## Los Angeles Angels (9-16) at Oakland Athletics (15-12) Monday, April 29, 2013 O.co Coliseum

#### GAME NOTES

- Tonight's time of game was six hours, 32 minutes...it is the longest time of game in Oakland history (previous: 6:00, Aug. 9, 2002 at New York-AL)...it is also the longest time of game in Angels history (previous: 6:06, April 13, 1982 vs. Seattle).
- . The game lasted 19 innings, which is tied for the third most innings in Oakland history (second time)...it is the third most innings in Angels history.

### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland A's have recorded back-to-back walk-off wins...now have three walk-offs for the season after tallying a Major League leading 14 last year.
- The A's are 12-2 (.857) against American League West competition and 3-10 (.231) against everyone else (2-8 vs. East, 1-2 vs. Central)...lost the first two games of the season to Seattle but have won 12 straight against Western division foes since then...that is the A's second longest winning streak against the West since divisional play began in 1969...it is the longest since 1994 when the record of 13 was set (June 12-August 11).
- Brett Anderson entered the game in the 13<sup>th</sup> inning and tossed 5.1 innings...it was his first career relief appearance.
- Coco Crisp (1 for 6, 2 r, bb, so, sb) left the game in the 14<sup>th</sup> inning with a strained left hamstring.
- Jed Lowrie had an Oakland-record tying nine at-bats (also: Mike Heath, July 1, 1979 at Texas).
- Brandon Moss hit his third career walk-off home run (last: Sept. 29, 2012 vs. Seattle)...had his second career multiple home run game (also: June 12, 2012 at Colorado).
- Chris Young left the game in the 16<sup>th</sup> inning with a strained left quad.

#### LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels lost in extra innings for the first time this season (were 3-0)...have lost the past three games and six of the past eight...are now 9-16 for the season, which matches their worst mark after 25 games in franchise history (9-16, four times; last: 1994).
- Peter Bourjos left the game in the 11<sup>th</sup> inning with a strained left hamstring.
- Brendan Harris and Howie Kendrick became the second and third players in Angels history with nine at-bats in a game (also: Don Baylor, April 13, 1982).
- Albert Pujols recorded a season-high tying four hits (second time), his 40<sup>th</sup> career game of four or more hits...hit two home runs, his second multiple home run game of the season and 46<sup>th</sup> of his career.
