TODAY'S GAME: The Orioles and Athletics meet in the third game of their four-game set and game three of a three-city, 11-game road trip to Oakland, Seattle and Anaheim (four games in Oakland and Anaheim)...The Home 7-5 Orioles are coming off a 6-3 homestand where they took two of three from the Rays, Dodgers and Blue Jays. Away 7-4 Day 5-4 VS. OAKLAND: The Orioles lead the season series, 2-0...The A's won the season series, 5-4, in 2012, going 3-9-5 Night 3 in Baltimore and 1-2 in Oakland...The Orioles trail in the all-time series 247-249 (119-125 in Baltimore and vs. LHP 5-3 vs. RHP 9-6 128-124 in Oakland)...The Orioles have not won a season series against the A's since 1998 (8-3)...The September 14-16 series in Oakland last year marked the first time the two clubs had both been over .500 when Series Record 5-2-0 meeting in September since September 2, 1992. 6-2 First game of series 3-4 Last game of a series STREAKING: The Birds have won three straight in Oakland (dating back to September 16, 2012) for the first Last 10 games 7-3 time August 15-17, 2005...The last time the Birds won four straight in Oakland was May 23-September 9, 1998. W2 Win/Loss streak JUST DO IT: With a win today or tomorrow, the Orioles will claim their first series win in Oakland since July 3 (4/18-20) Longest win streak 20-22, 2007...The last time the O's won a four-game series in Oakland was July 31-August 3, 1997...The Longest losing streak 3 (4/6-8) last four-game sweep by Baltimore in Oakland was May 22-25, 1987. Most games over .500 5 (14-9) Most games under .500 1(3-4)PITCHING PROWESS: The Birds have recorded consecutive Quality Starts in Oakland for the first time since 1-1 Extra innings April 16-18, 2010 when they posted three straight (Kevin Millwood, Jeremy Guthrie and Brian Matusz). Shutouts 0-1 One-run games 4-3 A PRETTY GOOD YEAR: Since April 25, 2012, Chris Davis has 40 home runs, good for fifth in the major Two-run games 2 - 1leagues behind Ryan Braun (45), Edwin Encarnacion (45), Miguel Cabrera (41) and Adam Dunn (41)...Davis has played 147 games in that span, while the other four averaged 158 games played in that span. 11-0 Lead after 7 innings Tied after 7 innings 1-2 A DECADE OF DOMINANCE: The Orioles scored 10 runs in the series opener Friday, marking the first time Trail after 7 innings 2-7 since May 23, 2002 (the last game at Oakland in 2002) that the Birds posted 10 or more runs in a game the Lead after 8 innings 10-0Coliseum...In the 10 seasons from 2003-2012 in between the last two 10+ run games in Oakland, the Birds Tied after 8 innings 1 - 2averaged 3.17 runs per game in Oakland (120 runs in 38 games) and were just 9-29 in those 38 games...The 1-7 Trail after 8 innings Orioles have lost 16 of their last 21 games at Oakland Coliseum dating back to May 5, 2008. Orioles score first 9-6 MEAT OF THE ORDER: In the first 23 games, the Orioles' 3-4-5 hitters are batting .335 (85-254) with 20 Opponent scores first 5-3 Score four or more runs 11-4 doubles, 14 homers, 51 runs scored and 55 RBI. Score fewer than four runs 3-5 ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Wei-Yin Chen and Jim Johnson combined for the Orioles' first shutout since 11-5 Orioles homer September 4, 2012 at Toronto...Chen's 8.0 innings pitched set a career-high and marked the longest outing by an Outhit opponents 11-4 Orioles starter since Chris Tillman worked eight innings on September 28, 2012 against Boston...J.J. Hardy 3-2 Equal hit total recorded his first multi-hit game after posting one hit in 15 of the first 22 games. 