OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost a season-high tying four straight (also: April 19-22) and eight of the last nine games...are now 4-10 since the nine-game winning streak.
- The A's are 11-2 (.846) against American League West competition and 2-10 (.167) against everyone else...are 1-8 in this 10-game stretch against the AL East (0-3 vs. Tampa Bay, 1-2 at Boston, 0-3 vs. Baltimore).
- A.J. Griffin** allowed a game-tying, two-run home run to Markakis in the fourth inning...it was the first hit he has allowed to an opponents number three hitter this year...number three hitters were 0 for 13 entering the at bat.
- A's starting pitchers are 5-10 with a 5.64 ERA (62 er in 99.0 ip) over the last 18 games (since April 9)...that includes 2-0 with a 1.80 ERA (4 er in 20.0 ip) in three starts by Bartolo Colón and 3-10 with a 6.61 ERA (58 er in 79.0 ip) by everyone else.
- Josh Donaldson** (4 for 4, 2 2b, 2 rbi, cs) recorded his second career four-hit game (also: Aug. 17, 2012 vs. Cleveland)...is now 11 for 19 (.579) with four runs, six doubles, eight RBI and five walks over his last six games and is batting .397 (25 for 63) over his last 17 contests.
- John Jaso** (3 for 5, so) had a career-high tying three hits (10th time, last: April 23, 2013 at Boston).

BALTIMORE NOTES

- The Baltimore Orioles have won a season-high three straight and eight of the last 10 games...are 3-0 on this 11-game road trip to Oakland (3-0), Seattle (three games) and Los Angeles (four games).
- The Orioles have won four straight in Oakland dating back to last season...it is the first time the Orioles have won four in a row in Oakland since May 23-Sept. 9, 1998 and their first series win at O.co Coliseum since July 20-22, 2007.
- The Orioles hit back-to-back home runs in the fourth inning (Markakis, Jones)...it is the first time Baltimore has hit back-to-back home runs since Sept. 8, 2012 against New York-AL (Reynolds, Ford).
- Chris Tillman** is 8-1 with a 2.37 ERA (17 er in 64.2 ip) in 10 career starts against American League West competition...including 1-0 with a 2.61 ERA (3 er in 10.1 ip) in two starts against Oakland.
- Nate McLouth** (3 for 5, r, hr, 2 rbi) has reached base safely in 18 of his last 31 plate appearances...is 11 for 24 (.458) with seven walks in eight games over that span.
- Taylor Teagarden** (0 for 2, so) left the game in the sixth inning with a dislocated left thumb.
