ODDS & ENDS TODAY'S GAME: The Orioles and Athletics meet in the finale of their four-game set and game four of a threecity, 11-game road trip to Oakland, Seattle and Anaheim (four games in Oakland and Anaheim)...The Orioles are Home 7-5 coming off a 6-3 homestand where they took two of three from the Rays, Dodgers and Blue Jays. 8-4 Away Day 6-4 VS. OAKLAND: The Orioles lead the season series, 3-0...The A's won the season series, 5-4, in 2012, as the 9-5 Night Orioles went 3-3 in Baltimore and 1-2 in Oakland...The Orioles trail in the all-time series 248-249 (119-125 in vs. LHP 5-3 vs. RHP 10-6 Baltimore and 129-124 in Oakland)...The Orioles have not won a season series against the A's since 1998 (8-3)... The September 14-16 series in Oakland last year marked the first time the two clubs had both been over .500 Series Record 6-2-0 when meeting in September since September 2, 1992. 6-2 First game of series 3-4 Last game of a series FINISH THE JOB: A win by the Birds today would clinch the Orioles' first season series win against the Last 10 games 8-2 Athletics since 1998 (8-3)...A win would also even the all-time series at 249 wins each. Win/Loss streak W3 STREAKING: The Birds have won four straight in Oakland (dating back to September 16, 2012) for the first Longest win streak 3 (4/18-20, 4/25-27) time since May 23-September 9, 1998...A win today would give the Birds five straight wins in Oakland for Longest losing streak 3 (4/6-8) the first time since May 13-August 16, 1996. Most games over .500 6 (15-9) Most games under .500 1(3-4)JUST DO IT: The Orioles have claimed their first series win in Oakland since July 20-22, 2007 and their first 1-1 win of a four-game series in Oakland since July 31-August 3, 1997...A win today would give the Birds their Extra innings Shutouts 1-1 first sweep of a four-game series in Oakland since May 22-25, 1987. One-run games 4-3 Two-run games 2-1 PITCHING PROWESS: The Birds have recorded three consecutive Quality Starts in Qakland (Jason Hammel, Wei-Yin Chen and Chris Tillman) for the first time since April 16-18, 2010 (Kevin Millwood, Jeremy 12-0 Lead after 7 innings Guthrie and Brian Matusz)...The last time the Birds recorded four consecutive Quality Starts in Oakland was Tied after 7 innings 1-2 August 15, 2005-September 1, 2006 (Rodrigo Lopez, Bruce Chen, Eric DuBose and Erik Bedard). Trail after 7 innings 2-7 Lead after 8 innings 11 - 0A PRETTY GOOD YEAR: Since April 25, 2012, Chris Davis has 40 home runs, good for fifth in the major Tied after 8 innings 1 - 2leagues behind Ryan Braun (45), Edwin Encarnacion (45), Miguel Cabrera (41) and Adam Dunn 1-7 Trail after 8 innings (42)...Davis has played 148 games in that span, while the other four averaged 159 games played in that span. Most hits in a game 15(4/25)Fewest hits in a game 5 (last 4/22) NATE THE GREAT: Nate McLouth has reached base safely in 18 of his last 31 plate appearances...Over his 11-5 last eight games, McLouth is batting .458 (11-for-24) with nine runs scored and seven walks...In the leadoff spot, No errors With one error 3-3 McLouth is batting .333 (21-63) with 12 walks...McLouth is second in the AL in walks by a leadoff batter With two errors 1-1 behind Oakland's Coco Crisp (15), but Crisp has five more games played than McLouth. With three or more errors 0-0Since August 22, 2011, the Orioles are tied with the Nationals for the second-most wins 13-8 vs. AI in baseball with 130...Only the Rangers (132) have more wins...The Yankees have 129 wins...Since April 10, vs. AL East 9-6 the Birds are 12-5 and tied with Boston for the best record in the American League. vs. AL Central 1-2 vs. AL West 3-0 KEEPING AN EYE ON COCO: The O's have caught an AL-best eight attempted base stealers (of 13)...Matt 2-1 vs. NL Wieters has thrown out seven of 11 potential thieves and Taylor Teagarden has nabbed one of two...Orioles catchers have thrown out more runners than the Rangers (2), Angels (2), Tigers (2), Blue Jays (1) and 46,653 (4/5) Largest home crowd Largest road crowd 41,851 (4/13) Athletics (0) combined...The A's are the only team that has not thrown out a potential base stealer (0-for-17). **CURRENT ROAD TRIP** THE CLOSER: In his last 11 appearances, Jim Johnson is 1-1 with eight saves and a .179 average against (six singles and a double in 39 at-bats)....He has converted a career-best 31 consecutive saves dating back to July Record 3-0 30, 2012, the second-longest streak in franchise history (Randy Myers, 34, May 6-September 27, 1997) and the .299 (32-107) Team Average longest active streak in the majors...Since September 7, 2011, he leads MLB with 68 saves (Craig Kimbrel 54, 6.7 (20R/3G) Runs per Game Fernando Rodney 51, Rafael Soriano 50, Jason Motte 48 round out the top 5)...He has converted 95.8% of his 2 Fielding Errors opportunities (68 of 71), the best percentage of any closer with at least 10 saves since September 7, 2011. Team ERA 1.00 (27.0IP, 3ER) SEVENTH HEAVEN: Per Elias, the Orioles have won a franchise-record 103 consecutive regular season games Starters W-L 3-0 when leading after seven innings (last loss was August 8, 2011)...It is the second-longest streak for any club 0.90 (20.0IP, 2ER) during the expansion era (since 1961), trailing just the 1998-99 Yankees (116). Starters ERA Bullpen W-L-S 0-0-2 SAVING THE (O')DAY: In his last 24 appearances since September 18, 2012 (regular season and postseason Bullpen ERA 1.29 (7.0IP, 1ER) included), Darren O'Day is 2-0 with a 0.35 ERA (25.2IP, 1ER) and the Orioles are 20-4 in those 24 2/2 Saves/Opps