0-3 Outhit by opponents Most hits in a game 15(4/25)NATE THE GREAT: Nate McLouth has reached base safely in 15 of his last 26 plate appearances...Over his Fewest hits in a game 5 (last 4/22) last seven games, McLouth is batting .421 (8-for-19) with eight runs scored and seven walks...In the leadoff spot, 10-5 No errors McLouth is batting .328 (19-58) with 12 walks...McLouth is second in the AL in walks by a leadoff batter With one error 3-3 behind Oakland's Coco Crisp (14), but Crisp has five more games played than McLouth. With two errors 1-1 SELECT COMPANY: Since August 22, 2011, the Orioles are tied with the Nationals for the second-most wins With three or more errors 0-0in baseball with 129...Only the Rangers (132) have more wins...The Yankees have 128 wins...Since April 10, 12-8 vs. AI the Birds are 11-5 and tied with Boston for the best record in the American League. vs. AL East 9-6 vs. AL Central 1-2 KEEPING AN EYE ON COCO: The O's have caught an AL-best eight attempted base stealers (of 13)...Matt vs. AL West 2-0Wieters has thrown out seven of 11 potential thieves and Taylor Teagarden has nabbed one of two...Orioles 2-1 vs. NL catchers have thrown out more runners than the Rangers (2), Angels (2), Tigers (1), Blue Jays (1) and 46,653 (4/5) Largest home crowd Athletics (0) combined... The A's are the only team that has not thrown out a potential base stealer (0-for-17). Largest road crowd 41,851 (4/13) THE CLOSER: In his last 10 appearances, Jim Johnson is 1-1 with seven saves and a .171 average against **CURRENT ROAD TRIP** (five singles and a double in 35 at-bats)....He has converted a career-best 30 consecutive saves dating back to July 30, 2012, the second-longest streak in franchise history (Randy Myers, 34, May 6-September 27, 1997) and Record 2-0the longest active streak in the majors...Since September 7, 2011, he leads MLB with 67 saves (Craig Kimbrel Team Average .306 (22-72) 54, Fernando Rodney 51, Rafael Soriano 49, Jason Motte 48 round out the top 5)...He has converted 95.7% of Runs per Game 6.5 (13R/2G) his opportunities (67 of 70), the best percentage of any closer with at least 10 saves since September 7, 2011. 2 Fielding Errors SEVENTH HEAVEN: Per Elias, the Orioles have won a franchise-record 102 consecutive regular season games Team ERA 0.00 (18.0IP, 0ER) when leading after seven innings (last loss was August 8, 2011)...It is the second-longest streak for any club during the expansion era (since 1961), trailing just the 1998-99 Yankees (116). Starters W-L 2-00.00 (14.0IP, 0ER) Starters ERA SAVING THE (O')DAY: In his last 23 appearances since September 18, 2012 (regular season and postseason Bullpen W-L-S 0-0-1 included). Darren O'Day is 2-0 with a 0.36 ERA (25.0IP, 1ER) and the Orioles are 19-4 in those 23 Bullpen ERA 0.00 (4.0IP, 0ER) games...Opponents are hitting just .111 (9-81) with one home run (James Loney last Thurs.) and eight singles. Saves/Opps 1/1

