**LEADING OFF:** Tonight, the Angels play the fifth game (1-3) of a seven-day, seven-game road trip to Seattle (April 25-28; 1-3) and Oakland (April 29-May 1)...Club is 9-15 after 24 games for second straight season...Club record for worst mark after 25 games is 9-16 (4 times, last, 1994)...Halos have dropped six of last seven road games...LAA is 7-7 in last 14 contests but has dropped five of last seven games overall...Club is 5-11 vs. A.L. West foes...2013 represents the Angels' 53rd season in the Majors and 48th campaign in Anaheim.

**SCHEDULING UPDATE:** Today the Angels and FOX Sports West announced two changes to the schedule this week: **Tomorrow's (4/30)** Angels @ Athletics game and **Friday's (5/3)** Angels vs Orioles game will both be televised on KCOP-TV (My13). Coverage for both broadcasts will begin with "Angels Live" at 6:30pm PT.

**YESTERDAY'S TRANSACTION:** The Angels Sunday acquired right-handed pitcher **Rob Delaney** from the Baltimore Orioles in exchange for catcher **Chris Snyder**. **Delaney**, 28, has posted an 0-1 record with a 10.12 ERA (5.1 IP – 6 ER) in three games this season pitching for the Norfolk Tides. Across eight minor league seasons, the right-hander has amassed a 29-23 record with a 2.79 ERA (473.2 IP – 147 ER) with 460 strikeouts and 80 saves.

**FAST FACT:** Angels have won eight of last 11 games in Oakland (7-12 here in previous 19 affairs)...However, Angels are 3-10 in previous 13 matchups at Angel Stadium.

**HURTIN' HALOS:** LAA currently has seven players (4 pitchers) on the 15-day D.L.

**THE MANAGER:** Scioscia is the longest tenured manager in the Majors (14<sup>th</sup> season) and the only active manager to collect over 1,000 victories with a single club...His current .547 (1,164-966) winning percentage and 1,164 wins are both tops in franchise history.

**IN WITH THE NEW:** Over the offseason, Jerry Dipoto and the Angels front office made several transactions, bringing in the likes of **Josh Hamilton**, **Jason Vargas**, **Sean Burnett**, **Joe Blanton**, **Ryan Madson** and **Tommy Hanson**...**Josh Hamilton** is one of just two players to have hit .310 or better with 100 doubles, 100 HRs and at least 300 RBI since the start of the 2010 season (also, **Miguel Cabrera**)...**Vargas** is one of only eight A.L. pitchers to have thrown 200+ innings in each of last two seasons...**Hanson** has posted at least 10 wins in each of his first four MLB seasons (2009-2012)...**Burnett** notched a career-high 31 holds in 2012 while appearing in 70+ games for the third time in his career...**Madson** missed all of 2012 with Reds following "Tommy John" surgery.

## TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER – RHP TOMMY HANSON

**2-1, 4.24 ERA (13-10, 4.48 ERA in 2012)**

*Making first career start vs. Oakland*

- Makes fourth start of regular season tonight and second on the road for the Angels...Has not allowed a run in last eight innings pitched.
- Missed last start after being placed on bereavement list April 22<sup>nd</sup>...Was activated from bereavement list yesterday afternoon.
- **LAST TIME OUT:** Tossed six shutout innings on April 19 vs. Detroit at Angel Stadium, holding the defending A.L. champs to six hits while striking out two...Struck out Victor Martinez in 5<sup>th</sup> inning for 600<sup>th</sup> career strikeout.
- Made Angels debut April 6 at Texas and earned the victory after tossing six innings and allowing three runs on six hits, while striking out four.
- **VS. OAKLAND:** Tonight marks first career start vs. Athletics...In four career starts vs. AL West teams, is 2-1 with a 5.87 ERA (23 IP – 15 ER) and 21 strikeouts.
- **AT O.CO COLISEUM:** Will make first career appearance at the Coliseum tonight...Has a 5-1 career record and 6.18 ERA (39.1 IP – 27 ER) when pitching in American League ballparks for first time...O.co Coliseum marks eighth A.L. park pitched in for Hanson and 25<sup>th</sup> MLB ballpark.
- Is in first season with Angels after four seasons with Braves...Acquired via trade in exchange for Jordan Walden Nov. 30, 2012.

### 2012 RECAP:

- Went 13-10 with a 4.48 ERA (174 IP – 87 ER) in 31 starts...13 wins established a career best and ranked second on team to Tim Hudson (16)...2012 marked third time in four seasons Hanson won 11+ games.
- Led Braves with 31 starts and 161 strikeouts...Went 9-2 from 5/13-8/17 with a 4.55 ERA and 85 strikeouts in 93 IP.

### CAREER NOTES:

- Has posted at least 10 wins in each of his first four MLB seasons (2009-12)...Led Braves in starts in two of his four full seasons with club
- Despite not making his debut until June of 2009, ranked among N.L. rookie leaders in wins (3<sup>rd</sup>, 11) and strikeouts (2<sup>nd</sup>, 116) that season.
- Finished third in 2009 N.L. Rookie of the Year voting...His 2.89 ERA in 2009 was lowest for a Braves rookie since 1943.