<u>CRUSH DAVIS</u>: Chris Davis is 12-for-34 in his last 10 games with four multi-hit games, three doubles, two homers and six RBI...Over his last 31 regular season games (dating back to September 26, 2012), he has separate home run streaks of six games, four games and two-games...Davis has a total of 15 homers in those 31 games and is batting .349/.433/.840 with 38 RBI over that stretch.

games...Opponents are hitting just .119 (10-84) with one home run, a double and eight singles.

JONESIN': Adam Jones has reached base safely in all but one (April 12 at NYY) of the Orioles' 24 games this season and has at least one hit in 22 of the 24.

LOCKDOWN LEFTY: Since moving to the Orioles bullpen on August 24, 2012, **Brian Matusz** has stranded all 24 runners he has inherited, leaving all 14 on base in 2012 and all 10 in 2013.

EARL IS LOVING THIS: The Orioles have had runners on base for 15 of their 29 home runs (52%) in 2013 (most multi-run HR in the majors)...Last season, 92 of their 214 homers were of the multi-run variety (43%)...This season, 43 percent of the Orioles' runs have scored via the longball (52 of 121; eight two-run homers, four three-run homers and two grand slams)...In 2012, 47.3% of the Orioles' runs (337 of 712) scored directly on homers (122 solo, 64 two-run, 25 three-run and three grand slams)...Of the 29 HR the O's have hit this season, 12 have given the Birds the lead, and four more have tied the game.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: Is expected to be LH **Zach Britton**...Britton was 1-0 with a 1.98 ERA (13.2IP, 3ER) in three starts for Triple-A Norfolk...In two career starts against Seattle, both in Baltimore, Britton is 0-0 with a 2.57 ERA (14.0IP, 4ER)...Britton threw nine scoreless innings in his first start against Seattle May 12, 2011 (**Jason Vargas** also threw nine scoreless in that game, a 2-1 Orioles win in 12 innings).

<u>OUICK HITS</u>: Is making his fifth start of the season...Is in his second year with the Orioles...Made his MLB debut May 29, 2012 at Toronto...Notched first major league win in his first MLB start July 6 at Los Angeles (AL)...Missed all of 2008 with a torn meniscus and all of 2009 after Tommy John surgery...Attended Mission (CA) CC.

CAREER vs. OAKLAND: Has never faced the Athletics.

LAST START: Faced just two batters over the minimum through five innings Tuesday against Toronto...Ran into trouble with two outs in the sixth as he walked consecutive batters before allowing a three-run homer to **Edwin Encarnacion**.

<u>A BEAST AGAINST THE EAST:</u> In his 14 career starts against the AL East, Gonzalez is 8-3 with a 3.69 ERA (85.1IP, 35) and 10 Quality Starts...He beat each team in the East as a rookie in 2012 and has worked at least 6.0 innings in 12 of his 14 career starts against the East.

IN GOOD COMPANY: Since July 6, 2012 (Gonzalez's first Major League start), the only AL pitcher to win more games than Gonzalez (11) is **Doug Fister** (12)...**Jered Weaver, Hiroki Kuroda, Max Scherzer** and **Alex Cobb** also have 11.

AS A STARTER: In his 19 starts for the Birds, he is 11-5 with a 3.52 ERA (117.2IP, 46ER) and 13 Quality Starts...He has worked six or more innings in 15 of his 19 starts and the Orioles are 14-5 in his 19 starts.

AT ORIOLE PARK: In his eight home starts, he is 4-2 with a 4.60 ERA (47.0IP, 24ER)...As a reliever at home, he has a 2.08 ERA (4.1IP, 1ER) in one appearance...In his eight total appearances, is 4-2 with a 4.38 ERA (51.1IP, 25ER).