<u>CRUSH DAVIS:</u> Chris Davis is 12-for-32 in his last nine games with four multi-hit games, three doubles, two homers and five RBI...Over his last 30 regular season games (dating back to September 26, 2012), he has separate home run streaks of six games, four games and two-games...Davis has a total of 15 homers in those 30 games and is batting .356/.439/.856 with 37 RBI over that stretch.

JONESIN': Adam Jones has reached base safely in all but one (April 12 at NYY) of the Orioles' 23 games this season and has at least one hit in 21 of the 23.

LOCKDOWN LEFTY: Since moving to the Orioles bullpen on August 24, 2012, Brian Matusz has stranded all 24 runners he has inherited, leaving all 14 on base in 2012 and all 10 in 2013.


EARL IS LOVING THIS: The Orioles have had runners on base for 14 of their 26 home runs (54%) in 2013 (tied with Cubs for most multi-run **HR**)...Last season, 92 of their 214 homers were of the multi-run variety (43%)...This season, 42 percent of the Orioles' runs have scored via the longball (48 of 114; eight two-run homers, four three-run homers and two grand slams)...In 2012, 47.3% of the Orioles' runs (337 of 712) scored directly on homers (122 solo, 64 two-run, 25 three-run and three grand slams)...Of the 26 home runs the Orioles have hit this season, 11 have given the Birds the lead, and three more have tied the game.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: RH Miguel Gonzalez makes his fifth start of the year and third road start...Gonzalez has never faced the Athletics.

<u>OUICK HITS</u>: Making his fifth start and second road start of 2013...Made 15 starts in 2012 and was 9-3 with a 2.93 ERA...Lost his last start of 2012 October 3 at Tampa to snap a career-high-tying four-game win streak (August 21-September 28, also won four straight decisions from July 21-August 6).

LAST START: Pitched a season-high 6.2 innings against Toronto and allowed one earned run in the 7th inning on a two-out single by **Colby Rasmus**...Left the game after that hit with the score 1-1 and did not factor in the decision, but Baltimore went on to win, 2-1, on a bases-loaded, walk-off single by **Nick Markakis** in the 9th inning...Became the second Orioles starter to go 6.2IP this season (**Jason Hammel** went 6.2IP on 4/7 vs. MIN in a 4-3 loss)...O's improved to 9-1 in Tillman's last 10 starts in which he has pitched at least 6.0 innings.

CAREER vs. OAKLAND: Is 0-0 with a 2.08 ERA against the A's in one career start, which came on 5/27/11 at Oakland...Pitched 4.1 innings and allowed two runs (one earned) on six hits and three walks...Hit a batter and struck out two...Did not factor in the decision (O's lost, 6-2).

BEST AGAINST THE WEST: Tillman is 7-1 with a 2.30 ERA (58.2IP, 15ER) in nine career starts against the AL West...Is the only division in the AL against which he has a winning record and an ERA below 4.93...Has held AL West opponents to a .193/.257/.307 line...Has made four consecutive Quality Starts against the division...Since the start of 2010, is 6-0 against the West with a 1.37 ERA (46.0IP, 7ER) and a .164 average against.

SPRING TRAINING REPORT: In two Spring Training starts, Tillman was 1-0 with a 4.15 ERA (4.1IP, 2ER)...Allowed five hits, walked three and struck out four...Also made several starts in minor league camp and pitched on March 29 against State College of Florida.

ON THE ROAD: Is 0-0 with a 3.38 ERA (5.1IP, 2ER) in his one road start of 2013, which came on April 11 at Boston...In his nine road starts in 2012, he was 5-2 with a 3.04 ERA (47.1IP, 16ER) and five Quality Starts...In 29 career road starts, is 8-11 with a 4.86 ERA (146.1IP, 79ER)...He has made 10 Quality Starts in his 29 road outings...The O's are 11-18 in his 29 road starts.

AT ORIOLE PARK: Is 0-1 with a 5.87 ERA (15.1IP, 10ER) and one Quality Start in three home starts in 2013...In 2012, was 4-1 with a 2.79 ERA (38.2IP, 12ER) and four Quality Starts in six home starts...He is 8-8 with a 4.66 ERA (141.0IP, 73ER) and 12 Quality Starts in 26 career starts at Oriole Park but went over a year between home wins (August 14, 2009-October 1, 2010)...The O's are 15-11 in his 26 starts.

