LEADING OFF: Tonight, the Angels play the fifth game (1-3) of a seven-day, seven-game road trip to Seattle (April 25-28; 1-3) and Oakland (April 29-May 1)...Club is 9-15 after 24 games for second straight season...Club record for worst mark after 25 games is 9-16 (4 times, last, 1994)...Halos have dropped six of last seven road games...LAA is 7-7 in last 14 contests but has dropped five of last seven games overall...Club is 5-11 vs. A.L. West foes...2013 represents the Angels' 53rd season in the Majors and 48th campaign in Anaheim.

SCHEDULING UPDATE: Today the Angels and FOX Sports West announced two changes to the schedule this week: Tomorrow's (4/30) Angels @ Athletics game and Friday's (5/3) Angels vs Orioles game will both be televised on KCOP-TV (My13). Coverage for both broadcasts will begin with "Angels Live" at 6:30pm PT.

YESTERDAY'S TRANSACTION: The Angels Sunday acquired right-handed pitcher Rob Delaney from the Baltimore Orioles in exchange for catcher Chris Snyder. Delaney, 28, has posted an 0-1 record with a 10.12 ERA (5.1 IP – 6 ER) in three games this season pitching for the Norfolk Tides. Across eight minor league seasons, the right-hander has amassed a 29-23 record with a 2.79 ERA (473.2 IP – 147 ER) with 460 strikeouts and 80 saves.

FAST FACT: Angels have won eight of last 11 games in Oakland (7-12 here in previous 19 affairs)....However, Angels are 3-10 in previous 13 matchups at Angel Stadium.

<u>HURTIN' HALOS</u>: LAA currently has seven players (4 pitchers) on the 15-day D.L.

THE MANAGER: Scioscia is the longest tenured manager in the Majors (14th season) and the only active manager to collect over 1,000 victories with a single club...His current .547 (1,164-966) winning percentage and 1,164 wins are both tops in franchise history.

IN WITH THE NEW: Over the offseason, Jerry Dipoto and the Angels front office made several transactions, bringing in the likes of Josh Hamilton, Jason Vargas, Sean Burnett, Joe Blanton, Ryan Madson and Tommy Hanson...Josh Hamilton is one of just two players to have hit .310 or better with 100 doubles, 100 HRs and at least 300 RBI since the start of the 2010 season (also, Miguel Cabrera)... Vargas is one of only eight A.L. pitchers to have thrown 200+ innings in each of last two seasons...Hanson has posted at least 10 wins in each of his first four MLB seasons (2009-2012)...Burnett notched a career-high 31 holds in 2012 while appearing in 70+ games for the third time in his career...Madson missed all of 2012 with Reds following John' "Tommv surgery.
