in 25 games (24 GS) in 2011, the fourth consecutive year in which his ERA was lower than 3.00 and his 94:31 strikeout-to-walk ratio marked the fourth consecutive season he was better than 3:1...Recorded the only save of his NPB career on 8/7/05 at Yokohama.

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE IN JAPAN: Pitched in the NPB postseason in each of the last four years with Chunichi...In 2008 and 2009 the Dragons played in the first two rounds of the playoffs before being eliminated...In 2010 and 2011 they received a first round bye and reached the Japan Series before losing to Chiba Lotte in 2010 and Fukuoka in 2011...In his 10 post-season GS, Chen was 2-5 with a 3.39 ERA (61.0IP, 23ER) and 10 walks and 49 K's.

MR. OLYMPIA: Pitched for the Chinese Taipei team in the Beijing Olympics...Went 1-0 in two GS, tossing 7.0 shutout innings in a 5-0 win over the Netherlands on August 13...Was also a member of the Chinese Taipei national baseball team in the 2004 Athens Olympics.

MISCELLANEOUS: Married to Yi-Wen Tsai (E-ewen sigh)...They have a son, Karsten, born November 12, 2012.