CAREER YEAR: Tillman won nine games in 15 starts in 2012...He had seven wins in his 36 career starts from 2009-11...Set career bests in 2012 in wins, games started, innings pitched (86.0), strikeouts (66), WHIP (1.05) and ERA (2.93)...From when he was recalled on July 4 to the end of the regular season, was fourth in the AL in WHIP among qualifiers (min. 82.0IP) behind James Shields, David Price and CC Sabathia...Was third in H/9 (6.91) among qualifiers behind Shields and Price over the same span...In his six starts from August 28 to the end of the regular season, Tillman was 3-1 with a 1.80 ERA (35.0IP, 7ER) and four Quality Starts (left one start after three innings with sore elbow)...During that span, had the lowest ERA among AL pitchers with at least four starts.

IF YOU'RE GOING TO GIVE THEM UP...: Chris has allowed 44 home runs in his career (30 solo shots)...Twelve of the 44 homers were by the leadoff batter of an inning...**Alex Rodriguez** (twice) and **Kelly Shoppach** are the only players to hit 3-run homers off Tillman.

ON A ROLL: Improved to 8-2 September 17, 2012 at Seattle to become the first Orioles starting pitcher younger than 25 to win at least eight of his first 10 decisions in one season since **Mike Mussina** did it at age 23 and 24 in 1992 and 1993. *Courtesy Elias*

1st-INNING FUNK: Of the 38 runs he allowed in 2012, 16 scored in the 1st inning.

STRONG FINISH: In his last home start of 2012 (Sept 28 vs. Boston), he allowed one hit, a leadoff bunt single by **Scott Podsednik**, the only hit he would allow over eight innings...Faced one batter over the minimum in the final seven innings of his outing...According to Elias, the last time a team bunted for a leadoff hit for their only hit of the game was August 13, 1970, when Minnesota's **Cesar Tovar** bunted for a hit off Washington's **Dick Bosman**.

<u>QUITE A 2012 DEBUT</u>: Worked a career-high 8.1 innings July 4 at Seattle and allowed two unearned runs as he beat the team that drafted and signed him in 2006...Allowed two hits and two walks while striking out seven...His 125 pitches thrown were a career-high and the most by an Oriole starter since **Erik Bedard** threw 126 pitches May 4, 2005 against Toronto.

LITTLE HELP HERE?: In his 13 starts in 2011, the Orioles gave Tillman 23 runs of support while he was in the game, with 10 of those coming in two starts (May 11 vs. SEA and May 16 at BOS)...The Birds did not score while he was in the game in five of his 13 starts...In 2010, the Birds gave him two or fewer runs while he was in the game nine times in 12 starts...Of his 41 runs allowed in 2011, 22 of them have scored in the first two innings.

OPENING ACT: Tillman threw 6.0 innings of no-hit ball in his first start of 2011, April 2 at Tampa Bay...According to Elias, over the last 15 seasons only two other pitchers threw at least 6.0 innings and didn't allow a hit in their first start of a season: **Shaun Marcum** (6 IP) for the 2007 Blue Jays and **Hideo Nomo**, who threw a no-hitter against Baltimore for the 2001 Red Sox...**Jason Hammel** did it in 2012 for the Orioles.

NO-HITTER: Tillman fired a nine-inning no-hitter April 28, 2010 for Norfolk at Gwinnett (Braves) as he walked one and fanned six...It was the first nine-inning no-hitter by an O's Triple-A farmhand since April 20, 1974, (Rochester's **Wayne Garland** vs. Charleston in a 5-0 win).

MLB FIRSTS: On July 29, 2009, made his major league debut...Recorded his first major league win August 14, 2009 vs. Los Angeles (AL)...Struck out Kansas City's Mike Jacobs for his first major league strikeout July 29, 2009.

AWARD WINNER: Named to the 2010 International League All-Star team...Started for the U.S. Team in the 2009 MLB Futures Game on July 12 in St. Louis...Elected to the 2009 Triple-A All-Star Game, but did not participate (Futures Game)...Named Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Month and Norfolk Pitcher of the Month for April 2009...Named to the 2008 Eastern League Southern Division All-Star Team...Named Org. Pitcher of the Month for May 2008 and August 2008...Named to the 2008 Bank of America Second Team Minor League All-Star Team.