ON THE ROAD: In his 11 starts, he is 7-3 with a 2.80 ERA (70.2IP, 22ER) and eight Quality Starts...He has road wins against the Angels, Red Sox, Rays (2), Yankees (2) and Indians...In his two relief appearances, he is 0-0 with a 2.45 ERA (7.1IP, 2ER)...Overall, is 7-3 with a 2.77 ERA (78.0IP, 24ER) in 13 road outings (11 starts).

<u>MINIMIZE THE DAMAGE</u>: Has allowed four home runs in 2013 (three solo and one three-run homer)...Of the 17 homers he has allowed in the majors, 15 have been solo shots...Four were leadoff homers and six were in the first inning...After allowing nine home runs in his first five starts, he allowed just four homers in his last 10 starts of 2012.

<u>HISTORIC OUTING</u>: Started Game 3 of the ALDS in New York and became the fifth pitcher to work seven or more innings, and allow one run or fewer, one walk or fewer and strike out eight or more in a postseason game in the Bronx...The others were **Cliff Lee** (2010 ALCS G3 and 2009 WS G1), **Curt Schilling** (2001 WS G4), **Burt Hooton** (1977 WS G2) and **Don Newcombe** (1949 WS G1)...Gonzalez did not factor in the decision in Game 3.

DIVISION SLAYER: Gonzalez recorded a win against each AL East team as a rookie in 2012... According to Elias, since 1969 (the division era), the only other Orioles pitcher to beat each team in the division as a rookie was **Willis Roberts** in 2001...Fourteen of Gonzalez's 19 career starts have come against the AL East, and he is 8-3 with a 3.69 ERA (85.1IP, 35ER) in those games.

MAJOR LEAGUE FIRSTS: Made his major league debut May 29, 2012 at Toronto and struck out the first batter he faced, **J.P. Arencibia**...Notched first major league win July 6, 2012 at Los Angeles (7.0IP, 1ER).

YANKEE KILLER: Gonzalez beat the Yankees in New York July 30 and August 31, 2012 to become the first rookie starter to beat the Yankees twice on their own field within a span of 33 days since Oriole **Tom Phoebus** did it back on July 17 and August 16 of 1967...Phoebus and Gonzalez are also the only Orioles rookies to earn a pair of road wins over the Yankees in the same season.

<u>AMAZING AUGUST</u>: In five August starts, was 3-1 with a 1.91 ERA (33.0IP, 7ER)...His ERA in August was third-best in the AL behind **Felix Hernandez** and **Bartolo Colon**...It was the sixth-best in all of baseball.

DUBIOUS DISTINCTION: In three start span from July 15-25, 2012, Gonzalez allowed a homer to the first (twice) or second batter of the game (once)...Austin Jackson (July 15) and Desmond Jennings (July 25) hit leadoff HRs and Asdrubal Cabrera (July 20) homered as the 2nd batter of the game...According to Elias, he is the first pitcher in Orioles history to allow a leadoff homer in each of his first two home starts in the major leagues and is the first major league pitcher to do it since Colorado's Chin-Hui Tsao did it July 25 and August 6, 2003...Gonzalez also allowed a leadoff homer run to B.J. Upton on September 12.

THE GLOVE: Was a minor league teammate of late Angels pitcher **Nick Adenhart**...Made his first major league start in Anaheim July 6, 2012 and used a glove that was a gift from Adenhart (has "Adenhart" stitched on the thumb) and held the Angels to one run over seven innings.

AT TRIPLE-A NORFOLK IN 2012: Appeared in 14 games (six starts) for the Tides, going 3-2 with a 1.61 ERA (44.2IP, 8ER)...In six starts, Gonzalez went 2-2 with a 1.98 ERA (6ER, 27.1IP)...In eight relief outings, he went 1-0 with a save and a 1.04 ERA (2ER, 17.1IP)...Struck out 53 and walked 10 batters...Allowed 32 runners in 44.2 innings (22H, 10BB)...Opponents batted .143...Was named Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Month for May as he was 2-1 with a 2.20 ERA (16.1IP, 4ER) in six appearances (two starts) for the Tides.

<u>A SELECT FEW:</u> Was one of 12 Mexican-born players in the major leagues last year, joined by Alfredo Aceves, Luis Ayala, Luis Cruz, Marco Estrada, Yovani Gallardo, Jaime Garcia, Rodrigo Lopez, Luis Mendoza, Ramiro Pena, Oliver Perez and Fernando Salas.

BACKGROUND: Signed by the Angels as an undrafted free agent December 13, 2004...Missed all of the 2008 season due to torn miniscus...Selected by the Red Sox in the Rule 5 Draft December 11, 2008...Missed all of 2009 season after undergoing Tommy John surgery...Signed as a free agent by the Orioles February 28, 2012.
